The Public Charitable Trust Deed is made at Shami (Prabudh Nagar) on 30 November 2011 by Sri Deepak Jain S/o Sri Jiya Lal Jain R/o 39 Hanuman Road, Shami, Dist. Prabudh Nagar (U.P.) hereinafter called the 'SETTLER' (Which Expression shall unless be excluded by repugnant to the subject or context be deemed to include his heirs, executors, administrators, assigns And representatives) of the FOUNDER OF THE ONE PART and

...EAS, the settler is desirous to establish a Public Charitable trust for the welfare of the community in general and specially to Jain community. The Trustees have at the request of settler agreed to act as trustees of these presents upon the terms and conditions hereinafter contained.

BY THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

1. In order to affectuate the said object of creating and establishing a Public Charitable Trust, the settler has delivered to and made over to the trustees a sum of Rs. 5100/- (Rupees Five thousand One Hundred only) with intention to part with all his rights, titles and interest claim therein and vest the same in the trustees to have and to hold and The investment or investments for the time being the same and all other properties that may for the time being represent the Trust Estate together with all additions and accretions thereto and all accumulated income thereof and all other property or properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise may hereafter be subject to the trust (hereinafter referred to as 'THE TRUST FUND') for the charitable objects and purposes and uses hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions hereip contained concerning the same.
2. The Name of the Trust shall be:
"SHRI. J.T. JAIN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST"
3. The OFFICE of the Trust shall be situated a 39, Hanuman Road Sharnli, Distt.-Prabudh Nagar which may be changed from time to time to such other place or places as the Trustees may deem fit and proper at their discretion.
4. The Trust could have its unit offices at any place in India and Abroad.
5. Those who are Trustees for the purpose, declare that Founder Deepak Kumar Jain will continue to be the Executive Trustee of the Trust and one of the Trustees for his life time.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST :-

The trust shall be a voluntary, non-political, non-profit making charitable & social service endowment/ organisation, established to promote quality of education for the society or so, It shall support the educationally backward and economically weaker sections, living in Rural/Urban areas of India. The aims and objects of this trust are aimed at furtherance of the constitutional Guarantees under section 19(1) and (2)

Trust is created for carrying out all objects specially including Jain Beneficial and the Following objects for Public charity within India or outside India and benefit of the society.

To Provide, Promote the restructuring of higher education facilities in the fields of commerce, Medical, Engineering, Management, Computer Science, Technical, Professional and Vocational Courses, Nursery, Primary Middle and Secondary/Senior Secondary Education for the needy Students, Intellectuals and other persons of the society:

To establish acquire, construct, maintain and run group of faculties, universities in different fields, colleges, institutions, polytechnic for imparting all sorts of education in the fields of medical, paramedical, engineering, management, vocational courses and nursery, primary, middle and secondary/senior secondary education in India or outside India to children, boys and girls and to men and women.

To establish, acquire, purchase, construct, maintain and run auditorium, sports complex, sports school, play grounds for furtherance of skills of sports athletes etc.

To open, run and assist libraries and Book Banks, Rendering help or assistance for any public charitable purpose and national cause.

To do all such acts and activities for the upliftment of handicaps jains & scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward and minority classes of the society:

To collaborate with other trusts/Societies/ Organizations which are pursuing objectives similar to those of this trust:

To innovate skill up-gradation programmes aimed at correcting the psyche behind child labour, and to assist in the implementation of lateral entry of suitable students into higher courses, skill up-gradation courses for the working professionals, and adult-education; more so, to provide support for such students from the educationally backward and economically weaker sections of society as wish to appear at NTSE (NCERT), UPSC preliminary exams, tests conducted by the NITs, and the various competitive admission tests.

To accept Tuition Fees, donations, grants, M.P.'s/M.L.A.'s Funds, presents and other offerings and to deal with the Same for the purposes of the trust

To change moderate tuition fees and/or otherwise recoup themselves for the outlay and expenses incurred in the upkeep and maintenance of institutions/colleges established or about to be established under the Deed

To establish acquire, purchase, construct, maintain hospitals, health care centres, recreational centres, diagnostic centres, nursing schools, nursing homes, Rehabilitation centre/clinics for orphan, creches, Boarding/Residential schools, old age home(s) and convalescent home (s) With up to date facilities maternity home(s), Working women hostels, child welfare centres and dispensaries, educational/job oriented training programmes for the benefit of the public in general.

To devise systems & approaches for qualitative education, and to develop a scientific process of evaluation of the pupils, educational programmes and institutions; and to develop Educational Technology for better teaching & learning methods, as also to provide Distance Educational—wherever permissible by the concerned official Authority;

To assist and support the implementation of the National Policy on Education in an effective manner, especially with regard to its provisions relating to the educationally backward classes;






To educate people about rain water harvesting, solar energy and assist them.






To enter into any agreement or arrangement with any other society, foundation or any other party having any legal authority or any individual for smooth functioning and achievements of the objectives of the Trust in a better way.

(i) To establish, acquire, purchase, construct, maintain community centres, Yoga and Meditation centres, Dharamshalas, rest houses etc for the benefit of any member of the society at large.

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
(ii) To establish, organize, build, erect, maintain and to take over, to run religious places for conducting meetings, prayers, services for the mental and spiritual upliftment and benefits of the general public.

To pay out stipends and scholarships on such terms, if any, as deemed fit and as may be commensurate with the income of the trust

The trust is a public charitable institution and has not been started with a view to earn any profits; all income of the trust or institutions run by the trust shall be utilized towards promotions of aims and objectives of the trust only. No benefits will be derived, directly or indirectly, by the founder trustee of one part and trustees on the other part. The Trust has been established to do all acts for the benefit of general public, belonging to any caste, creed or religion.

- a) Any movable and immovable properties purchased or acquired on lease or otherwise including pieces of land or built properties thereon of any kind under any name and style for the use of Trust and fulfilment of its objectives will be the assets of the trust.
- v) To undertake all such activities as are not specifically mentioned in the aims and objects listed above, but which are likely to promote these objectives.
- w) To start and assist the relief measures in those parts of the country which become affected by natural calamities like famine, fire flood, earthquakes etc
- x) To promote national Integration, Communal Harmony, Universal Brotherhood Global Peace.
- y) To promote and advocate Human Right and Fundamental Freedom for all without any discrimination of race, colour, sex and language.
- z) To develop and mobilize Community and Natural Resources to give the right direct to people of the marginalized and economically weaker sections of the trust for their sustainable overall development.
- aa) To work for the special concentration for the Child & Women Welfare.
- bb) To explore ways for promotion of socioeconomic development in the community.




To conduct research studies on the social an economic conditions of people with a view to involving ways and means for their development within their social historical frame works and to seek promotion of rural development such as provision of drinking water, rural industrialization as well as Public convenience for people.





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
TRUSTEES AND THEIR APPOINTMENTS:




- a) Trustees (so called "Founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the other part") above named shall be the First trustees of the Trust for their life.
- b) The descendants of the "founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the other part" shall hold the office of the trust in their place for their respective lives after death. In case the number of descendents are more than one "Founder of the One part" and "Trustees of The other part" shall name the decedents who will inherit the chain as "Founder of the One part" and "Trustees of the Other parts" after his death only with the consent of "Founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the other part". In the event of non-existence of the "founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the other part" or his descendents, the nominee, of the "founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the Other part" respectively shall become the "founder of the One part" and "Trustees of the other parts" and the nomination by WILL or otherwise shall be kept in total secrecy till the death of the "Founder of the one Part" and "Trustees of the other part" The nomination shall be made known to the board of trustees in presence of all other trustees.
- c) In the event of a Trustee intending to withdraw from the trust or submitting his resignation the same may be allowed by the board of Trustees by simple majority decision and with the prior approval of the Chairman.
- d) Any vacancy of the trustee shall be filled up, on the approval of simple majority of the existing trustees for the period upto the ensuing annual general meeting and the same shall be considered with the prior consent of the Chairman.
- e) The Chairman shall have full and final authority to co-opt any person as a trustee of the Trust at any point.
- f) In any circumstances and eventualities the "Founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the other part" cannot be removed or impeached by any resolution of the trustees either by an individual in the capacity of trustee or by collective decision.
- g) The administration of the trust shall be vested in the trustees, who shall not be less than two in numbers, one of whom shall be the Founder of the one part or the descendants of his families and trustee of the other part or the descendants of their family and shall be known collectively as the board of trustees and all decisions of whatsoever nature pertaining to trust shall actively be taken by the principle of simple majority in writing and in case of any

dispute whatsoever the decision of the "Founder of the one part" shall be final and binding in all respect. The number of trustees may be enhanced/ reduced (not exceeding 9) at the discretion of founder of the one part" and "trustees of the other part" at any point of time.

OFFICE BEARRERS OF THE TRUST :

The office bearers of the trust shall be appointed either from the existing trustees or public by the "Founder of the one part" and "Trustees of the other part" either by selection or by nomination or by mutual consent. The following will be the office bearers of the trust:

- a) Sri Jiya Lal Jain - Patron
- b) Sri Deepak Jain - Chairman
- c) Smt. Nisha Jain - Vice-Chairman
- d) Sri Dinesh Kumar Jain - Secretary
- e) Smt. Geeta Jain - Treasurer

f) Such other posts as may be deemed necessary for the functioning of the trust or for all or any institution run, by the trust for a specified period of time can be created in writing during such appointments.

- a) The post of chairman shall be occupied by Shri Deepak Jain S/o Shri Jiya Lal Jain Founder of the one part and shall be a non-remunerative post.
- b) The post of Vice-Chairman shall be occupied by Smt. Nisha Jain trustee of the other part.

POWERS & FUNCTIONS OF THE PATRON OF THE TRUST:

In case of any dispute between The Chairman of 'One Part' and The Trustees of 'Other Part' & subsequently and failure, The Patron will have the right to execute his power for settlement in the interest & benefit of the Trust.

POWERS & FUNCTIONS OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TRUST:

The Secretary and all executives shall be appointed by the chairman of the trust to accomplish with the objectives of the Trust or institutions/college(s) of the Trust to their best in all respect. The Chairman of the Trust shall be the link between the executive officers viz. Director or any other office bearer and the Board of Trustees. Chairman shall be having all powers which trustee or Trustees

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jointly or severally or any other officer by whatever name called, can exercise within their powers in the interest and in accomplishment of any or all aims and objects of the Trust.

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE VICE -CHAIRMAN:

The vice Chairman shall discharge the duties of the chairman, in his absence and shall execute the power and authority as delegated and assigned to Chairman including his own other duties.

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARY:

Secretary shall be responsible for calling a meeting with the approval of the Chairman and recording all minutes and resolutions passed or rejected in the house of meeting of the Trust and implement the decisions of the Board of the Trustees.

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE TREASURER:


The treasurer will be responsible to collect various funds, keep Books and records of accounts from time to time and perform such financial duties as and when directed by the Chairman of Board of Trustees

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF MEMBERS:

Any member including office Bearers may request the chairman/secretary for calling a meeting of Board of Trustees within one week's time in case of urgency. The chairman/secretary will participate in the discussion for resolving matters of interest of the trust.






POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES :

- a) All the policy decisions shall be taken by the Board of Trustees and conveyed Subject to the approval of The Chairman for implementation.
- b) In case of any dispute arising on any decision, the verdict of "Chairman" shall be considered as final and binding by the Board of Trustees.
- c) Without prejudice to the general powers conferred by the last proceedings clause and other powers conferred by these presents, it is hereby expressly declared that the Trustees shall have the following Powers :
 - i. To pass accounts of the Trust and consider any recommendation made in this regard at the Annual General Meeting.
 - ii. To invest in safe bonds, FDR's of bank/institutions/corporate, debentures, stock, securities etc not prohibited by provisions under income Tax Act, 1961 or under any or all other govt. Statutes.





- III. To secure and enter into any contract or engagement on behalf of the trust, compound or abandon any legal proceedings by or against the trust and to refer any matters, claims or demands or to arbitrate, observe and perform the awards.
- IV. To set up independently or in collaboration with Foreign institutions or university, constitute and organize local branches of the Trust in India or abroad and in such manner and on such terms as may be considered necessary in the interest of the trust and to constitute committees consisting of two or more persons, not necessarily members of the Trust and delegate them such powers and vary the same as may be considered for the purpose.
- V. To accept grant, donations and contributions in cash or in other kind from other public bodies, corporations, associations, institutions, companies or individuals with in India or abroad, for the purpose of the Trust.
- VI. To draw, accept, endorse discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bill of exchange and other negotiable transferable instruments in the interest of the trust.
- VII. To provide funds for all or any objectives of the Trust in such manner as may be considered expedient.
- VIII. To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any movable or immovable property, and in particular any land, buildings, workshops connected with privileges necessary for or consistent with the purpose of the trust and to construct, erect, alter improve and maintain any building and to manage, develop, sell demise, let, mortgage, dispose off, or in any manner or otherwise deal with the same and also to sell the undertaking to Trust for cash or any other consideration with a view to promote the objectives of the Trust.
- IX. To pay all expenses, preliminary or incidental to the formation of the trust and its registration.
- X. To make rules and regulations and bye laws for smooth and successful running the affairs of the trust in a better and planned way and to amend or alter the same. Intimation of such amendments in Trust deed shall be promptly made to the concerned Registrar of Trusts.

- XI. To fulfil the objects of the Trust and to do all other things Trustees are empowered to run the affairs under the name and style of the Trust i.e. "J.T. JAIN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST" and to open separate institution independently or in collaboration with Foreign Institution to be under any name and style to fulfil the aims and objects of the trust.
- XII. To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person.
- XIII. To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security, in accordance with rules and regulations of the Trust and all statutes in application of such funds.
- XIV. Trustees shall not do such things or acts which may, directly or indirectly, accrue in any benefits or bad effects expressly or impliedly to the Founder trustee of one part and to Other Trustee(s).
- XV. To establish, support or aid the needy people of the society and do all such activities necessary in furtherance of the objects of the Trust.
- XVI. To open one or more bank accounts and operate the same or provide for operation of the said accounts by Chairman or Chairman jointly with Secretary/ Treasurer. In the absence of Secretary/Treasurer, any of the Trustees may be authorized by the Board of Trustees by a resolution, to operate the bank accounts.
- XVII. Powers to take any loan from Banks/Financial Institutes. Mortgaging the movable and/or immovable assets will be vested with any of the Trustees subject to mutual consideration and approval of the Board.
- XVIII. To borrow funds from Govt. financial institutions, banks or from anybody, corporate or otherwise on interest or without interest in fulfilment of the objectives of the trust i.e. to purchase land, construct buildings, Projects, equipments, books etc. and all their movable or immovable properties which are required for the fulfilment of the objectives of the Trust for which the Trustees are empowered to execute all necessary documents for borrowing the funds.
- XIX. The societies/Management committees/other committees constituted to run various institutions/-schools/colleges etc. Will be solely formed by the board of trustees as per norms laid by affiliating university/board/councils etc. In case aforesaid bodies found functioning inappropriately, the same will be dissolved by the board of trustees by majority of votes. The board of trustees will have the right





to include or exclude the general/ nominated/ elected members of management committee as per the circumstances of the case. The procedure of formation of societies/ Management committees/other committees will be taking care of by board of trustees or a person or person appointed/ nominated out of public at large by the board of trustees. The Trustees of the Trust shall be the office bearers of societies/Management committees/other committees so formed. The members or any of office bearer, if required as per norms laid by affiliating university/board/councils etc. Shall be nominated by the Board of Trustees out of the public at large.

- XX. To execute powers of attorney to any person for the purpose of executing, administering or managing the whole or any part of the Trust for the purpose of all or some among the objects of the Trust.
- XXI. To receive, collect and enforce recovery of all monies due or payable to the Trust and grant receipts and discharges therefore.
- XXII. To settle, compromise or compound any disputes or refer the same to arbitration or litigation. The Board of Trustees will follow the instructions given by any donor who makes substantial contribution towards furtherance of the objects of the Trust, so long as such instructions are not detrimental to the attainment of the objects of the Trust and are in conformity with the provisions of the income-tax Act, 1961.

32. RULES OF THE TRUST :

- a) Every meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be chaired by the Chairman and in his absence Vice-Chairman shall chair the meeting.
- b) Such a meeting shall be hold once in three months or within a period as decided by the Board of Trustees.
- c) Two members of the Board of Trustees present in person shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Trust.
- d) Chairman/secretary may call any requisition in writing a meeting of the trust at any Time.
- e) For official purpose, each year shall be deemed to commence from 1st April and terminate on 31st March.
- f) i) Each member of the Board of Trustees shall have one vote.
ii) Where there is deadlock in regard to any particular issue, the decision of

the Chairman and in the absence the Vice Chairman shall prevail and binding to all.

- g) The Board of Trustees may, by General or special order, direct that any resolution, to be placed before the meetings, may be passed by circulation amongst all the trustees. Any resolution so circulated and approved by a majority of the trustees signing the circular shall be as effective and binding as if such resolutions had been passed by / at a meeting of the Board of Trustees and approve by the Chairman
- h) To manage, sell transfer, let out by way of tenancy, lease, license or otherwise dispose off or deal with the assets/properties of any kind both movable or immovable belongings to the Trust.
- i) Any movable and immovable properties including pieces of land or built properties thereon of any kind under any name and style for the use of Trust and fulfilment of its objectives will be the assets of the trust
- j) To enter into any agreement or arrangement with any other society, foundation or any other party having any legal entity or any individual for smooth functioning and achievements of the objectives of the Trust in a better way

Provided that if anyone or more of the purposes or objects specified hereinabove are held not to be the purpose or objects of a public charitable nature, the trustees shall not carry out such purposes or objects by the validity of the trust created by these presents as a Trust for public charitable objects or purpose shall not be effected in any manner.

13. TRUSTEES AND THEIR APPOINTMENTS:


Trustees (those so called as the founder of one Part the Trustees of the other part) above named shall be the first Trustees of the Trust for the life.

14. RECORDINGS OF PROCEEDINGS:

An office bears or any person nominated by Board of Trustees will record all resolution of proceedings of the meetings of the board of trustees. Such minutes shall be signed by the Chairman, Secretary and other Trustees who were present in the meetings.

15. MEETING OF THE TRUSTEES:

- a) The Annual General Meeting of the Trust comprising of the Trustees once every year at such time not being more than 15 months after the last preceding Annual General Body Meeting shall be held at such time, date & place as may be



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determined by the Chairman, and subject to the following rules, it shall be determined by the Trust's chairman.

A minimum of 10 clear days notice shall be given for every Annual General Meeting to every Trustee containing the agenda for the meeting.

All other meeting of the Trustees shall be called extraordinary meetings.

Notice of meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be sent under postal certificate and shall be deemed to have been served if addressed to the Trustees at the address given for the purpose.

PROCEEDINGS OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

The business of an Annual General Meetings shall be:

To place the accounts balance sheet and the report of the auditors and of the Board of Trustees.

To elect such trustees whose terms have expired or have ceased to the trustees.

At any meeting, a declaration by the chairman of the meeting that a resolution has been made unanimously or by a particular majority or lost or not carried out, and an entry to the effect in the minutes Book shall be conclusive evidence of the fact.

The Chairman of the meeting may adjourn the same from time to time and from place to place but no business other than the business of the meetings shall be transacted at such adjourned meetings unless and until any other issue brought on Agenda by the Chairman or Board of Trustees during such meetings.

BORROWINGS:

To borrow funds from Govt. Financial institutions, bank or from anybody, corporate or otherwise on interest or without interest in fulfilment of the objectives of the trust i.e. to purchase land, construct buildings, Projects, equipments, books etc., and all their movable or immovable properties, which are required for the fulfilment of the objectives of the Trust for which the Trustees are empowered to execute all necessary documents for borrowing the funds as mentioned above. The Trust can borrow loans on all properties which are in the name and style for the use of trust for the fulfilment of its objectives.

13. BANKERS AND OPERATION:

The accounts of the Trust will be opened through Bank, jointly by the signatures of the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. The operation/transactions of the accounts will be done jointly with the signatures of any two of them quoted above.



The board of Trustees are authorized to raise loans to gain credit from any bank or any other financial institutions and to execute the necessary borrowing documents or create lien or the scurrilities of the Trust to secure the borrowing as per present or future needs of the trust. In case of disputes/differences in this regard the decision of chairman shall be final.
- II. Restrictions for application of Trust Fund: It is expressly cleared that on part of the Trust Property, its income or trust shall be utilized or applied for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose under the income tax act 1961 and all revisions thereof shall be constructed accordingly.

20. POWER TO MAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS:

a) It shall lawful for the Board of Trustees & Executives from time to time frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the trust and its charities as they shall think fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time provided that such rules shall not be consistent with the terms and consistent of these presents. It shall be lawful to make amendments if unanimously agreed upon by the

Trustees (all) for the time being in the provisions of these presents on their own accord or at the directions of the income tax authorities

which the Trustees may be required to make to fulfil the conditions for sections 80-G of the income tax act, 1961 or any other statutory modifications of re-enactment thereof for the time being in force but without prejudice to the main objects of the trust.

The points where no express provision has been made in these presents the provisions of the India trust act, 1882 and the Statutory Modifications thereof shall apply.

Any money required to be invested by these presents shall be in the name of the Trust. The trust or trustees shall have power from time to time to vary any securities and investments held by the trustees hereunder provided that no investments or application of the trust fund shall be made in contravention of the provision by the section 13 of the Income Tax act, 1961 as amended from time to time. All money forming part of the Trust Fund, and requiring investment shall be invested had to, conveyance or other assurance in respect of any immovable property of properties forming part of the Trust for the time being of these presents.

RESTRICTIONS:

No amendments to the Trust Deed shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

21. ACCOUNTING AND AUDIT:


The Trust shall maintain proper account and other relevant records, and prepare annual reports, Statement of Account in such form as may be prescribed. The Accounts of the Trust shall be audited annually by the Chartered Accountants duly appointed by the Trust, and any expenditure incurred in connection with the audit of accounts of the Trust shall be payable by the trust.

22. ANNUAL ACCOUNTING:

An Annual Report of the proceedings of the Trust and of the work undertaken during the year shall be prepared by the Secretary and presented to the Board of Trustees at least thirteen day in advance of the Annual General Meeting for information and consideration.

23. INDEMNITY:

The trustee shall be fully keep indemnified and harmless by the trust against any action and claim loss suffered or liability that arises against them, on account of anything done by them in good faith in pursuance of the powers and authority

In the event of winding up to the trust the corpus of the trust shall be transferred to some other charitable trust or institutions or society having the same or similar objects or as mutually decided by all trustees for charitable cause but the trustees and settler shall not entitled to share in funds of the trust at any stage

25- GENERAL

- a) If the board to trustees desire to incorporate any objectives within the basic frame works of the trust, it shall be done at a special meeting called by the Chairman/Secretary for the Purpose by present or by proxy
- b) The income and property of the Trust shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objectives of the trust no Portion/Portions thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, gift, division, bonus or otherwise by way of profits to the trustees of the trust
- c) Any property (movable or immovable) including piece of land, purchased directly in the name of institutions/colleges/societies by the trust and constructed for the collegel/institutions/societies or for the use/purpose of Trust to fulfilment of its objectives will be the assets of the trust. The functional/management committee of institutions/colleges/societies will be formed by the board of trustees

d) Any Change/Alterations in the Trust Deed or its byelaws can be made at any time with the mutual consideration & decisions of the Board of Trust

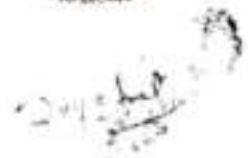
