PROBATION DEPARTMENT

1. The purpose of this report is to provide information regarding the activities of the probation department during the period from January 1, 1954, to December 31, 1954. This report is intended for the use of the Board of Probation and the public.

2. The probation department has been organized to provide supervision and guidance to offenders who are placed on probation. The department's primary function is to monitor the progress of these offenders and to provide them with the necessary support and services to enable them to lead law-abiding lives.

3. During the year 1954, the probation department has received a total of 1,234 new referrals from the courts. Of these, 789 were males and 445 were females. The majority of these referrals were for offenses involving property crimes, such as larceny and burglary. However, there were also a significant number of referrals for more serious offenses, including assault and drug offenses.

4. The probation department has been successful in placing 1,156 of these offenders on probation. The remaining 78 referrals were either committed to the state prison or were otherwise disposed of by the courts. The probation department has been able to place a high percentage of offenders on probation because of its close cooperation with the courts and its ability to provide the necessary support and services to these offenders.

5. The probation department has also been successful in monitoring the progress of these offenders. During the year 1954, the department has conducted a total of 15,678 supervision visits. These visits have provided the probation officers with valuable information regarding the progress of these offenders and have enabled them to provide them with the necessary support and services to enable them to lead law-abiding lives.

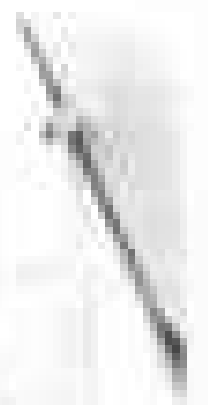
