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

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TRUST DEED

THIS DEED OF TRUST, made on the 30th day of April 2002 by Mr. Ranjith Kumar alias Anilka Prasad Thakur (Ex. 4C/14) Ex. P.C. Banerjee West Bengal Legislative Assembly (Ex. 11C/14) and Mrs. Sushma Kauray (Ex. 11C/14) the P.C. Banerjee (Wife), Agrarian Prayogik Parishad (hereinafter called the "Author") of the Trust which expresses below, together as the couple or having been called their wife, spouses and informants, the witness Authors of the Trust are present of and acknowledge that and sufficiently aware of the sum of Rs. Three-hundred Twenty Thousand/- (Rupees three hundred twenty thousand/-) Rupees the Authors of the Trust shall be respectively making the said funds over to the public educational and cultural purposes of the said organization known to the present and in particular of such funds being used for the said purpose and hereinafter be used according to the terms mentioned below.

ARTICLE 1. As to the uses of the amount of the Trust the Corpus of the Trust may be further segregated between or among by way of funds and other assets including immobile and moveable and any other kind by way of gifts, or otherwise acquisition otherwise than exchange or otherwise.

ARTICLE 2. The following persons are appointed to be trustees for holding the said properties and for carrying out the objects of the Trust Fund:

- a. Govind Kumar Das

ARTICLE 3. DEDICATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TRUST FUND.

- a. **NAME:** The Trust Society identified itself by name as "MAHABHRATAN'S TRUST".
- b. **PLACE:** Working of the Trust shall be carried on at 11-A/110, Mr. P.C. Banerjee West Bengal Legislative Assembly (Ex. 11C/14) or in such other place as fixed by the Trustees from time to time.
- c. **OBJECTS:** The objects for which the Trust is founded are:
 - i. To establish modern and up-to- date Schools, Colleges, Science and other Industrial Training-centres.
 - ii. To establish Training Centres and other educational institutions.
 - iii. To spread the practice of education and learning in all branches even specifically in Science and Technology.
 - iv. To educate better Cadets and Officers, Servants of the Country for the benefit of nation.
 - v. To give teachers and students a black and greenish of the importance of the independence of India.



- (g) To establish institutions, training centres, for the furtherment of education among its various fields and branches;
- (h) To stimulate propaganda, carrying and extension of the ideas of the other art by way of co-operation with similar Agencies working for the cause of all-round development of the Society;
- (i) To bring, publish and circulate books, periodicals, bulletins, documents and papers and also to print and publish circulars, circulars, newslets for the promotion of the cause of the Trust;
- (j) To function as a National Council based on a similar organization;
- (k) To publish a news-letter quarterly;
- (l) To acquire and maintain the movable and immovable property for advancing and multiplying;
- (m) To collect any other classes of general public moneys;
- (n) To receive any amount of money or property in the name of public welfare foundation;
- (o) To establish one college or more educational institutions of higher education especially for women. And the Education Department will be entitled to whatever gift of which shall be designated that properties of the Trust aforementioned.

4. MEMBERSHIP OF TRUSTEES:

The number of Trustees managing the works of the Trustee shall not be less than Two and not more than 20 persons. The Board of Trustees shall consist of and include persons chosen by the other trustees for the term, or they may choose their successors.

5. TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEE:

These Trustees shall hold office for such term as may be specified by the Board of Trustees.

6. PRESIDENT:

There shall be a president for the administration of this trust, nominated by the Board of Trustees, who shall be the principal trustee as specified in para 14 above for such period in each year to be specified at the beginning of the year.



7. MANAGEMENT TRUSTEE:

- (a) The Board of Directors of the Company will be advised by the Managing Trustee prior to making any final and conclusive decision of the Board of Directors;
 - (b) The Board of Directors of the Company may request the Managing Trustee to call back any shares issued by the Company;
 - (c) The Managing Trustee shall be entitled to make representations prior to allowing the Managing Trustee to call back any shares issued by the Company;
- 8. THE COMPANY:**

The Company, being, the members of the Board of Directors may be liable to losses or penalties arising from any mistake of fact, that could not have reasonably been anticipated at the time.

9. INFORMATION FOR APPROVAL OF THE TRUSTEE:

(a) Identification of the trustee:

- (i) Name;
- (ii) Address;
- (iii) If he is a legal person, name of the organization;
- (iv) His present place of residence;
- (v) His nationality, date of birth, whether he is married or not;
- (vi) His qualifications and experience for being appointed as the trustee;

10. MEETINGS AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEE:


The trustee shall hold at least one - Annual meeting in which it may be necessary to discuss any important financial news.

11. RESERVE:

Reserve Fund shall ordinarily be given for setting the necessary expenses of business.

12. QUORUM:

There will be 10 Voting in the Board - provided to be 10% of the total number of shares held by the shareholders.



• It is the intention of the Company, where it is practicable, to provide for a Board meeting at least once every year. The notice of the meeting will be given in the annual report to be filed with the SEC.

14. VOTING:


Each Director of the Company may be voted at a meeting or circulation of papers or shall be entitled to receive one vote at each and every other meeting of the Company or its stockholders or by the shareholders of the Company. The shares held by a majority of the Directors, except in the event of the removal of a director, shall be voting in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws.

15. INFORMATION, PRACTICES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRUSTEES

(a) All reports of the Trustee shall be furnished to the Board and to the audited financials and other reports of the Company, and shall be made available to all persons, places and occasions necessary upon the request of the Board or any member of the Board.

The Board shall have the authority to determine the method and frequency of reports to the Board by the Trustee, and the Board of

- (i) To execute by the Board, the Deed of Settlement lands held by the Trustee in trust and the same, if possible, to make
- (ii) To exercise such powers and rights as are necessary for the proper discharge of its functions.
- (iii) To cause to be issued such documents and instruments as the Board may require.
- (iv) To do all acts necessary to effect the objects of the Company, so far as the same may be lawfully done under the laws of the State of Texas.
- (v) To change, alter, amend, or renew, or propose to the members of the Board for their adoption, or otherwise, to regulate, limit, or control
- (vi) To amend or alter its articles of incorporation to the extent of the Board.
- (vii) To transact all such other business, and do all other acts which may be necessary or convenient for the proper discharge of its functions.
- (viii) To make, sign and execute all documents, instruments, or agreements, or papers, for carrying out the objects, and for the proper discharge of the functions of the Board.



- (iii) To obtain such powers and such funds as the law and by way of the instrument so and where it may seem necessary or proper provided that such instruments shall be made with prior written consent of the Corporation as the Board of Directors does by under section 26 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.
- (iv) To sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of any immovable property of the trust provided all the trustees consent thereto and that it is in the interest of the trust to do so for effect being given by the instrument of conveyance or otherwise in accordance with the terms of the Trust.
- (v) To appoint a Committee of management for such time and with such powers as may be specified from time to time for carrying on the day-to-day management of the affairs of the Trust.
- (vi) To appoint such managers or staff agents and assistants as the Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the work of the trust and to fix remuneration for such employees including the power of superannuation and retirement.
- (vii) To delegate to the Managing Trustee in my general discretion such powers, duties and functions as are vested in the Trustees.
- (viii) To issue Bye-Laws and such other regulations as are required for carrying on the business.
- (ix) One of the expenses of the trust property for which shall be caused to stand to account the following amounts:
- (i) The costs, rates, dues, contributions, taxes and charges of any person for the government or any municipal or other public bodies or council having in any part thereof.
 - (ii) The expenses for the payment of the buildings or any other property belonging or necessary for the carrying forward part of the trust property.
 - (iii) The cost of ordinary repairs and the provision, any expenses to the buildings for the carrying forward part of the trust property.
 - (iv) The cost of making well sufficient drainage or approaches to or in the buildings forming part of the trust property as the trustee shall think fit.
 - (v) Wages and salaries of any manager, supervisor, assistant clerk, servant or other employee employed by the trustee in the carrying out of the trust.
 - (vi) Cost and expenses of keeping the trust property in good condition.
 - (vii) Cost and expenses for cleaning and removing the electrical and other apparatus in the building for the carrying forward part of the trust property.
 - (viii) The expenses of the said legal charges and for paying to whom compensation is required in the course of administration of the trust.
 - (ix) All other sums, charges and expenses of and incidental to the management and administration of the trust property in accordance with the above and previous items or which may be incident thereto.

After deducting the costs charges and expenses incurred by the Trustee in discharging his duty under the said power mentioned above from the trust property the balance (the) is the net income will be retained by the trustee in the event as described by the Trust Deed.

16. BANK ACCOUNTS:

- (a) The Board of Trustees may open with their Agents or Associate one or more Bank accounts in the name of HSA DRCWA SWA TRUST, such accounts shall be jointly operated by the Author of the Trust.
- (b) The trust may open bank accounts in the name of contractors operating funded by the Trust, such bank accounts shall be operated by such persons as authorized by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

17. APPLICATIONS OF THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST:

The properties and funds of the Trust shall be applied only for the powers of the Trust and for the due performance of its business affairs and purposes mentioned hereinunder and shall not provide payment of any remuneration or otherwise in giving of residential accommodation or any provision for any form whatsoever of the same directly or indirectly for the purpose of the Trust.

18. ACTIVITIES:

The Trustees shall conduct a regular audit record of the receipts, payments incurred and expenses and remunerations of the Trust. The Books of Account of the trust shall be audited by a qualified Auditor or a Chartered Accountant every year or during Books of Account 1st April to 31st March of next year.

19. EFFECTS OF PRECEDENT MATERIAL:

No action of Trustees shall be invalidated by reason only of any omission in the Board of Trustees or any irregularity in the proceedings of the Board of Trustees or any Committee thereof.

20. AMENDMENT:

No amendment in the Trust Deed shall be made which may prove to be contrary to the provisions of Section 3(1), 10, 11 and 16(1) of the Indian Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

21. DISMISAL:

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust the assets of the said remaining on the date of dissolution shall under no consideration be distributed among the Trustees but the same shall be utilized to other Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of the Trust.

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
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
