The **MEMO** of Trust made this 15th day of November 2002 between **SHRI SURESH KUMAR GUPTA** (the **RA**) hereinafter the **1st** Member Part Mortgage (PM), hereinafter called "THE **SETTLOR**" whose signature shall unless excluded by or referred to the contrary be deemed to include his successors administrators and representatives of the **1st** PM and **SHRI P. N. GUPTA** (the **2nd** **RA**) hereinafter the **2nd** Part Mortgage (PM) hereinafter called "THE **TRUSTEES**" (whose signature shall unless excluded by or referred to the contrary be deemed to include the trustee or trustees for the time being of these presents and their successors in office of the **1st** PM)

- (a) The **SETTLOR** is desirous of establishing a **TRUST FUND** for public charitable objects for general public.
- (b) The **Trustees** here on the request of said **SETTLOR** agreed to act as **Life Trustees**, under this **MEMORANDUM OF TRUST** to be followed :-

1. In order to effectuate the said intent the **SETTLOR** has made over to the **Trust** a **Trustee** was **ATUL KUMAR GUPTA** (hereinafter only to hold the same together with all other properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise and may hereafter be subject to the **TRUST** hereinafter referred to as the **TRUST FUND**) for the objects and purposes hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions here in contained concerning the same.
2. The name of the **TRUST** shall be **SHRI. JAWLA B. EDUCATIONAL TRUST**.
3. The head office of the **TRUST FUND** shall be at 15, Mohan Park Marg, Delhi (hereinafter **Delhi**) or at such other place or places in India as the trustees may from time to time think fit.
4. The object for which the **TRUST FUND** is established are :-
 (a) Relief of the poor, education, medical relief, and the advancement of any other object of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit and for such purposes as
- (b) To acquire, maintain and use Technical Educational College for B.E., I.T.E., M.B.A., M.C.A. etc.

20. All the Administrative powers of the Trust for the time being will be vested with the chairman of the Trust or as time to time decided by the 2/3rd majority of the Trustees.

21. The Trustees can from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulation of the meeting of the TRUSTEES.

In the absence of such regulations :-

(a) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for meeting of the Trustees.

(b) All the Matters will be decided by a majority of votes and in case of any equality of votes, the chairman shall have a second or casting vote.

(c) Resolutions passed without any meeting of Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidence in writing under hands of two third of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the TRUSTEES.

(d) All the proceedings of the meeting of Trustees shall be entered in the minute book and shall be signed by chairman of meeting.

22. ACCOUNTS & AUDIT

(a) A statement of accounts shall be made out every year and passed by the Board of Trustees.

(b) Once atleast in every year the accounts of the Trust shall be examined and the correctness of the same certified by an Audited Chartered Accountant.

23. WINDING UP :-

The TRUSTEES shall have the power to wind up the powers to wind up the business or any of them forming part of the Trust Estate and to start other business as they may think fit in the same and intent with power to them also to invest from time to time the Trust Estate or any part thereof in the purchase of any immovable property or properties and to dispose off the same as and when the Trustees shall think fit & proper.

24. The TRUST here by created shall be irrevocable.

25. It is expressly declared that no part of Trust property or its income or TRUST FUND shall be applied for any purpose, which is not a public charitable purpose in law and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.
