## Trust Fund and Property

- (i) The funds of the Trust are to apply the sum of Rs. 2000/- (Two thousand rupees only) and also the monies received by the Trust as corpus and shall not be disposed of or applied to any other purpose than the purpose of meeting the expenses or in carrying out the object of the Trust for literary or other purposes unless otherwise resolved by the trustees.
- (ii) The fund together with funds the above corpus will be invested in such investments as may be made by the trustees on behalf of the Trust for the time being in any manner whatsoever, the amount of which contributions, the sole property of the Trust, accordingly notwithstanding.

- (v) It shall be lawful for the trustees at any time in their absolute discretion think it needful by public notice or by contract or exchange or transfer or assign or sell, let or lease for any term whatsoever to any person or persons or firm or firm of the true fund including the immovable properties themselves and on such term and conditions relative to the otherwise and in all respects as they may think proper and to buy it and receive or carry the same for uses according to him in payment of debts or otherwise disposition without being answerable for any loss sustained thereby and for such purpose to execute all necessary conveyance, deed or exchange assignments

- for whom such evidence shall be given and other assurances and to pass, give and execute necessary simple releases and discharges for the consideration money otherwise obtainable by the donee or his or her estate. All money arising from any sale, transfer or otherwise disposition of the contributions of the trust fund shall be includable accordingly.
- (v) The Board of Trustees may, where all the requirements for the smooth working management of the trust give the same the necessary powers in the keeping of the trust by an unaniuous resolution or by a resolution passed by the majority,
15. Application of the Funds and Properties of the Trust:

#### 15. Beneficiaries


