(1) संस्था की निबन्धन संख्या/तिथि तथा पत्रावली संख्या अंकित नहीं की गई है जिसके कारण प्रस्तुत प्रपत्रों पर कार्यवाही सम्भव नहीं है। कृपया उक्त सन्दर्भों सहित ही प्रपत्र प्रस्तुत करें और इस कार्यालय से प्रत्येक पत्र व्यवहार में उक्त सन्दर्भ देने का स्थान भविष्य में अवश्य रखें।

(2) सन्दर्भित नवीकरण किया जा चुका है एवं दस्तावेजी प्रमाण-पत्र संलग्न है। कृपया प्रति स्वीकार करें तथा सोसाइटीज रजिस्ट्रेशन ऐक्ट, 1860, ३० प्र० सोसाइटीज रजिस्ट्रेशन रूल्स, 1976 और अन्य संगत नियमों के अन्तर्गत ही संस्था का संचालन करें।

(3) नवीकरण हेतु एक वर्ष से भी अधिक दिवस से आवेदन करने के फलस्वरूप संस्था अपंजीकृत हो चुकी है। अतः बिना पर्याप्त कारणों के संस्था का नवीकरण करना सम्भव नहीं है। संस्था द्वारा आवेदन किये जाने पर उसके पुनः पंजीकरण पर विचार किया जा सकता है जिसके सम्बन्ध में आपके मार्ग-दर्शन हेतु "निर्देश-पत्र" की प्रति संलग्न है (धारा 3ए (5)।

(4) कृपया दिनांक _____ से _____ तक के नवीकरण हेतु ३० _____ नवीकरण शुल्क तथा ३० _____ दिवस शुल्क का बैंक ड्राफ्ट रजिस्ट्रार, फर्स, सोसाइटीज एण्ड चिट्स, ३० प्र०, लखनऊ अथवा सम्बन्धित क्षेत्रीय सहायक निबन्धक के पदनाम से प्रेषित करें। कार्यालय में व्यक्तिगत रूप से जमा करने की स्थिति में उक्त शुल्क नकद भी जमा किया जा सकता है (धारा 3ए तथा नियम 9)।

(5) कृपया शिक्षा प्रमाण-पत्र मूल रूप में प्रस्तुत करें। मूल प्रमाण-पत्र छो जाने अथवा किन्हीं अन्य कारणों से न प्रस्तुत किये जाने की स्थिति में वास्तविक तथ्यों का उल्लेख करते हुए नोट्स शपथ-पत्र प्रस्तुत किया जा सकता है। इस शपथ-पत्र में यह भी लिखा जाना चाहिये कि संस्था में कोई प्रबन्धकीय विवाद नहीं है [(धारा 3ए (4)।

(6) कृपया जिला विधायक, जिला वैदिक शिक्षा अधिकारी से इस तथ्य का एक प्रमाण-पत्र प्रस्तुत करें कि संस्था में कोई प्रबन्धकीय विवाद नहीं है और संस्था के वर्तमान प्रबन्धक अमुक्त सम्बन्ध हैं।

(7) कृपया _____ वर्षों की वर्षवार अलग-अलग प्रबन्ध समिति की सूची, जिसमें सभी पदाधिकारियों तथा सदस्यों के नाम, पते, व्यवसाय तथा पद का उल्लेख हो, प्रस्तुत करें। प्रत्येक वर्ष की सूची अलग-अलग पृष्ठ पर होनी चाहिये चाहे वही सूची अगले वर्ष भी क्यों न लागू हो। (धारा 3ए तथा 4(1))।

(8) यदि प्रबन्ध समिति में परिवर्तन हुआ हो तो उक्त वर्ष की सूची पर भूतपूर्व पदाधिकारियों व सदस्यों के हस्ताक्षर कराये जाने चाहिये जो अब इस सूची में नहीं है। कृपया वर्ष _____ की सूची पर भूतपूर्व पदाधिकारियों/सदस्यों के भी हस्ताक्षर फेरकर प्रस्तुत करें। (धारा 3ए तथा 4(1))।

(9) वर्ष _____ से सम्बन्धित प्रबन्ध समिति की सूची संस्था के पंजीकृत नियमावली में अंकित पदों के अनुरूप नहीं है। कृपया इसका कारण स्पष्ट करें तथा पुनर्पत्रित सही सूची प्रस्तुत करें।

(10) कृपया सूचित करें कि संस्था के विधान के अनुसार प्रबन्ध समिति का चुनाव कब होता था और उरी वास्तव में कब कराया गया। प्रबन्ध समिति के प्रत्येक चुनाव की कार्यवाही प्रस्तुत करें। यदि संस्था के विधान में निर्धारित अवधि/तिथि के अनुसार संस्था के प्रबन्ध समिति का चुनाव नहीं हुआ है तो यह भी स्पष्ट करें कि उक्त चुनाव समय से पूर्व/पश्चात्, कराने के क्या कारण थे और क्यों न उक्त चुनाव को अमान्य कर दिया जाय (धारा-25)।

(13) कृपया वर्ष के आय-व्यय लेखे/बैलेंस शीट प्रस्तुत करें वी। उन्हें समय से प्रस्तुत किये जाने का कारण भी स्पष्ट करें [धारा 4 (2)]।

(14) प्रस्तुत आय-व्यय लेखे/बैलेंस शीट वर्ष रही नहीं है। उदाहरणार्थ उनमें गत वर्ष के अवशेष पहले वर्ष में सही/अंकित नहीं किये गये हैं, आय-व्ययक की नई अंकित नहीं की गयी है। कृपया बुद्धिपूर्व लेखे प्रस्तुत करने का कारण स्पष्ट करते हुए सही लेखे प्रस्तुत करें।

(15) कृपया वर्ष के आय-व्यय लेखे/बैलेंस शीट धर्टर्ड एकेउन्टेन्ट से प्रमाणित कराकर प्रस्तुत करें [धारा 23]।

(16) उद्देश्यों में परिवर्तन हेतु सर्वप्रथम प्रन्ध सभिति द्वारा प्रस्तावित परिवर्तन पारित किये जाने चाहिये। इसके 10 दिन बाद साधारण सभा की एक दूसरी विशेष बैठक में 3/5 बहुमत से उक्त प्रस्ताव पारित किये जाने चाहिये और इस बैठक के एक माह के अन्तर्गत पर साधारण सभा की एक दूसरी विशेष बैठक 3/5 बहुमत से उक्त प्रस्ताव का पुष्टिकरण किया जाना चाहिये। इस बैठक के एक माह के भीतर ही उक्त सभी बैठकों की कार्यवाहियों की प्रतियाँ उचित पुनरीक्षित स्मृति-पत्र जिसमें परिवर्तन उद्देश्यों का सम्बन्ध ही तथा मंत्री और प्रन्ध सभिति के तीन सदस्यों के हस्ताक्षर हैं, के साथ सुसंशोधित स्मृति-पत्र के पंजीकरण हेतु आवेदन किया जाना चाहिये। कृपया निर्धारित प्रक्रिया के अनुसार कार्यवाही कर आवश्यक प्रपत्र प्रस्तुत करें। रजिस्ट्रार द्वारा उक्त स्मृति-पत्र के पंजीकरण (फाइल) के लिये जाने की सूचना जारी हो जाने पर ही संशोधित उद्देश्य मान्य होंगे [धारा 12 तथा नियम 5]।

(17) संस्था के पते तथा नियमों में परिवर्तन की कार्यवाही की सूचना नियमों में निर्धारित प्रक्रिया के अनुसार प्रस्ताव की प्रति के साथ 30 दिन के अन्दर ही उन्हें पंजीकरण (फाइल) करने के अनुरोध के साथ प्रस्तुत किये जाने चाहिये। संस्था के नियमों के परिवर्तन की स्थिति में संस्था की संशोधित सम्पूर्ण नियमावली भी उसे पंजीकरण करने के अनुरोध के साथ प्रस्तुत की जानी चाहिये। कृपया तदनुसार तत्सम्बन्धी कार्यवाही तथा संशोधित नियमावली प्रस्तुत करें। कार्यालय द्वारा उक्त परिवर्तनों के पंजीकरण किये जाने की सूचना जारी किये जाने पर ही परिवर्तन मान्य होंगे [धारा 4ए तथा नियम 5]।

(18) संस्था के नाम परिवर्तन हेतु रजिस्ट्रार की पूर्व अनुमति आवश्यक है। अनुमति हेतु अनुरोध करने तथा अनुमति प्राप्त होने पर संस्था द्वारा साधारण सभा की विशेष बैठक में 2/3 बहुमत द्वारा अनुमोदन प्राप्त कर प्रस्ताव की संशोधित स्मृति-पत्र/नियमावली के प्रति के साथ रजिस्ट्रार को परिवर्तित नाम का प्रमाण-पत्र जारी किये जाने के अनुरोध के साथ प्रस्तुत किया जाना चाहिये। कृपया तदनुसार कार्यवाही करें। रजिस्ट्रार द्वारा परिवर्तित नाम का प्रमाण-पत्र जारी किये जाने पर ही परिवर्तित नाम मान्य होगा [धारा 12 तथा नियम 5 व 12]।

(19) संस्था द्वारा धारा 4 व 4ए के अन्तर्गत प्रन्ध सभिति की वार्षिक सूची व असावधिक नियमावली की प्रारम्भिक प्रतिलिपि नहीं प्रस्तुत की गयी है। कृपया 30 दिनों के अन्दर सूचित करें कि क्यों न संस्था के विरुद्ध अधिनियम की धारा 27 के अन्तर्गत कार्यवाही करते हुए न्यायालय में अपीलेशन दाखल किया जाय।

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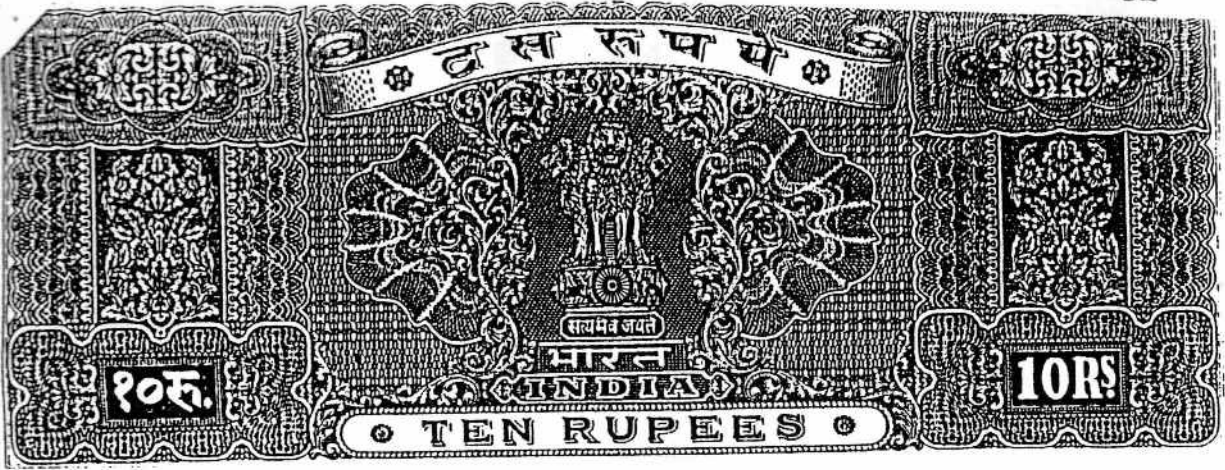

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AMANDMENTS MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF THE SANSKAR FOUNDATION

RULE (1) NAME

The name of the Society shall be "SANSKAR FOUNDATION"

RULE (2) REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered Office of the Society shall be situated at 2/77, Vipul Khand, Genti Nagar, Lucknow.

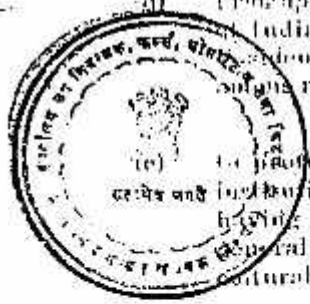
RULE (3) AREA OF OPERATION





RULE (4) OBJECTS

The objects of the Society are :-

- (a) Prior approval of State Govt. (U.P.) Dental Council of India and Central Govt. of India to set up the dental college for promoting, protecting, extending support the dental education among individuals and weaker sections of the society.
- (b) Prior approval of State Govt. (U.P.) Medical Council of India and Central Govt. of India to set up the Medical College for promoting the medical education among individuals and society.
- (c) Prior approval of State Govt. (U.P.) A.I.C.T.E. and Central Govt. of India to set up the Engineering College for promoting the among individuals and society.
- (d) Prior approval of State Govt. (U.P.) U.G.C.E. and Central Govt. of India to set up the Universities, Deemed University, Central University for promoting the higher education among remote area, individual, weaker sections of the society.
- (e) to protect, promote and extend support to persons and institutions engaged in activities of education, social cause and having direct or indirect influence or impact on people in general. So as to make them useful for raising the moral, cultural and educational levels of individuals and society.
- (f) to assess and evaluate contribution and impact of individuals and organizations engaged in activities of promoting education, social service and public good, with particular emphasis on the role of promoting education amongst the poor throughout the country or abroad.

organised sectors, with a view to make them aware of their prime responsibility towards needy individuals and society in general :

- (iv) to extend and provide financial and other help to people involved in the upliftment of education and activities incidental thereto and other deserving persons and organisations associated with preserving and promoting cultural heritage of our country, upliftment of human values, service to humanity in general and weaker sections of society in particular, and these purposes to raise funds by accepting donations, gifts and charities, holding exhibitions and cultural programmes, or any other profit making activity which may be incidental or conducive to their main object of the Society.
- (v) to organise, open, control and manage institutions and organisations for the furtherance of the aforesaid and other charitable objects.
- (vi) to promote and provide appropriate and encouraging atmosphere and environment to deserving persons engaged in service of society or in public life, particularly to those involved in upliftment of standard of education :
- (vii) to promote and diffuse useful knowledge and education in all spheres and establish and maintain schools, colleges, training centres, libraries, reading rooms, research centres, etc.
- (viii) to promote and educate children and youth for removal of social disparities, upliftment and rehabilitation of displaced and other persons in distress, and other charitable works.
- (ix) to raise the intellectual, moral, economic, health of the people in general and of the weaker sections of Society in particular and to establish and run institutions for furtherance of these objects;

- (x) to grant scholarship or other help to deserving students ;
- (xi) to work in association with Government and/or other organisation or otherwise to set up colleges, institutions and schools in furtherance of the aims and objects of the Society.

RULE (5) MEMBERS

There shall be the following categories of members of the Society.

- (i) Founder Members
- (ii) Life Memembrs
- (iii) Ordinary Memembrs

RULE (6) FOUNDER MEMBERS

- (i) There will be only 7 Founder Members and they will hold office for life, unless any of them resigns or is removed from membership under Rule 9(a) or Rule 10(i) of these rules. Provided that a Founder Member may induct and other person in his place as a Founder Member with the approval of the Governing Council.
- (ii) These 7 persons who have actively participated in the establishment of the Society in the memory of and have been described as Founder Members, at the time of the formation of the Society, will be the original Founder Members.

RULE (7) LIFE MEMBERS

A life Memembr means a person who has contributed Rs. 5.000/- or more and is enrolled and registered as such by the Governing Council of the Society on the ground of his distinguished and devoted public service for the attainment of the objects of the Society ; and who has contributed to the upliftment of society mankind.

RULE (8) ORDINARY MEMBERS

An Ordinary Member means a person inducted by the governing Council to render advice to the Society for smooth and proper functioning of the Society and who in the opinion of the governing Council is possessed of such qualities. An Ordinary Member shall not have a right to vote.

RULE (9) REMOVAL OF MEMBERS

- (i) The Governing Council may remove a Founder Member a Life Member or an Ordinary Member from its membership if he :-
- [a] is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent authority, or
 - [b] is an undischarged insolvent, or
 - [c] is convicted by a court of law of any offence including moral turpitude, or
 - [d] is found to have committed a breach of Rules and Regulations of the society under his care, which lapse palpably casts a reflection on his integrity or honesty in the estimation of the Council, or
 - [e] is held by 3/5th of the members of the Council to be behaving in a manner which is prejudicial or detrimental to the interest, reputation and discipline of the Society ; or
 - [f] if he ceases to take interest in the activities of the society and fails to attend five consecutive meetings of the General Body without satisfactory reasons.
- (ii) A person against whom action under this Rule is contemplated may be afforded opportunity to be heard in camera before the action is finally taken but he may not be anything in writing in relation to the allegations against him.

- (iii) A member removed under this Rule shall not be entitled to stake any claim in respect of any contribution made by such member to the Society:

RULE (10) · GOVERNING COUNCIL

- (i) The Governing Council shall be composed of 15 members in accordance with Article 5 of the Memorandum of the Association of the Society.
- (ii) Minimum of nine members of the Governing Council of the Society shall be from amongst the Founder memebtrs and/or Life Members.
- (iii) All casual vacancies among the members, other than Founder memebtrs, of the Governing Council shall be filled up by election by the memebtrs for the time being of the said Council present in the meeting specially convened for the purpose and of which due notice has been given to each member of the Council.
- (iv) For the purpose of clause(b) and (c) of this rule each member of the Governing Council present shall have one vote in respect of each vacancy, which is to be filled up in that meeting.
- (v) The person who obtains the highest number of votes shall be declared elected in that vacancy, in case of tie between two or more persons, who receive equal number of votes, the Chairman shall have a second vote and a person in whose favour he casts his vote shall be declared elected.
- (vi) If a member of the governing Council, dies, resigns, or is removed from office, the casual vacancy caused shall be filled in from the members; and the person so elected shall hold office for the remainder of the term of the member in whose vacancy he has been elected.
- (vii) The term of the members elected as in (b) above shall be 3 years, and they shall be eligible for re-election.

- (viii) A member of the Governing Council may resign his office by writing under his own hand, addressed to the President of the governing Council.
- (ix) A member may be removed from the membership of the Governing Council if he :-
- [a] fails to attend 5 consecutive meetings of the Council without satisfactory reasons ;
 - [b] is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent authority ;
 - [c] is an undischarged insolvent.
 - [d] is convicted by a court of law of any offence including involving moral turpitude; or
 - [e] if he does any act of omission or commission which he knows to be, or is likely to be, injurious to the interests of the Society.
- (x) All the decisions of the governing Council shall be by consensus.

RULE (11) POWERS OF GOVERNING COUNCIL

- (i) The affairs and the management of the Society, including the management and council of the institution and organisations run by or under the Society and the control and supervision of other activities taken up by the Society, together with all its property of every nature of sort shall vest in the governing Council.
- (ii) Without prejudice to the general powers conferred under sub Rule (a) the Governing Council shall inter alia exercise the following powers :-
- [a] to take over, establish, maintain and run institutions.

- colleges, research institutions, dispensaries, libraries, reading rooms, museums, and art galleries.
- (b) to acquire land, buildings and other movable and immovable properties by purchase or otherwise;
 - (c) to construct buildings and other structures for the purposes of or connected with the Society;
 - (d) to accept gifts, grants and subsidies, donations etc., and to raise money for the purposes of the Society;
 - (e) to lend or borrow money and to sell, lease or mortgage the property of the Society on such terms and conditions as it may think to be in the best interest of the Society;
 - (f) to grant scholarship and to give other financial help to poor and deserving persons, specially students;
 - (g) to enter into and to secure the fulfillment of the contracts and other engagements entered into by or on behalf of the Society;
 - (h) to appoint, remove, or suspend the servants or the Society and of the institutions and organisations which are maintained by it and to fix their salaries or remunerations;
 - (i) to institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal proceeding by or against the Society;
 - (j) to refer any claim by or against the Society to arbitration;
 - (k) to provide money for establishing, maintaining and running institutions, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, dispensaries etc. and for all other activities, which may be taken up by the Society for achieving all or any its objects; and to negotiate with the State and/or Central government for setting up any college or institution on

such terms and conditions as may be agreed.

- (l) to frame rules, regulation or bye-laws for running, maintaining, managing and controlling the institutions and organisations, which may be established or taken over by the Society for carrying out its purposes provided that they are not inconsistent with these Rules or the provisions of the Societies Registration Act, (Act No. XXI) of 1860 or the Memorandum of Association of the Society.
 - (m) to invest and deal with the money of the Society which is not immediately required, in such manner as it may think fit;
 - (n) to do all acts and things which may be necessary to further the aims and objects of the Society.
- (iii) The Governing Council may, subject to its general control and supervision and such restrictions as it may like to impose, delegate all or any of its power to any founder/life member.
- (iv) The acts of the governing council shall be valid notwithstanding any vacancies in its membership for any cause whatsoever.
- (v) All decisions taken by the Governing Council shall be by consensus.

RULE (12) MEETINGS OF GOVERNING COUNCIL

- (i) The Governing Council shall meet normally once in a year but it may meet as often as the President may consider necessary; or may be summoned to be convened by not less than five founder members who shall forward their request in writing and jointly signed to the President.
- (ii) The Secretary with approval of the President shall call the meetings of the Council transact such business as may be notified.

RULE (13) NOTICE OF MEETING

The notice of a meeting of the Council shall be issued at least seven days before the date of the meeting. Provided that an emergent meeting of the Council may be called at 48 hours notice.

RULE (14) GENERAL BODY

The General Body shall be composed of the members as prescribed in Rule 13(a).

RULE (15) MEETING OF GENERAL BODY

The General Body of the Society shall ordinarily meet once a year but, if the Founder Member deems, necessary, it may be called as often as necessary, in accordance with rule 12(a).

RULE (16) QUORUM

The quorum for a meeting of the General Body of the Society shall be nine members present in person.

No quorum shall be required for a meeting held to transact business notified for a meeting which has ben adjourned for want of quorum.

RULE (17) BUSINESS AT THE GENERAL BODY MEETING

- (i) A report of the activities and other matters relating to the Society for the period under review shall be placed before the General Body meeting of the Society and a statement of accounts for each year relating to that period shall be made available to the members of the Society.
- (ii) The Chairman of the meeting shall supply all relevant information to the members if asked for by any one of them during the meeting.

RULE (18) NOTICE OF GENERAL BODY

The notice of a meeting of the General Body shall be issued by the Secretary at least two weeks before the date of the meeting.

RULE (19) AUDITORS

- (i) An Auditor shall be appointed in the meeting of the General Body of the Society and he shall hold office for one year, provided that the Auditor so appointed shall continue to work beyond one year until his successor is appointed.
- (ii) the accounts of the Society shall be audited at the close of every financial year (from 1st April to 31st March) and the report submitted by the Auditor shall be duly considered and passed by the Governing Council.

RULE (20) OFFICE BEARERS

- (i) The Society shall have a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Director (who shall be the Honorary General Secretary of the Society) a Honorary Treasurer, and a Joint Secretary and such other officer as the Governing Body may appoint.
- (ii) All office permanent all office bearers, shall hold office for three years, unless they resign or relinquish office on their own or are removed by the Governing Council with a least 3/5th of its Members present.
- (iii) The members of the governing body shall have a right to resign from office subject to:
 - [a] giving three months notice in writing of his intention to do so; and
 - [b] acceptance of the same by the Governing Council in a meeting convened for the said purpose.

- (iv) On death or resignation of any of the office bearers of the Society, the vacancy so caused shall be filled by the Governing Council from a amongst the Founder Members of the Society. The office bearer so elected can be removed by the Governing Council with 3/5th of its Members present and voting for such removal under Rule 11(i).
- (v) The retiring office bearers shall be eligible for re-election.

RULE (21) POWERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS

- (i) The President shall be the head of the Society and function for and on behalf of the Society during the absence of the Governing Council. All such actions taken by him shall be brought to the notice of the Governing Council in due course.
- (ii) The President may delegate any of his function, duties and powers to any of the Vice Presidents for any specified time or during his absence or when on leave.
- (iii) The Secretary shall be the Chief Executive of the Society, and all executive business, shall be carried on by him, subject to the restrictions laid down by the Governing Council, or by these Rules, or by or under the Societies Registration Act (Act XXI) of 1860 or the Memorandum of Association of the Society.
- (iv) The Secretary may delegate any or all his powers for any specified time and may also assign any work and duties to the Honorary Treasurer or to the Joint Secretary.

RULE (22) FUND AND ASSETS

- (i) All funds, properties and assets, moveable and immovable received or acquired in any manner whatsoever shall belong to the Society and be kept, maintained and invested in the name of the Society.

- (ii) Banking accounts of the Society shall be opened in any nationalised bank and shall be operated upon by the Director of the Society.

Provided that the Governing Council may authorise opening of accounts or investment of funds of the Society in any other bank or with any other institution.

Provided further that the Governing Council may authorise operation of banking and other accounts and investments by the President or any other office bearer or Member of the Governing Council.

RULE (23) RECORDS

Records of the Society like Membership Register, Minute Book, Cash Books and Ledgers, etc. shall be properly maintained and kept at the Registered office of the Society.

RULE (24) LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

The Society shall sue and be sued in its own name, through the Honorary General Secretary or such other person who may be appointed by the Governing Council for the said purpose.

RULE (25) AMENDMENTS

The governing Council may add to amend vary or delete any of the Rules.

Provided that no Rule shall be added to, amended, varied or deleted unless a resolution to that effect has been passed by not less than 3/5th of the members present in the meeting of the Council specially called for that purpose and of which at least one month's notice has been given to each member.

RULE (26) WINDING UP

The provision of Section-13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act (Act No. XXI) of 1860 shall apply for dissolution the Society and to disposal of the assets of the dissolved Society.

RULE (27) APPLICATION OF THE ACT

All the provisions under all the sections of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 shall apply to this Society.

RULE (28) FIRST GOVERNING COUNCIL

The First Governing Council shall be constituted from amongst the founder members of the Society whose minimum term shall be of 3 years which may be extended by the Governing Council for another 2 years.

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF THE SANSKAR FOUNDATION

1. The name of the Society shall be "SANSKAR FOUNDATION" it is being established in the memory of.....
2. The Registered Office of the Society shall be at 2/77, Vipul Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow.
3. The Society shall have jurisdiction to function and operate any where within the territories of teh Union of India or abroad.
4. The objects of the Society are :
 - (i) to protect, promote and extend support to persons and institutions engaged in activities of education, social cause and having direct or indirect influence or impact on people in general, so as to make them useful for raising the moral, cultural and educational levels of individuals and society.

- (ii) to assess and evaluate contribution and impact of individuals and organisations engaged in activities of promoting education social service and public good with particular emphasis on the role of promoting education amongst the poor throughout the country or abroad.
- (iii) to work for accountability of persons and organisations associated and involved with the influencing directly or indirectly cause and interest of promoting education for the benefit of common man, with emphasis on role of artists, journalists, jurists, social workers, writers, people's representative trade unions and functionaries of other organised sectors with a view to make them aware of their prime responsibility towards needy individuals and society in general;
- (iv) to extend and provide financial and other help to people involved in the upliftment of education and activities incidental thereto and other deserving persons and organisations associated with preserving and promoting cultural heritage of our country, upliftment of human values service to humanity in general and weaker sections of society in particular and these purposes to raise funds by accepting donations gifts and charities holding exhibitions and cultural programmes or any other profit making activity which may be incidental or conducive to the main objects of the Society;
- (v) to organise, open control and manage institutions and organisations for the furtherance of the aforesaid and other charitable objects;

- (vi) to promote and provide appropriate and encouraging atmosphere and environment to deserving persons engaged in service of society or in public life particularly to those involved in upliftment of standard of education.
- (vii) to promote and diffuse useful knowledge and education in all spheres and establish and maintain schools colleges training centres libraries reading rooms research centres, Dental education Medical education, Engg. education, University etc. *→ First Seven*
- (viii) to promote and educate children and youth for removal of social disparities upliftment and rehabilitation of displaced and other persons in distress and other charitable works;
- (ix) to raise the intellectual moral economic social health of the people in general and of the weaker sections of Society in particular and to establish and run institutions for furtherance of these objects;
- (x) to grant scholarships or other help to deserving students;
- (xi) to work in association with government and/or other organisation or otherwise to set up colleges institutions and schools in furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Society.
