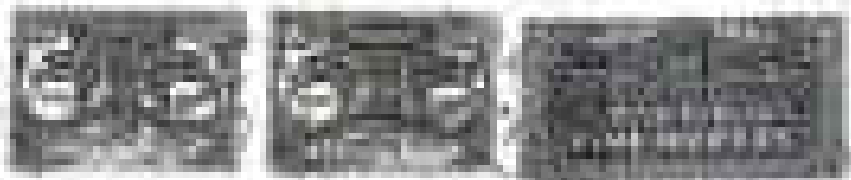

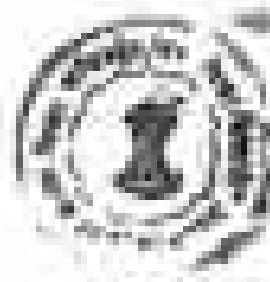

1880-81
