5. To help the poor patients with blood, artificial limbs, other aids, medicines, food, nutrition and resettlement.
6. To establish, run, maintain or grant aid to the schools, colleges, path shaias, hostels and education to boys and girls and also to provide facilities for the development and advancement of education and knowledge.
7. To help poor or promising students in their studies by providing books, uniforms, meals, lodging and other necessities or facilities and to provide stipends, scholarships grants and aids for further studies.
8. To establish, arrange and maintain rest houses, public houses, poor houses, Ashrams, water huts or other public utilities for the benefit of the society.
9. To grant relief to the poor and distressed persons during and after natural calamities like famine, earthquakes, floods, draughts etc.
10. To help indigent, poor and helpless families, individuals and persons.
11. To start community, recreational, health, devotional and other centres of general public utility and also to arrange and manage medical camps for any kind of diseases, for the benefit of the public.
12. To assist in or to provide and create job or employment opportunities for the poor, handicapped and female.
13. To formulate and carry out schemes and programme for the benefit of the Society specially for the benefit of the poor and weaker sections of the society and to take-up other public charitable objects.
14. To establish, grant aid to Colleges of Technical Education, Engineering, Colleges, Law Colleges, Management College, Mass Communication College, College of Education and Colleges of Higher Education of any branch etc.
15. To perform any other activity as resolved by the Board of Trustees from time to time for the welfare of society and upliftment of mankind. This may also include establishing a temple of all faiths.
16. The area of activity of the Trust may be the whole of India and also abroad.

2. CORPUS

The amount initially for the running of the trust is Rs. 1000/-
The amount, which the trustees may receive after the execution of this deed with specific direction of forming corpus of the trust shall be subject to a similar control.

3. TRUST PROPERTIES

The trustees shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus and such other properties, moveable or immovable, tangible or intangible, in possession or action as may be acquired from time to time by the trust by purchase, exchange, lease, grant, subscription, donation, contribution, gift will or otherwise in any manner whatsoever or in alteration, improvement or accession of the property, which shall form trust property.

4. POWERS OF TRUSTEES

The entire control, regulation, management, application and administration of the trust properties whether corpus or income, rent, interest or profit, the entire for which the board shall enjoy, interalia the following powers.

- (i) To participate and to work for proceeding the objects either solely or in collaboration or in association with other persons, institutions, missions or authorities or to aid and help other persons, institutions, missions or authorities, engaged in activities enumerated above or to donate for the above causes in cash or kind or provision of services.
- (ii) To receive and collect public donations, subscriptions, contributions and the like and to purchase, acquire and hold moveable and immoveable properties.
- (iii) To acquire property by gift, purchase or lease or by any other mode or transfer to accomplish the above objects and further to exchange, alter or improve the property of the trust and other assets held by the trust or implementing the objects of the trust.
- (iv) To transfer and dispose off the trust properties, moveable and immoveable, by gift, sale lease, exchange or in any other mode whatsoever and to enter into any agreement, negotiation, transaction, conveyance etc. and to sign, execute and get registered any deed, instrument or writing to pass possession and/or title, provided that the monies realized shall be under trust and shall be used for the purposes and objects of the trust
- (v) To operate, maintain or close one or more bank accounts for the trust monies or part thereof and to deposit, invest, draw or over draw in such accounts and to do all such acts in their dealings with Bank or Banks.
- (vi) To invest funds in government and other securities and investments to yield incomes for the applications on objects of the trust.
- (vii) To increase or decrease from time to time the corpus of the trust.
- (viii) To accumulate income of the trust for the objects of the trust.
- (ix) To frame, make and enforce all such rules, regulations and bye-laws not inconsistent with the express provisions of this trust, as they deem proper for the efficient management and administration of the trust properties and carrying out the objects of the trust and also from time to time repeal, alter, rescinded or add to all such rules etc.

- (x) The President will be empowered to appoint, engage, remove, dismiss and suspend any employee for the purpose of the activities of the trust and to do all acts necessary & incidental thereto.
- (xi) To receive out of pockets expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the objects of the trust. Any trustee can be paid honorarium for the work he does for the carrying out the activities of the trust. The amount of honorarium will have to have advance approval of the Board of Trustees.
- (xii) To be indemnified and reimbursed for all lawful acts in the discharge of objects of the trust.
- (xiii) The President may nominate a Secretary and/or a Treasurer out of other trustees for one year at a time, if he desires for the smooth running of the activities of the Trust. In such a case the President will allocate duties and responsibilities to the Secretary / Treasurer. The President may also remove the Secretary or Treasurer before expiry of one year if in his opinion the work of Secretary / Treasurer is not satisfactory.
- (xiv) To fill in any vacancy occurring in the Board of Trustees by death, serious and continuous illness, willful absence, incapacity, resignation or otherwise.
- (xv) To nominate any other person as trustee so long as the total number of trustees does not exceed the limit of eleven trustees.
- (xvi) To raise funds by way of loans, advances, deposits, grants and donations etc from banks, financial institutions, govt. bodies and private parties etc for the purposes of the Trust and to pay interest thereon and also to create charge over trust properties including by way of equitable mortgage and/or in any other form.
- (xvii) To assume all such powers and authority which is not inconsistent with the recitals of this deed and which is conducive or necessary for the promotion of the objects of the trust and intention of the settler as gathered by this deed.

5. **DUTIES OF TRUSTEES**

- (i) Namrata Singh will be Secretary of the Trust.
- (ii) Dr. Ramanand Singh will be the President of the Trust for life. After his death his nominee will be the President. If he dies without nominating any, his senior most legal heir will be the President. The President will keep his nomination in a sealed envelope at a safe and secured place which will be opened after his death. This arrangement will continue in future generations also.
- (iii) The Trustees shall maintain a regular account of all receipts and payments of the trust and shall draw a balance sheet and annual income and expenditure account on such day as may be mutually agreed by the Trustees.
- (iv) The trustees shall after defraying all expenses, liabilities and taxes incurred in realisation of income and maintenance of assets and subject to clause 4 (xi) and 4 (xii) spend trust income on the objects of the trust.
- (v) The trustees shall faithfully discharge the trust reposed in them to the best advantage of the society and in accordance with the terms of this deed. If any trustee fails to do so, or acts against the interest of the Trust, he can be discharged from his office by the settler of the Trust or the board of trustees.

6. **PROHIBITIONS OF TRUSTEES**

The trustees shall be prohibited from:-

- (i) Making any distinction or discrimination in the beneficiaries on the ground of caste or religion except in favour of Scheduled castes, Scheduled tribes and backward classes.
- (ii) Receiving any, remuneration, for the conduct of the trust, subject however to clause 4(xi) and 4 (xii) above.
- (iii) Deriving any direct or indirect pecuniary advantage out of the trust properties, income or application thereof, for themselves and their relatives and associates:
- (iv) Spending the trust properties on any object which is not enumerated in clause (ii) above
- (iv) Acting against the interest of the Trust.

7. PARAMOUNT CLAUSE

It is mutually considered that the objects of the trust shall be better achieved, if the income of the trust is exempt under the Income-Tax Act. In case, however, any clause or sub-clause of this deed has been inadvertently clothed in a language capable of interpretations in conflict with relevant provisions of Income Tax Laws granting exemption, it is hereby agreed and declared that such clause or sub-clause shall have restricted meaning.

8. DISPUTES

Any disputes or differences not resolved by the Board of trustee in respect of the objects of the trust, interpretation of this deed, the settlers intention, the powers, the duties, prohibitions and obligations of the trustees or otherwise shall be referred to Arbitration to which the provisions of the Arbitration Act shall apply and the Award shall be binding on all concerned.
