### PHILOSOPHY 101

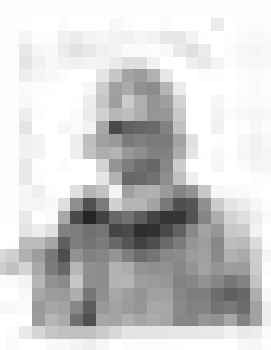

## THE EFFECTS OF AEROSOL PARTICLES ON THE RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

The respiratory system is the primary pathway for the entry of inhaled particles into the body. The effects of these particles depend on their physical and chemical properties, the dose, and the duration of exposure.
