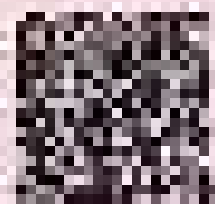


# System of Management of Human Resources

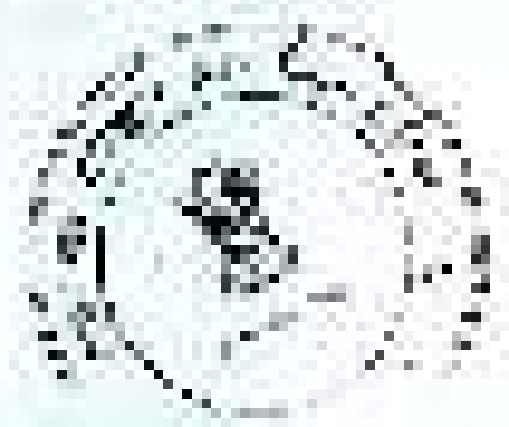
**Human Resource Management**

**Figure 1. The study design.**

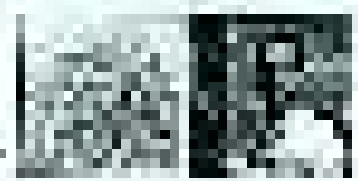
