Under the title of Property referred to as the Trust Fund which comprises that also includes cash and any other property and investments of any kind, whatsoever into which the trustee or any person himself might be interested, received or raised from time to time in such sum or property as may be required by the Trustees in their sole discretion by virtue of these powers or by operation of law or otherwise for proper distribution to those persons upon the event and with the subject to the present, prospective, agreements and directions hereinbefore declared, expressed and contained.

NAME:- That the name of the Trust shall be SHRI GANPATI DEGRADADIR EDUCATIONAL TRUST hereinafter to be used of property referred to as the Trust and registered office shall be situated at SHRI, BHAVANI NAGAR, CHINTA BAHRI, ALAMBADI, LUCKNOW - 226005, in the State of Uttar Pradesh and / or such other place or places as the Trustees herein may decide from time to time.

OBJECTS:- That the objects for which the Trust is founded are:

- (i) To establish open, nominal and non-Educational Institutions, Schools, Colleges, Research Institute including Medical College, Dental College, Engineering College for providing quality education and research and health.

- (i) To spread education and for achieving the said object to establish, maintain, develop and improve, extend, grant, recover donations in cash and kind and trust to the institutions, associations, trusts, development, improvement and extension of schools, colleges, universities, basic education, workshops, industrial and vocational, and technical schools, banks, institutes for the promotion of agriculture, banks for the benefit of needy students, pensioner organisations for the benefit of the poor;
- (ii) To give scholarships, prizes, bursaries, loans, and other assistance;
- (iii) To establish, maintain or acquire library or libraries for the benefit of the students prominently;
- (iv) To instruct and give encouragement to the needy for the study, research and apprenticeship for all classes of the aforesaid educational purposes;
- (v) To serve the Government cause and to help, assist, take care of disabled, sick, injured, old and deceased and handicapped and sick persons by way of relief.



missions of business including provision of medicines, medical services or pharmaceuticals, devices, building tools / shelter during such treatment, medical aids etc through one thousand seven hundred twenty five hospitals, medical aids, Mental Dispensaries, Clinics, Nursing homes, Free Clinics, Medical Colleges, Model Clinics, Free Clinics, Ambulance stations, Welfare dispensary etc., like institution / body or trustee for treatment of patients as well as supply and sale.

- (iii) To afford medical aid and care of sick and infirm to labour poor, needy and deserving persons.
- (iv) To establish institutions and various agencies, places of religious assemblies, dispensaries, orphanages, Homes for Destitute women, Old Age Homes, Handicapped Welfare and Treatment Centres, Day and Night Help and Rehabilitation Centres, Explorers Guidance Centre, Orphanage, Adoption and care of sick and disabled cases and orphans.
- (v) To serve the poor and underprivileged sections of the society and to undertake social welfare programmes for the poor and underprivileged sections of the society, including old, women and children.
- (D) To provide education and training for Architects, Physicians, and related services including religious robes and ornaments, education and research services including those related to ayurveda and yoga.
- (E) To engage in other unauthorised programmes for social welfare development and promotion including institutional ATMs, Comm. Enhancement by giving loans and other relief and/or other social services.
- (F) To promote help, assist by cash or in kind the poor families to run his/her home or family as well as to give financial assistance for the storage of grains and pulses.

- (iii) To carry out programme for welfare of the weaker sections of the society and also for development of backward areas and rural areas of the country.
- (iv) To assist the deserving unemployed uneducated persons for setting up their own cottage industry, business or vocations, etc. and to assist the needy to achieve their Goals.
- (v) To construct, help, assist, maintain dispensaries, ashrams, ashrams, hospitals and make provisions for drinking water, general sanitation in residential colonies to provide assistance in cash or in kind to people struck and affected by natural calamities like Drought, Famine, Flood, Earthquake, etc. to provide hinge services for social, good and welfare of the people and / or promote family planning promoting social security.
- (vi) To donate / help / give / any other public charitable and religious trusts for promoting the above objects of this Trust.
- (vii) To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above mentioned objects or any of them; and it is hereby declared that the incorporation of any of the aforesaid objects and in the event of any ambiguity they shall be construed by the Board of Trustees in such a way so as to widen and not to curtail the objects of the Trust.
- (viii) To establish open, materials and play the promotional and guiding role for imparting the training and education and to conduct and run it.

For the removal of doubts, if any, it is hereby declared that this Trust and its implementation shall not be against the objects of the Trust as mentioned in above clause.

THE TRUST:

The trustee of the trust is as follows:

To pay and apply the principal to the first person from time to time the sole payment of principal, charges and expenses of and incidentals to the collection thereof and the mystery.



Received for the payment, maintenance, insurance, fees, wages and salaries of employees and other charges which may be related to or connected with the trust property and management of the Trust fund including the charges and expenses of and incident to the trust and pertaining thereto and the costs, charges and expenses of the preparation of the accounts, statements, returns and all additional matters from time to time.

That the administration of the income or corpus of the Trust towards the use and uses of the objects mentioned hereinabove shall be made by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

That the Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to reduce the income and for the purpose of the Trust for any one or more of the objects aforesaid and in such proportion as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.

If the income, exclusive of dividends and contributions to a particular year, is not fully utilized for any one or more of the aforesaid objects, the Board of Trustees shall be entitled to accumulate and carry forward the unexpended income to the next year or years.

That the Board of Trustees shall name and include the Trustees of their present, services or services of those and the Trustees for the class holding of these presents. The Trustees for the time being shall be entitled to appoint new Trustees to fill up the vacancy caused by death, resignation or removal (or otherwise). The minimum number of Trustees shall be two and the maximum shall be seven.

Without limiting the generality of the power of the Board of Trustees, the Board of Trustees shall be empowered:

Having a Committee to hold and in possession of the Trust Fund and its properties.

Dealing with the lands, crops and stocks, documents, securities, instruments, goods, gifts, benefactions and in each or in kind or in interestable or leaseable properties for all or any of the objects of the trust.



Nature of Assets: To determine in case of the marriage or death whether any money or property received be considered as capital or income and whether out of the income or capital any expenses or outgoings shall be paid or borne or ought to be paid or borne.

Immovable Properties: To buy and acquire or sell and dispose off by public auction or private contract or exchange or transfer or lease or sub-lease or dispose or otherwise any immovable property on such terms and conditions as they may think fit and proper from time to time and in furtherance of the above to carry into any agreements or arrangements with the powers of or persons appointed to say other properties.

Investments: To invest the Trust fund and all income in their hand which may require investments in or specify one or more of the following securities or mode of the following securities or mode of investments with power from time to time at their discretion or vary any investments and securities held by the Trust for other objects of the charitable trust authorized namely:

1. Any stock or shares issued by or the payment of the principal and interest thereon shall be guaranteed by the Government of India or the Government of any State of the Republic of India.
2. Debenture, Debenture Stock or Ordinary Stock or shares of any company so fixed or otherwise upon the amount or dividend on which the expenses of principal or which are guaranteed by the Government of India or the Government of any State of the Republic of India.
3. Or fixed on other deposit with established institution and a guaranteed bank or banks.

4. Any security or instrument authorized by the law (see Art. 795) and/or
Instrument Law (Art. 266).

Sale/Lease/Transfer:

To dispose of the assets, securities, instruments and other documents relating to the Trust property for such validity as a selected nationalized bank or banks and to make the necessary arrangements for realization of value of dividends on investments of the trust through bank and to give the charge payment to the bank for response.

Construction:

To construct, pull down, renovate, repair, alter, adapt, improve, develop, repair, increase or enhance any immovable property and to subscribe any subscription or contribution as it may think fit to do any and or kind of the foregoing acts or deeds and to do such other acts, deeds and things which are considered necessary or expedient from time to time.

Leasing:

To obtain, set up, maintain, manage and supervise all long-termments with the, whether set up and created by this trust or otherwise, for sufficient remuneration of up to one or more of the objects of the trust.

Granting Ownership:

To decide, whether to cash or kind any part of the trust property in any manner carrying out any use or uses of the objects of the trust in accordance and conditions as it may think fit.

Acquisition/Liquidation Properties:

To acquire immovable or movable properties for the trust and likewise have to sell, lease or exchange or otherwise deal with such properties in the interest of the trust.

General Power: To (not) keep for any one or more of the purposes aforesaid in such terms and conditions as it may think fit.

Designation of trustee: To choose and, if deem fit to accept nomination nominate as trustee by this end of the trustees in these powers:

Agents and Attorneys: To appoint, employ and pay and remunerate agents or attorneys for such purposes and with such authorities and for such periods and subject to such conditions as it may think fit and to authorise and remunerate of the expenses of such persons.

Employee: Appoint, employ, reward and remove such officers, clerks, servants and employees as required, inspecting or special services as and when and whenever it may think fit and to make the necessary rules, regulations and provisions relating to the same.

Corporate Identity: To obtain, confirm, define, compound, compromise or settle any legal proceeding by or against the Trust or otherwise managing the affairs of the trust in accordance with law and practice and usage and moreover to make all necessary documents.

And generally, to do and cause to do all other or incidental necessary expeditious and convenient to the attainment of the objects of this charter or for the uses as specified in agreement or otherwise.

APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF THE TRUSTEES

The above MENTIONED person and the Managing Trustees of the Trust during their lifetime and during their period of appointment, over the affairs of the trust and shall have in particular the power to open the bank accounts of the Trust, borrow money for the trust, make all arrangements of the trust at convenient times, to execute all the documents for and on behalf of the trust.

- behalf of the Trust, whether legal or otherwise, to nominate the Board of Trustees and to appoint members to the Board of Trustees and to execute all such documents and alter any procedures as may be required for the purpose as well as to effect any change in the incorporation of the Board of Trustees and to delegate the powers of the Managing Trustees to any person, whether or not such person is a member in trust of the Trust or not, and to carry out the objects of the Trust.
- (ii) That the Managing Trustees shall preside over the meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- (iii) In the event of absence of the Managing Trustees in particular meeting of the Board of Trustees, one or more than one of them and any alternate of them to preside over the meeting.
- (iv) The trustees shall have power to accept donations in money or otherwise for the purpose of this trust.
- (v) The Board of Trustees shall do such other lawful things as are incidental in carrying out the administration and management of the Trust.
- (vi) The Trustees may open and operate current or saving or other accounts with any Scheduled Bank, Nationalised Banks and the branches authorising any one or more of the trustees either singly or jointly or severally to operate on such accounts.
- (vii) **Meetings:** The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as may be necessary or convenient to transact business and take the usual by circulation of papers etc.
- (viii) **Resolution:** The designation and administration of the trust shall rest in the Board of Trustees. All decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be taken by simple majority and if the Board is divided equally the managing trustee shall be entitled for casting vote.
- (ix) **Quorum:** In all meetings two trustees will form a quorum. PROVIDED HOWEVER, that if the number of trustees fall below two then for the purpose of appointing a new trustee one trustee will form a quorum.
- (x) **Motion:** That the minutes of all proceedings of the Board of Trustees shall be written in the Minutes Book and shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting at which the proceeding.

 - (f) WITNESSES - In case the trustees decide to split up the trust in future, they shall remember the nature of the original will incorporating that done for the use of poor gentle members of the community having similar objects that of this trust and no irrevocable charitable trust or foundation having similar objects that of this trust and no irrevocable property is being included in the charitable trust separately;
 - (g) The Rules and Regulations given to the trust may be modified, deleted, added by the majority of the 50% of the Trustees of the trust before 10.00pm
