This deed of Declaration of Public Charitable Trust is executed on the 30 October 2018 between Raghendra Pratap Singh, S/o of Ashok Kumar Singh, residing at Village and Post – Maharapur, District – Jaunpur, Pin code No. 222180 (U.P.) hereafter called the "Author" of the one part and the Trustees mentioned hereinafter of the other part.

Whereas the Author, out of philanthropic, benevolent and other good, pious and noble causes, here already set apart a sum Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) in cash toward constituting a public Charitable Trust and handed over the same to the Trustees hereinafter appearing.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the Objects and Terms of the Public Charitable Trust.

Now this Deed of declaration of the Public Charitable Trust witness as follows.

1. Name of the Trust:-

The name of the Trust shall be **ASHOK KUMAR SINGH EDUCATIONAL & CHARITABLE TRUST**, hereinafter for the sake of brevity referred to as "Trust" and its Head Office shall be Village and Post – Maharapur, District – Jaunpur, Pin Code no. 222180 (U.P.) and branches – such other or place as the Trustees herein may decide from time to time.

- b. In case the son is minor, then his legal guardian shall be in charge of the Secretary till the attainment of the age of the majority of the Son. In case of no son, the eldest male member of the family will be the legal heir to the post of Secretary.

5. Trust Fund:

- a. The initial contribution of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) made by the Author of the Trust shall hereby vest in the Trustees and shall constitute the Initial Trust fund.
- b. The Trust fund may be augmented by the income the initial fund and also donations and other contributors from time to time.
- c. The Trust fund can be applied for any charitable purpose other than those specified below.

6. Objects of the Trust:

The Objects of the Trust are as under -

- a. To open, found, establish, promote, setup, run, maintain, assist, finance, support and / or run hospitals, charitable dispensaries, child welfare centers, research centers, diagnostic centers, blood bank service centers, immunization centers, health centers and to apply or provide medical relief and / or aid to the suffering humanity.
- b. To establish, setup, maintain, finance support and / or help in the setting up orphanages, widow homes, old age homes, leprosy centers, AIDS relief centers or other establishment for relief and / or help to the poor, old and / or destitute.
- c. To give, provide and / or render food, medicine and other help and / or assistance in any shape or form to the poor, deserving and needy persons.
- d. To give, provide and / or render monetary and / or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire,

To grant, pay or give scholarship, stipends, prizes, rewards, allowance and other financial assistance or help in cash or kind to students with a view to help them in pursuing their studies in schools, colleges, education institutions, technical institutions, art schools, institutions teaching commercial and other arts Industrial Training Center.

- n. To help in the preservation of useful animals, environments, and to promote plantation and ecological conservation.

7. Enabling Powers:

That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall have the following power through their Managing Committee.

- a. To accept any donation, contribution, grant of subscription in cash or in kind, from any persons(s), body of persons or Trust, institutions, state or central governments and governments departments, local authorities, etc. with or without condition.
- b. To apply the whole or any Part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust fund or accumulations hereto any one or more of the objects of the Trust, as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- c. To convert and with deal with the Trust Property and/or investments for the time being.

- e. To borrow or raise or secure payments of money and also lend money either with or without security.
- f. To sell, dispose off, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust fund by Secretary.
- g. To let out, demise any immovable property, comprised in the Trust fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Founder Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- h. To open account in the name of Trust, and institutions run/ conducted by the Trust with a bank or to operate such account and give instructions to the bank and provide for the opening and operation of such account by the Secretary.
- i. To adjust, settle, compromise compound, and refer to arbitrations all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust.
- j. To make, vary alter or modify schemes rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the managing of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effects to the objects of the Trust.
- k. To start, abolish discontinue, and restart any charity or charitable institution for the benefit of general public and to impose any condition to any subscription or donation made by them.
- l. To set apart and / or allocate the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or a part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- m. To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise to different charitable institutions, societies organizations or Trust in India.

1. **Name of the Trust** : ASHOK KUMAR SINGH EDUCATIONAL & CHARITABLE TRUST
2. **Address (Head Office)** : Village and Post Maharapur, District - Jaunpur,
Pin. Code No. 222180 (U.P)
3. **Area of Activity** : All over India
4. **Type of Membership** :
 - a. **Founder Trustees**: The members whose names have been incorporated in the Trust deed.
 - b. **Life Trustee**: The members who are blood relations of the Founder Trustees and who have been admitted for life jointly by the President and the Secretary/Manager after the incorporation of the Trust with voting right.
 - c. **Ordinary Members**: the members who have been admitted by the president / secretary on the recommendation of Founder Trustees (and in their absence by life Trustees) for the benefit of the Trust, but who will have no voting right, and whose appointments shall be valid for 5 years only. Their membership may be renewed on recommendation of Secretary.
5. **No. of Trustees**:
Maximum 7 (Seven)
Minimum 2 (Two)
6. **No. of Ordinary Members**:
Maximum - No Limit
Minimum - Zero
7. **Eligibility of the Trustees/Members**:
No person being:
 - a. An undercharged insolvent; or
 - b. Convicted for offence involving moral turpitude; or

8. Ceasing of trusteeship / membership:

A person shall, cease to be a member in any of the following events:

- If he / she dies; or
- If he / she becomes bankrupt; or
- If he / she becomes insane or otherwise incapable to act; or
- If he / she resigns his office, and the resignation is accepted by the secretary;

9. Managing Committee:

Founder, Trustees will form the Managing Committee and the office bearer of Trust shall be office bear of Managing Committee. The following Trustees shall be the first Managing Committee Member.

10. Meeting:

General meeting of the Managing Committee shall be held at least once a year. However with the consent of the Presidents/Secretary, meeting can be called upon at any time by the Secretary / Manager.

11. Period of Notice:

The notice period shall be of minimum seven days; however it can be reduced on the event of any emergency, with the consent of the Presidents.

Presence of 1/3 of the Managing Committee shall be Quorum. In case the present members are less than 1/3 the meeting shall be adjourned for one hour, after which it can be held on the same place for which no Quorum shall be required.

13. Duties and Right of the Managing Committee:

- Modification of the Constitution of the Trust by 2/3 majority.
- To take decision in respect of opening of hospitals, schools, graduate and post Graduates colleges, engineering / management / law / teacher education colleges, Pharmacy college etc.
- Managing committee shall have right to, form sub committees as needed for any purpose in which all the office member of the Managing Committee shall be the Member of such committee.
- For running any education institution established by the Trust, where it is required to form a separate management committee, the presidents and Secretary (manager) of the Trust shall be the Presidents and Secretary of that committee of the institution respectively.

12. Quorum:

Presence of 1/3 of the Managing Committee shall be Quorum. In case the present members are less than 1/3 the meeting shall be adjourned for one hour, after which it can be held on the same place for which no Quorum shall be required.

13. Duties and Right of the Managing Committee:

- Modification of the Constitution of the Trust by 2/3 majority.
- To take decision in respect of opening of hospitals, schools, graduate and post Graduate colleges, engineering / management / law / teacher education colleges, Pharmacy college etc.
- Managing committee shall have right to, form sub committees as needed for any purpose in which all the office member of the Managing Committee shall be the Member of such committee.
- For running any education institution established by the Trust, where it is required to form a separate management committee, the presidents and Secretary (manager) of the Trust shall be the Presidents and Secretary of that committee of the institution respectively.
- In case of death of founder Trustees the remaining founder Trustees with consents of Secretary will nominate the founder trustees from his family.

14. Power and duties of the office bearers of the committee of Management:

President

- The Presidents will hold office for life. Founder Trustees Shri Raghendra Pratap Singh will be the President.

15. Right and Duties of the President:

- The presidents shall preside over the meeting of Managing Committee

- a. If the managing committee / board of the trust or the institutions run by the trust is divided equally in any resolution in the meeting or on any decision the President is entitled to the casting vote.
- 2. Vice - President:**
 - a. In the absence of Presidents, he / she will act as president.
 - b. To exercise and perform all such powers and duty as may be delegated to him by the president in writing for a specific period.
- 3. Secretary (Manager):**
 - a. The Secretary will hold office for life. Founder Trustee Sri Harsh Pratap Singh shall be Secretary, after that the office of the Secretary shall be assumed by the son of the Secretary.
 - b. In case the son is minor, then his legal guardian shall be in charge of the Secretary till the attainment of the age of majority of the eldest son after him the said office shall devolve upon his wife after her upon his Son failing thereof make next male in line of succession failing thereof such successor, or any person nominated by him by deed, will or otherwise.
- 4. Rights and Duties of the Secretary:**
 - a. Shall operate and execute all working of the Trust. He will be Principal Officer of Trust.
 - b. Shall keep and maintain minute-books of the meeting and maintain members register of the Trust.
 - c. The Manger will conveys the meeting of the board on his own motion or at the requisition of the President. In the absence of President, Secretary will preside the meeting.
 - d. All the funds of the Trust and other institution governed by the Trust shall be operated by the secretary.
 - e. All deposits and accounts e.g. saving account, fixed deposit, cash certificates and other investments of all kinds will stand in the name of secretary.
 - f. To watch over the finances of the Trust and Institution run by the Trust and to exercise the general control over the executive administration of Trust and Institutions.
 - g. To conduct all correspondence on behalf of the management committee.
 - h. All the documents and record of the Trust or institution managed by the Trust i.e. membership registered, Notice registered, proceeding register, stock register, cash book its salary kept by the secretary.
 - i. The committee of management shall appoint an auditor at the end of the financial year to audit the accounts of Trust and institutions.
 - j. The secretary shall have the power to institute to conduct - defend, compromise, referred to arbitration or legal proceeding and claims by or against the Trust, institution, or the managing committee.
 - k. Any amendment alteration or addition to this rules and regulations for the benefit of Trust or running institution by the Trust shall be made by majority of 2/3 members of total strengths of trustee.
 - l. Secretary with in consultancy with Managing Committee can frame any new rule for the benefit of Trust or abolish any rule which is against the Trust by Secretary.
 - m. To purchase or sell of any property of Trust or Mortgage or Lease will done by Secretary.
- 5. Deputy Secretary:**

In the absence of Secretary. He / she will act as Secretary

6. The Managing Committee member will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Managing Committee may reimburse themselves all expense actually incurred by them, in connection with the trust or their duties relating thereto.
7. The numbers of members of the Managing Committee shall not less than two and more than seven, if the numbers of the members shall fell below two, the Trustees shall not, except for the purpose of filling any vacancy, act so long the numbers is below the said minimum.
8. Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his / her intention of doing so.
9. The Managing Committee shall from time to time frame rules for the conduct and Regulations of the meetings of the Trustees in the absence of such regulations.
10. All members will be decided mutually by the Managing Committee. Resolution passed without any meeting of the Managing Committee, but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hand of 1/3 of the Trustee including the President shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the managing committee.
11. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending 31 march every year.
12. The Trust and the Trust funds shall be irrevocable for all times.
13. The Head office of the Trust shall be situated at Village and Post - Maharapur, District - Jaunpur, Pin-Code No. 222180 (U.P.) unless changed by the Founder Trustees by a 2/3rd majority.
14. The objects and / By-Laws of the Trust can be altered or modified or changed within the charitable purpose by 2/3rd majority of the Trustees in general meeting.
15. It is explicitly declared that no part of Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or the benefit of any Trustee/ Members or for any purpose which is not charitable purpose in law, and all provisions thereof shall be construed accordingly.
16. In case of dispute, the place of jurisdiction will be Jaunpur, U.P. (INDIA) in witness whereof the parties have hereunto seen and subscribed their respective hands on the day, months and first mentioned herein above.
