

4. Aims and objects

The aims and objects for which the Society is established are as under:

- (a) To train the minds and shape the character of the younger generation.
 - (b) To impart, teach and provide guidance for learning Computer Education, Information Technology, Hindi, English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Music, Dance, Drama, Art, Poetry, Oration, Games, Physical Training, Moral Science including Ethical values etc.
 - (c) To impart the knowledge in the fields of Accountancy, Taxation, Management, Medical Engineering, Architectural and other allied technical areas.
 - (d) To inspire and encourage the younger generation to discover their talents in fields of technical education, arts, science, commerce, sports and other various activities and help them to excel in them.
 - (e) To train them to become good individuals and disciplined citizens of India for the betterment of the country and world at large.
 - (f) To run dispensary for providing free medical aid to poor people irrespective of caste, creed and religion.
 - (g) To render assistance by way of scholarships or otherwise to the poor, handicapped or underprivileged youth and shining students irrespective of caste, creed and religion, in cash, either in lump sum or by giving monthly stipends, or in kind or both and also to give grants to the shining students so as to encourage them.

(b) To render assistance by way of scholarships or otherwise to women irrespective of caste, creed and religion, in each either in lump sum or by giving monthly stipends, or in kind of such and all other forms to women so as to encourage them.

(c) To enter into mutual co-operation or collaborate with any educational institution, society or association for physical, moral, educational development, uplift of society or its surroundings.

(d) To arrange tours or provide conveyance to any student and youth to and for any such place of historical value or internationally acclaimed monument or place which may enlighten and diffuse knowledge.

(e) To accept donations, raise subscriptions from the members of the society or other persons, to lend funds of the society with such individuals, societies, firms or companies for providing income to the society, on such terms and conditions as may deem proper and necessary for the fulfillment of the aims and objects of the society and to further its interest as enumerated above.

(f) To sell, manage, transfer, exchange, mortgage, charge, lease, dispose off or otherwise deal with any property of the society and to mortgage with banks or financial institutions or borrow funds for the attainment of the objects of the society.

(g) The income and the property of the Society shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the society as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and the amounts thereof shall be paid or transferred directly to the members of the society.

(h) Two member of the Governing Body of the Society shall be appointed to any office or office of the Society or any offices of, the Society paid by fees that no remuneration shall be given by the society to any member of such Governing Body except repayment of out of pocket expenses, honorarium for holding a position in the faculty of the society, interest on money lent and rent for premises demised, to the society.

(i) To deal with the banks and other financial institutions to borrow funds for the attainment of objects of the society.

(j) All the incomes, earnings, moveable, immoveable properties of the society shall be society utilized and applied towards that promotion of its aims and objects only.
