It is the duty of every one that occupies the country by the consent of the

- Q. **What are the different types of soil formation?**
- A.** **Soil formation** is the process by which new soils are developed from parent materials. Soil formation is influenced by various factors such as climate, topography, vegetation, parent material, time, and biological activity. There are four main types of soil formation processes:
