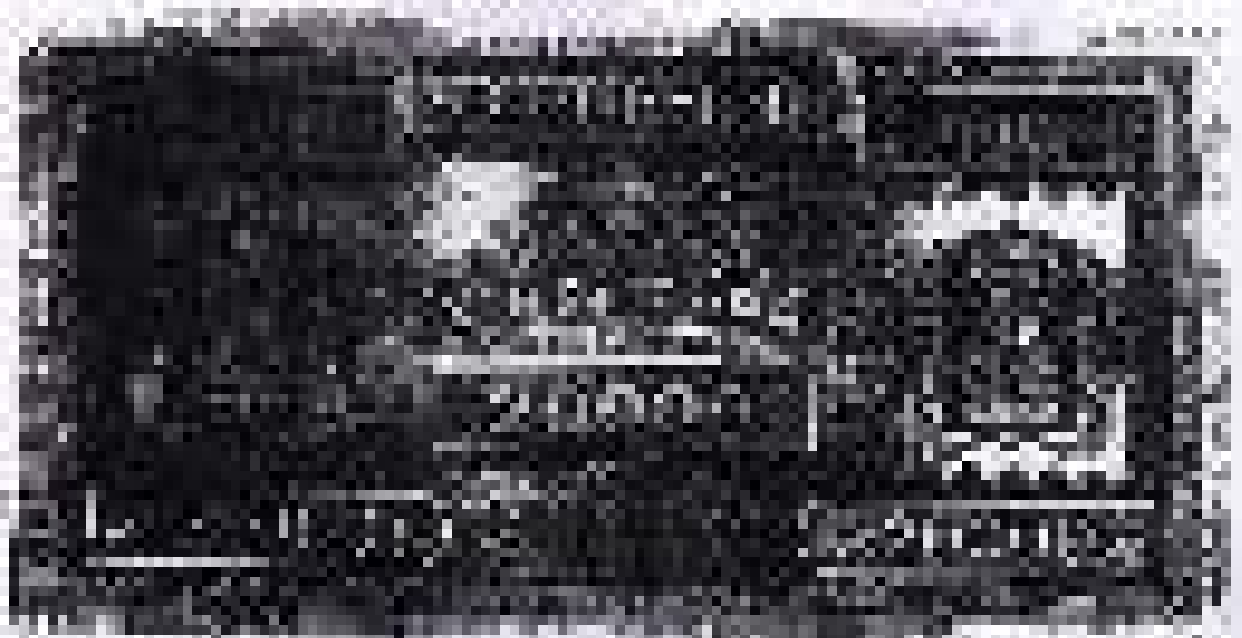

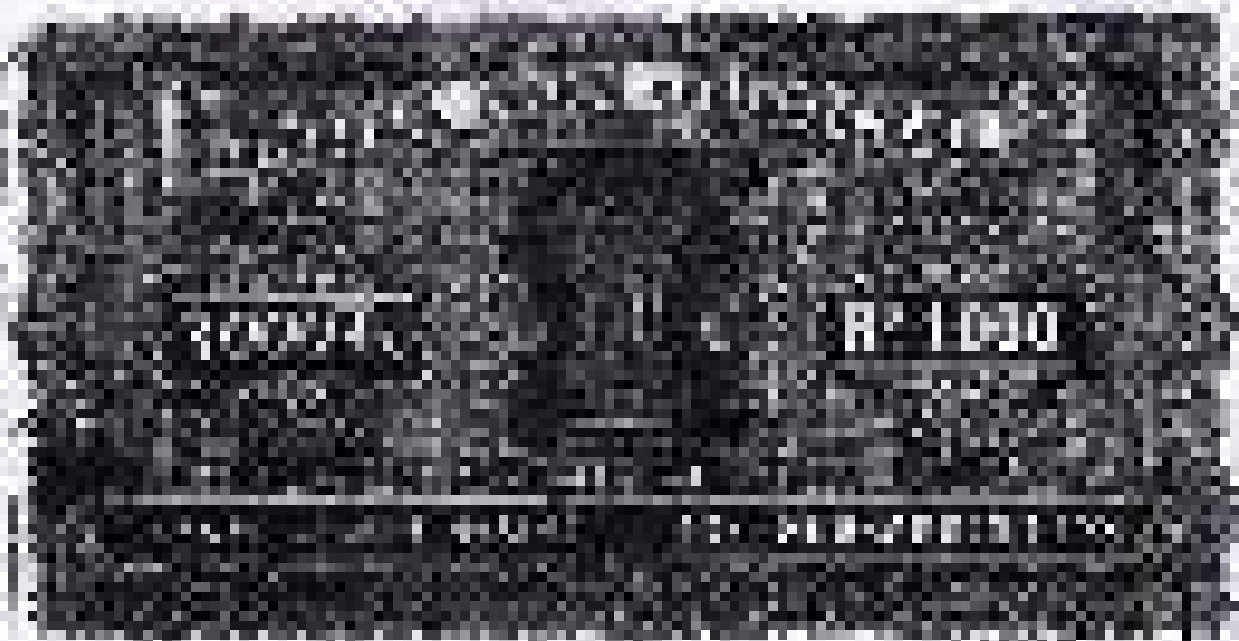

The first part of the question is to find the value of x. We are given the equation $2x + 5 = 15$. To solve for x, we first subtract 5 from both sides of the equation, which gives us $2x = 10$. Then, we divide both sides by 2, resulting in $x = 5$. This is the solution to the equation.

The second part of the question asks us to simplify the expression $3x^2 + 2x - 5 + 4x^2 - 7x + 8$. To do this, we combine like terms. The x^2 terms are $3x^2$ and $4x^2$, which sum to $7x^2$. We can write the following system of equations: $x = 2y + 10$ and $x + y = 25$. Substituting the first equation into the second, we get $2y + 10 + y = 25$, which simplifies to $3y + 10 = 25$. Subtracting 10 from both sides gives $3y = 15$, and dividing by 3 yields $y = 5$. Substituting $y = 5$ back into the first equation, we find $x = 2(5) + 10 = 20$. Thus, the two numbers are 20 and 5.
