THE FOUNDING OF THE NATION

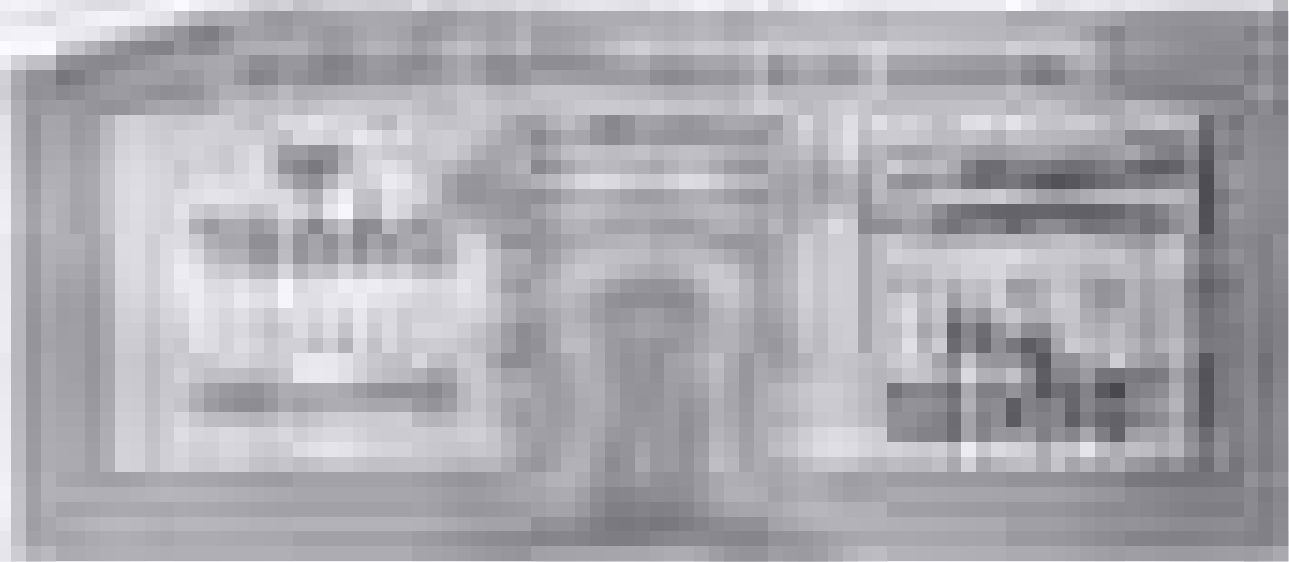

The new nation faced many challenges, including the need to establish a government and a constitution. The Constitution was signed in 1787 and went into effect in 1789. The first President, George Washington, was inaugurated in 1789.

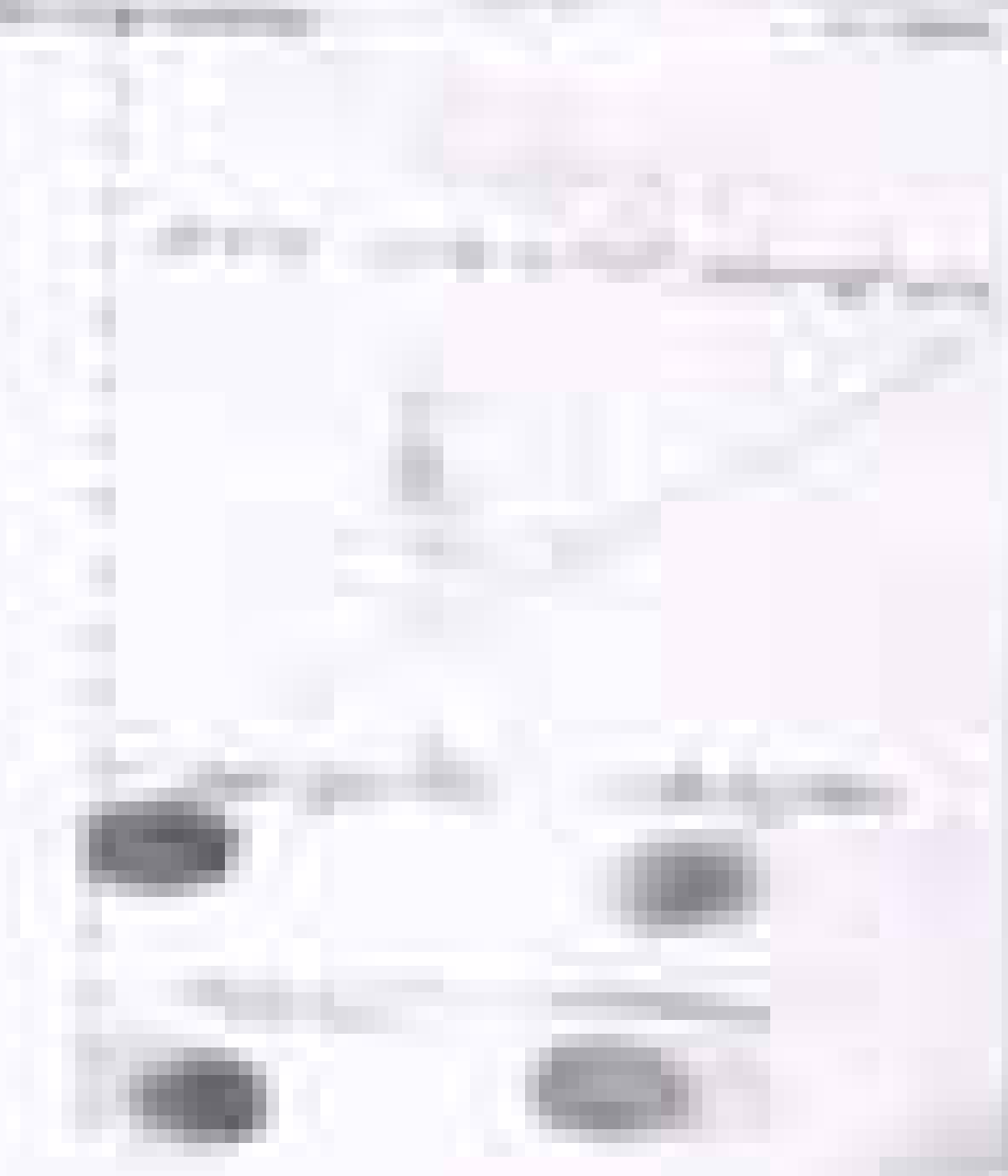
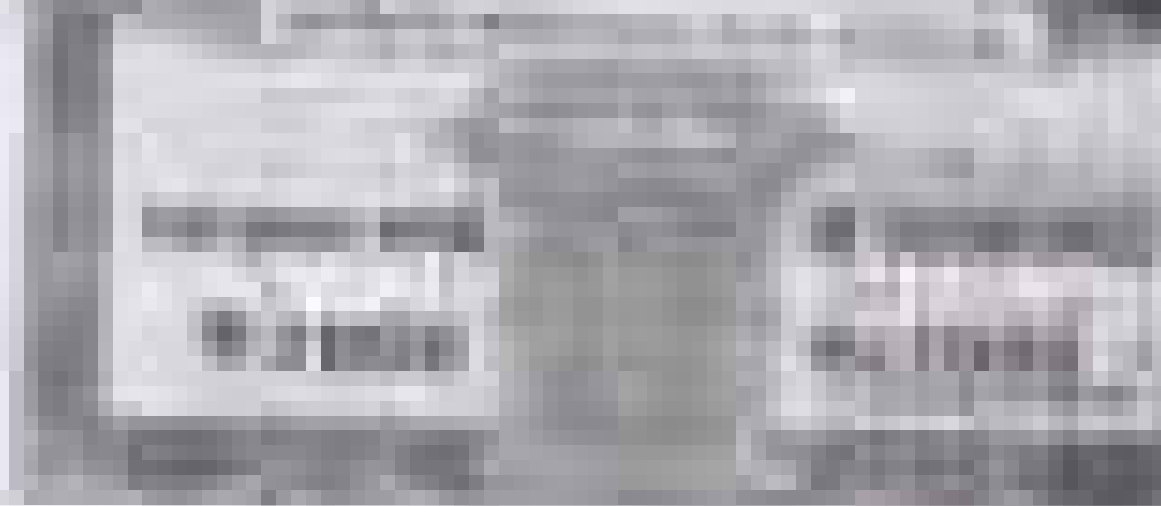

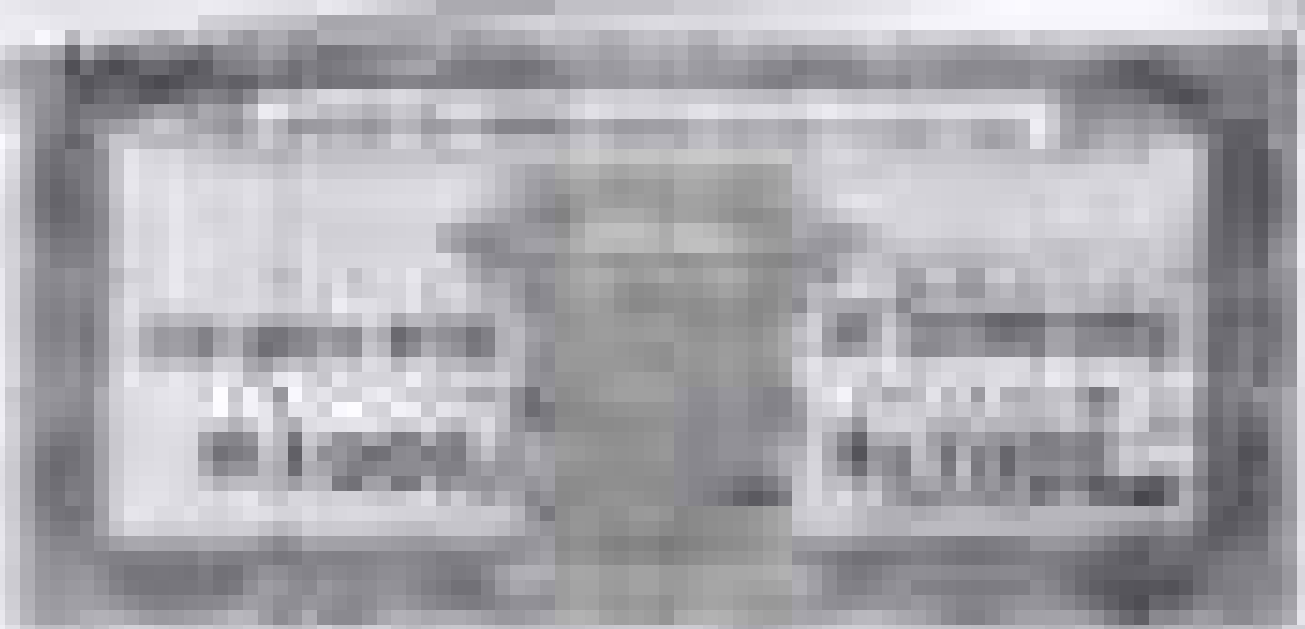
