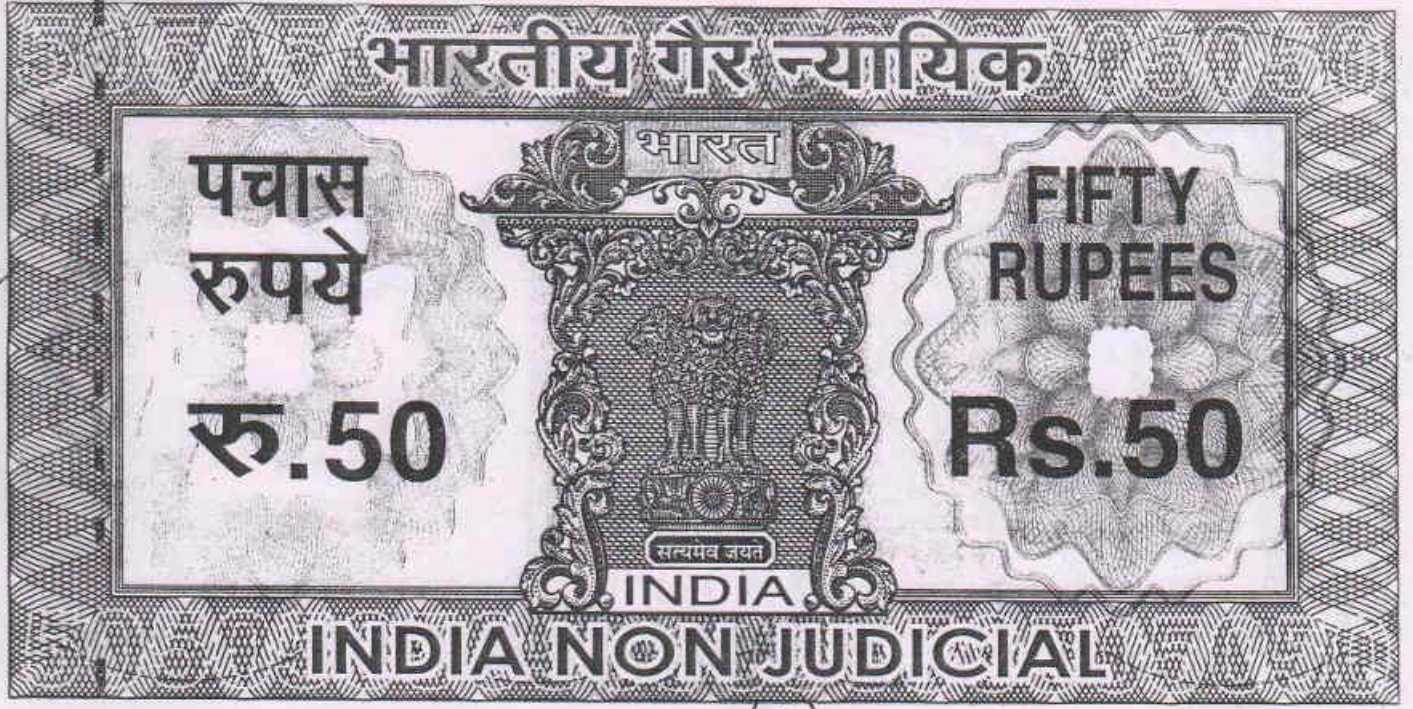

AND whereas for the aforesaid purpose the settlers are desirous of dedicating Rs. 5,000/- (Five Thousand Only)

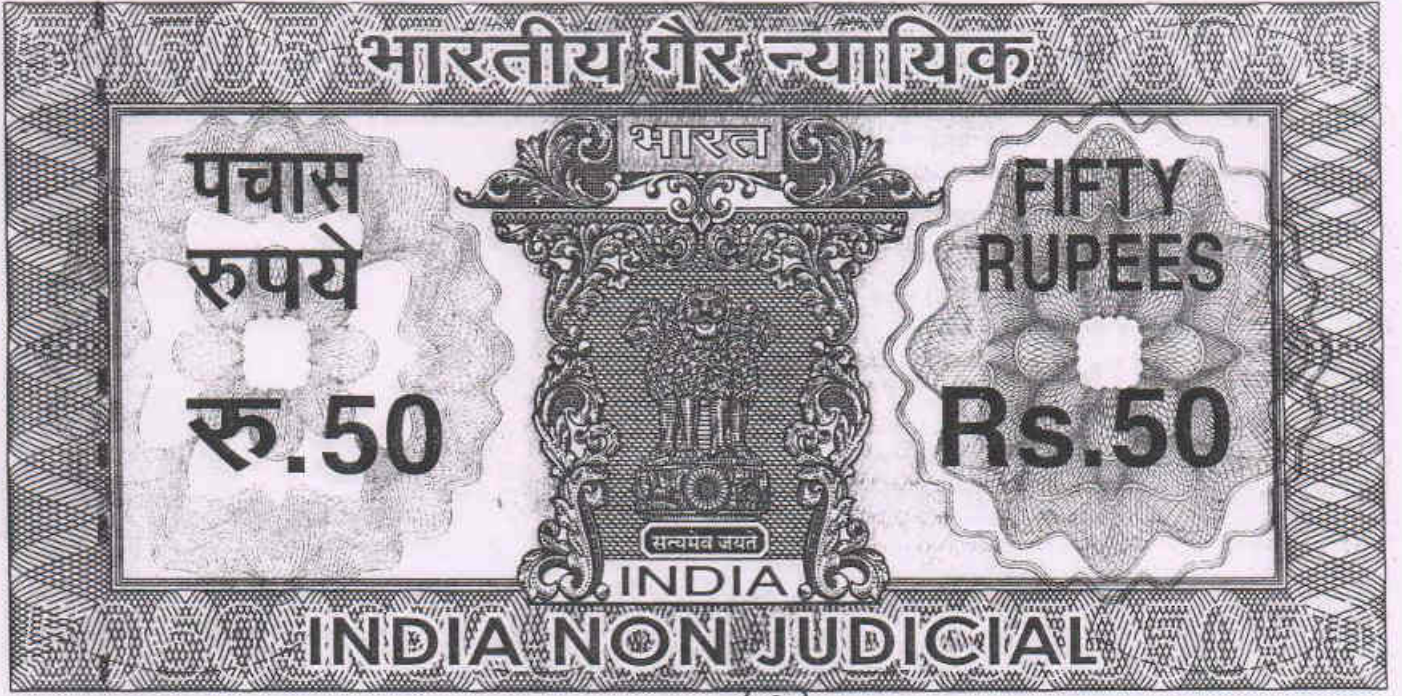
NOW THIS DEED WITNESSES and we transfer, convey and entrust the amount stated above, to hold the same in trust according to the terms herein under:-

3. DEFINITION:-

The trust means "SANSKRITI SOCIAL WELFARE & EDUCATIONAL TRUST"

4. OBJECTIVES:-

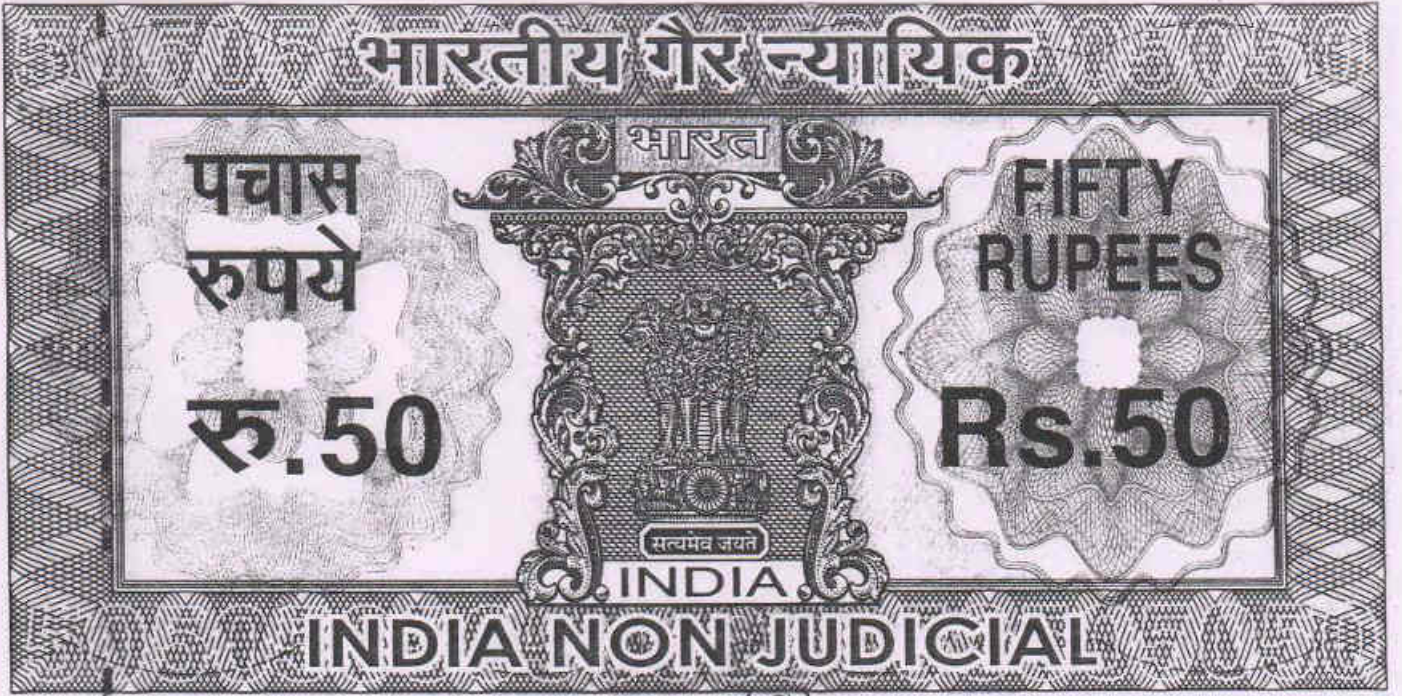
(A) The main aims and objects of the trust are:-

- (i) To promote, establish, run, develop and manage universities, institutions, U.G., P.G. Colleges, Public School and all Types of organization in various fields beneficial to the community such as social welfare, and education, particularly pre-primary, primary and secondary, senior secondary, engineering, polytechnic, management college/ insitute, medical, nursing, Ayurvedic, unani, Homeopathi, veterinary, agriculture education, college/ insitute, hospital, dairy development, Vedic science, cultural education, sports and technology education & all other types of Education etc. and any other activities in interest of social, economic, educational and cultural development of human welfare & the nation in general, in India& Abroad.
- (ii) To promote & manage water, land, agriculture, construction, animal husbandry & aquaculture etc. in rural areas & to work for the betterment of women & for weaker sections allover India & abroad.
- (iii) To impart sound and liberal education to boys and girls during their impressionable years-a type of education that will lay stress on character building, team work sprite development and will infuse in school children a spirit of adventure, fair, play and justice & To develop among its students a feeling of pride in Indian culture and to produce citizens who will be truly Indian and will rise above social, communal, religious or provincial prejudices.
- (iv) To impart training and facilitate scientific research, including undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the diagnosis and treatment in all branches of education & Research at all levels.

- (v) To advice and practice effective measures for rendering medical facilities to all sections of public whether in medical institutions or at homes or at other places where it may be required.
- (vi) To establish, provide, maintain and assist research laboratories and other experimental institutions for doing research and to hold or sponsored seminars & conference.
- (vii) To render, advice, give consultation, promote utilization of research and enhance, develop, exchange research program and establish cooperation between institutions engaged in research in various fields of modern education.
- (viii) To establish, run, develop & manage at all levels, all type of picnic spots, resorts, temples, dharmshala, orphanage, & old age home etc. for increasing the social interaction, supports to each other at all levels for human beings & Cultural development of our Society.
- (ix) To establish, run, develop & manage at all level all the type of missionary schools, college, institutes, all other type of universities & institutions etc.
- (x) To establish, run, develop & manage book publications, paper publications, other print media, electronic media, Radio channels, TV channel of all types & at all levels & directing, designing, making the movies, serials, Ad-films of all types and all other working in all type of media & to establish all type of prodection house for making movie & TV serial, all type of News channels, all type of sale & purchase of movies, serial & establishment of movi & serial colleges.
- (xi) To establish, run develop & manage a Bank, its branches & any other Financial Institutions of all types & at all levels.

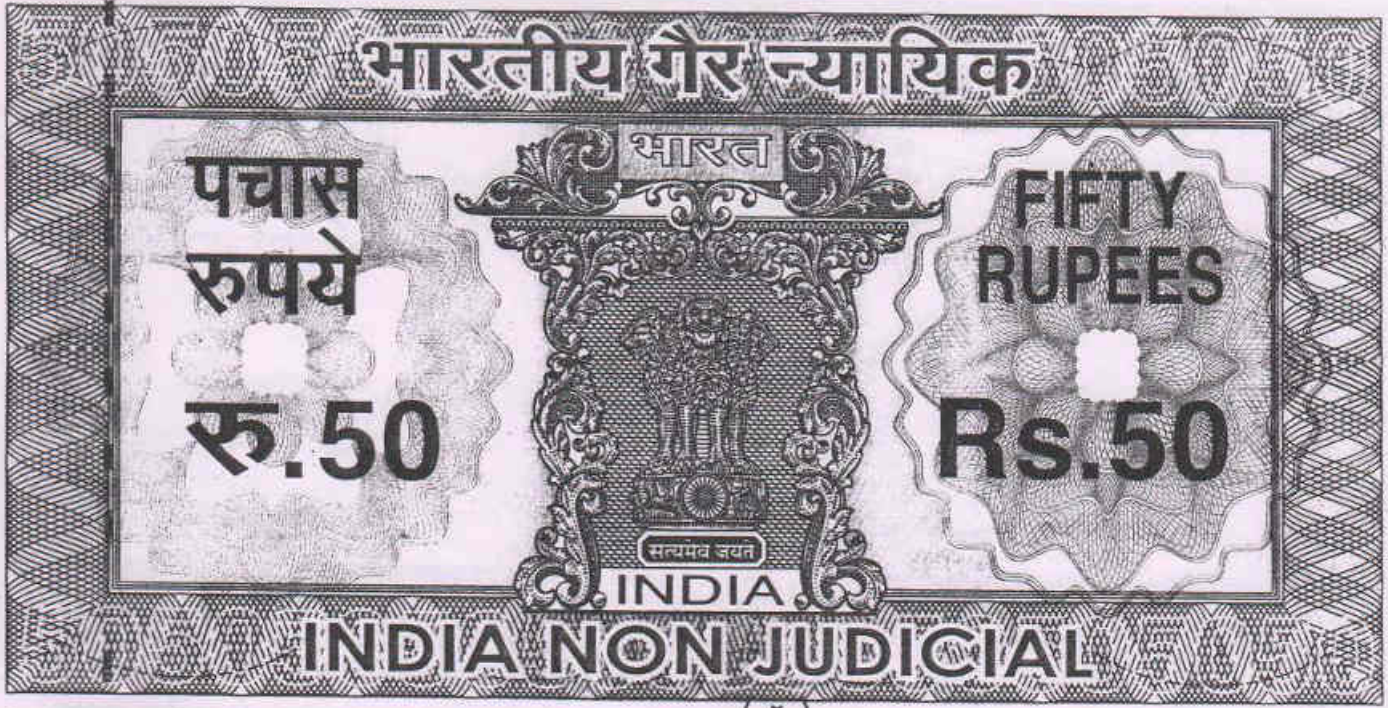

- (xii) To establish, run, develop & manage all types of hospital, pharma production & marketing units or companies to provide the best available facility & the products of that line (in Allopathic, Homeopathy, Ayurvedic etc.) available all over the world.
- (xiii) To develop, maintain and run warehouse.
- (xiv) To promote Indian product outside India.
- (xv) To develop, maintain and run petrol pumps, community hall, paper mills, sugar mills, rice mills.
- (xvi) To establish run develop and maintain production units of non-alcoholic beverages and food supplements.
- (B) The objects incidental or ancillary to the attainment of the Main Object:-**
- (a) To construct, demolish or alter any buildings, which may be necessary or as convenient for its objects.
- (b) To provide hostels and residence, as may be needed, for such students and workers who belong to trust & to any organization of trust or work for it & for others for the benefits of trust.
- (c) To purchase or take on lease land areas to develop residences, flats, multi complexes, shops, markets, multiplex etc. to the attainment of the Main Objects.
- (d) To purchase, take on lease, or exchange, hire, accept as a gift or otherwise acquire or deal in any movable or immovable property or rights therein or privileges thereto attaching, which may be necessary or as convenient for its objects.
- (e) To sell, lease, mortgage, charge, surrender, let on hire, exchange, dispose off, or otherwise transfer for consideration or by way of gift all

or any portion of its movable or immovable property rights, assets and liabilities to any other Society, trust, company, foundation, person or persons which may be necessary or as convenient for its objects etc.

(f) To borrow or raise funds for the trust From Nationalized Bank, scheduled Bank, Private Bank, any other Banking of any level & any Financial Institutions or private person, secured or unsecured through Promotes or other obligation or securities of the trust or by mortgage or creating charge on the properties of the trust or through all other possible means or as covenants for its objects.

(g) To buy, sell, endorse, negotiate or transfer all Government or other securities and to collect and realize interest, bonus, dividend or profits on such securities for its objects.

(h) To invest and deal with its funds and moneys in securities, shares, debentures or bonds or elsewhere and to sell or transfer such investments from time to time or in property and to operate its accounts with any bank, bankers or sheriffs etc. upon such terms and conditions and such manner as may from time to time be determined or deemed expedient or as defined in the trust rules of account.

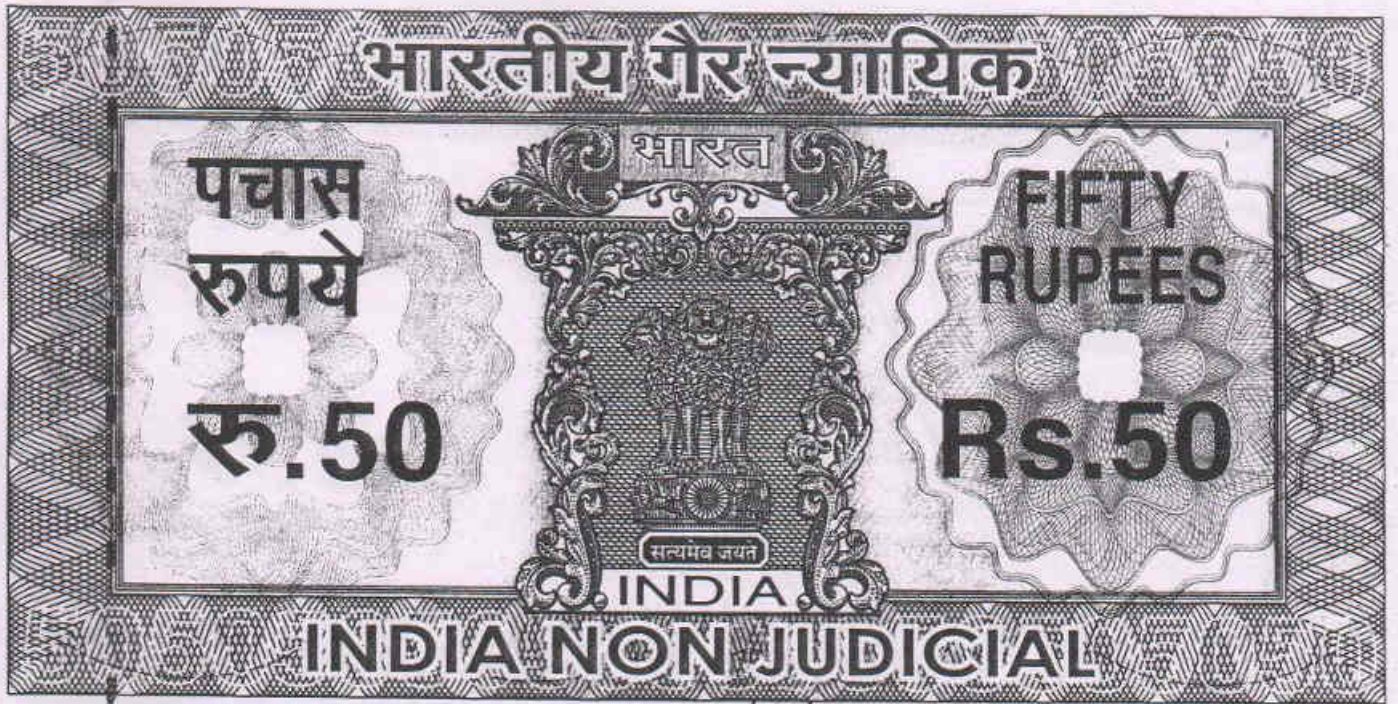
(i) To lend or otherwise employ money belonging to it, to borrow or raise money with or without security by mortgaging or debenture or charging the whole or any or any part of its property, assets or rights and on such terms and conditions as may be determined from time to time.

(j) To do all such other acts and thing whether incidental to the powers aforesaid or not, as may be requisite in order to further its objects.

(k) To engage, invest or enter into any contractual obligations for the purpose of promotion of sound and liberal education.

(l) To take over, on such terms as may be determined, any existing school, colleges any institution, university & any other organization with its properties, movable or immovable and with or without its liabilities and carry on the same as an educational institutions or to amalgamate the same with any school established by the school Society, Trust or by any other type of group or person and to amalgamate with any other Society or Trust.

(m) To enter into any arrangement with Government (Central, any state & union tertiary) or other sources including foreign for securing grants in aid of any school, college, university & organization belonging to Society or Trust.

(n) To provide on welfare and on humanitarian grounds all necessary facilities for the benefit of all the educational institutions of the Society/ Trust.

(o) To offer prizes, incentives, scholarships, remunerations & stipends.

(p) To do all the work alone or in association with other person, Trust or Body of persons, or otherwise, to achieve the aims & objectives of the trust.

(q) To do all other work which are beneficial for the human beings & to achieve the aim & objective of the trust.

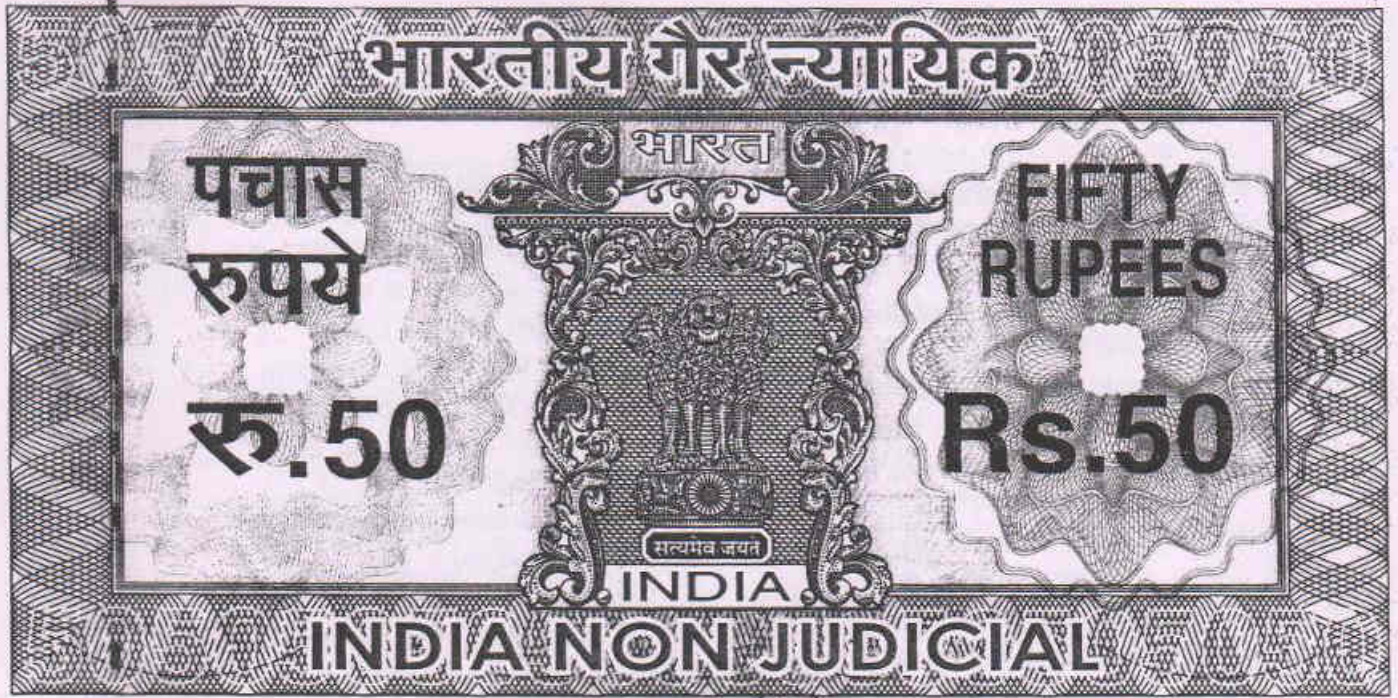

(B) **Ordinary Members of Trust:-** Those who will pay donation & will be confirmed by the board of trustee as a ordinary member of the trust. This approval of chairman though secretary of trust, with annual donation. They are – (1) Shri Harender Kumar.
(2) Smt. Vimla Devi.

5A. **Qualification for Ordinary Membership of Trust:-**

- (A) Healthy, good Character, free from mental ailment.
- (B) Must be an adult.
- (C) Must have good faith in the aims, objectives, rules & regulations of the Trust.
- (D) Must be proposed by any one trustee and membership except by board of Trustees.

5B. **Board of Trustees of the Trusts:-** Founder members or founder trustees of the trust will be considered as board of trustees.

5.1.1A Smt. Savita shall be the first Chairman Trustee of the Trust & Shri Dinesh shall be the first secretary trustee of the trust.

5.1.1B In case of death of Chairman Trustee or secretary trustee the founder trustees/board of trustees will elect or nominate the next Chairman & next Secretary of the trust in the place of the founder trustees in future.

5.1.1C Secretary Trustee with the consent of chairman trustee can nominate & can ask for remove up to any two general members or on seniority basis to work with the board of trust but it any point or aspect before appointing them or after appointing, the decision of chairman will be the final decision.

5.2 VACATION OF OFFICIAL

1. 5.2.1 In Case of death of any trustee of the trust, the vacancy shall be filled by majority by the members of board of Trustees agreeing to the same or by voting.

2. 5.2.2 Any Trustee of the Trust desiring to resign from membership of the Trust may do so by sending a request/resignation letter in writing to the Board of Trustees, who may accept the same and such acceptance shall be subject to the approval by the Board of Trustees of the Trust.

5.2.3 Any member of the Board of Trustees shall cease to be a member on becoming insolvent.

5.2.4. Any member of the Board of trustees shall cease to be a member on becoming insolvent with the consent of Board of Trust.

5.2.5 If the chairman Trustee finds any member of the trust to be undesirable to continue as member of the trust he / she may, remove such member from the membership of the trust after giving written notice and right of hearing, whereupon such person shall cease to be member of the trust.

5.2.6 All vacancy of Board of Trustees shall be filled by the chairman trustee of the trust.

6. FINANCES

The donations and profits, income and property of the trustee will be applied solely for the promotion of the objects of the trust, as set forth above, and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly way of dividends, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way profit to any member or ex-member or any other person claiming through them or any of them, provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of remuneration for any services rendered to the trust. But the chairman trustee & Secretary trustee can receive the payments for their working expenses from trust, that working expenses amounts will be decided, renewed & watched by board of trust.

7. MANAGEMENT


The management and control of the trust shall vest in the Board of trustees of the trust as per the power & duties vested in it in the said deed.

8. POWERS AND DUTIES

8.A POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

8.1A. The Board of the Trustees shall have full powers, and authorities of acts, matters, things and deeds, which may necessary or expedient, for the purpose of management of the trust subject of the final approval of the Chairman Trustees, The Board of Trustees shall have the following power and authorities.

8.2A. The Board of Trustees have power to frame rules, bye laws and regulations as may be considered necessary in the interest and for the betterment, smooth and effective working of the trust.







8.3A. The Board of Trustees may alter, modify, rescind or add the rules, regulation and bye laws by two third majority in the meeting duly convened for this purpose.

8.4A. To do all things for the purpose of effectually carrying out the objects and activities of the trust.

8.5A. To constitute sub-committee consisting of the persons from outside and/or among Trustees with such powers and functions as the Board of Trustees may deem fit, with the consent of chairman trustee.

8.6A. To look after and supervise the management of the properties and activities of the trust and to spend money for that purpose.

8.7A. To fix fees or charges in respect of different activities of the trust and the manner in which the same is to be received.

8.8A. To fix, increase or decrease the rent of the property belonging to the trust.

8.9A. To keep any person in service or expel or terminate the person from service of the trust for misconduct or for any act, which in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, is prejudicial to the interest of the trust, provided that no such action should be taken without giving opportunity to the person concerned of being heard.

8.10A. To invest funds in Banks, or shares, debentures or bonds or elsewhere and to sell or transfer such investments from time to time for the benefit of the trust.

8.11A. To invest funds to acquire movable and immovable properties either by way of purchase, gifts, donation, mortgage, lease, grant or license.

8.12A. To invest funds to construct new buildings, to repair and renovate existing buildings by making necessary improvements and alteration, to demolish buildings and to reconstruct the same.

8.13A. To sell, lease, gift, donate, and create charge or mortgage, any of the movable or immovable properties of the trust.

8.14A. To accept or give aid, from or to any institutions to propagate the objects of the trust.

8.15A. To borrow from Central / State Financial Institution, body Corporate, Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank , Co-operative Bank, other Govt./ Non Govt. Agencies , both in india or abroad for achievement of its objective with or without security of moveable / immoveable properties of trust by way of Mortgage, Hypothecation, Lien, Pledge, or Assignment of its fund in fix deposits/saving/NSCs/ KVPs and / or any other deposit accounts and / or insurance policies or as required by the lending institution

8.16A. To file, defend and conduct any civil or criminal proceedings and to compromise, withdraw, give up or abandon any claim on behalf of the trust for such purposes, to incur necessary expenses from the funds of the trust.

- 8.17A. To defend institute or take any legal proceedings for the defence of office bearers, employs or members of any body or committee of the trust if such legal action has arisen during the course of their action for the interest of the trust.
- 8.18A. To defend, institute of take any legal proceedings against any employee or anybody and during such legal proceedings against any employee or any body and during such legal action, for the interest of trust to compromise or abandon any such claims and incur necessary expenditure from the funds of trust.
- 8.19A. To execute on behalf of the trust all contracts, conveyance or all sort of documents and to receive and accept the same.
- 8.20A. To pass valid receipts or to delegate power of passing receipts for the money received by the trust.
- 8.21A. To prepare and sanction, annual; budgets and estimated income and expenditure of the trust.
- 8.22A. To appoint auditors for audit of the trust work & record and fix their remuneration.
- 8.23A. To disapprove, alter, modify, amend or rescind an resolution passed by board of Trustees of the trust.
- 8.24A. To appoint member of teaching staff, faculty, legal advisors, engineers, architect, managers, accountants, clerks, agents, nursing staff and other employees which may be required for the management of the trust on such terms and conditions as the Board of trustees may consider proper and may dismiss any such employee.
- 8.25A. To deliberate and draw plans for development and fulfillment of the objectives of the trust.
- 8.26A. To prepare research plans for the purpose of bringing up research and development activity.
- 8.27A. To interact with like mind organizations and national research institutions etc. to bring out workable plans for infusion of technological infrastructure.
- 8.28A. To work out plans for setting up national and international educational centers, hospitals etc. to promote the objects of the trust.
- 8.29A. To Board of Trustees shall held their meetings in every 6 month and General meeting will held at least once in a year.
- 8.30A. To alter, modify and adopt new aims and objects of the trust, which shall be passed by two third majority of the trustees in a meeting duly convened for the purpose.
- 8.31A. To delegate any power/powers to a Trustee or any other person as Board of Trustee of the trust may think proper.
- 8.32A. Chairman Trustee shall be the executive head of the trust to carry out the management of the property of the trust. Chairman Trustee shall exercise such powers, as provided in these Rules and Regulation.

8.33A. Secretary Trustee, if appointed shall work under the direction and supervision of the Chairman Trustee.

8.34A. Treasurer Trustee, if appointed shall work under the direction and supervision of the chairman Trustee.

8.35A. All other office bearers, if appointed shall also work under the direction and supervision of the Chairman Trustee.

8.36A. Board of trust will work with their all written powers, in the said deed, only after the properly written consent of the chairman trustee.

8.36A. Board of trust will have right to appoint any legible member or discharge without asking any reason or by way of resignation.

9. PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST

9.1 The properties of the trust shall consist of immovable properties, including subscription and donations in cash or kind and shall be called 'the properties of the trust'

9.2 The properties of the trust shall vest in name of Trust and shall be administered and managed by the Board of Trustees subject to and in conformity with the rules, regulation and by laws of the trust.

10. ACCOUNTS

10.1 The Accounts of the trust shall be kept and maintained at the registered office of the trust or at such other place as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.

10.2 Annual Income and Expenditure Statement and Balance Sheet of the trust shall contain true and fair picture of the trust.

10.3 The financial year of the Foundation shall be ending 31st March every year.

10.4 The Annual Accounts shall be audited by duly appointed Chartered Accountants.

11. FUNDS

11.1 The funds of the trust shall consist of its own assets, receipts through grants, matching grants, donation, contributions, fees and subscriptions and by all other way of income and all payments of the trust shall be made there from.



11.2 The funds of the trust shall be expended and invested solely for the promotion of aims and objects of the trust in accordance with laws.

11.3 All Banking Accounts in any bank & any other financial account of anywhere of any type shall be operated upon by the chairman & secretary trustee jointly.

12. QUORUM

For a meeting of Board of Trustees, there, shall be a quorum of at least one third of total. When a meeting cannot be held for want of quorum, the same shall be adjourned for one hour and two members present shall form a quorum for such adjourned meeting.



13. NOTICE OF MEETING

13.1 Notice in writing of every meeting of the Board of trustees shall be delivered or sent through post or by hand or by the possible way to all the Trustees of the Trust at their addresses on record, at least three clear days before the date of the meeting.

13.2 The chairman Trustee may call an extraordinary meeting of the trust for which notice of 24 hours or as he/she think best in interest of trust before the date of the meeting shall be deemed sufficient.

14. LIABILITY

14.1 The members of the Board of Trustees shall be liable only for such moneys and securities as they shall actually receive notwithstanding their signing any receipt, for the sake of conformity and shall not be answerable or responsible for the acts, receipts, omissions, negligence and defaults of any banker, broker, auctioneer or there person with when or into whose hands and moneys or securities shall be deposited and other losses, unless the same has happened through their own negligence, default or admission, branch of trust, misapplication or misconduct.

14.2 that in case of borrowings the liability of each Trustee existing or future will continue till the loan amount taken by trust from the bank/ financial intuition is repaid in full and this liability will not be affected by the removal , resignation or death of any of the trustees or by the extinction of trust or any of the trustees will not relieve any trustee, present or future , from the liability if the trust in respect of the amount due to the Financial Institution/ Bank

14.3 Further, any security created for securing any loan including hypothecation, pledge, mortgage assignment, secured interest etc. Whatsoever upon trust properties whether movable or immovable as well as any right title and/or interest whether over any property tangible or intangible shall continue till full repayment of such loan and shall not be affected by removal, resignation or death of any of the trustees or by the extinction of the trust and even discharge of the trust and/or any of the trustees will not relieve the trustees and/ or trust properties mortgaged, hypothecated, pledge etc. as aforesaid in respect of the amount due to financial institution /Bank and no trustee whether past, present or future , will raise any objection against enforcement of securities, charge , assignments, liens, secured interest etc. created over trust properties ; whether movable or immovable, tangible or intangible, for recovery of dues secured by any such security, charge , assignment , lien, secured interest etc. in favor of Bank /financial institution.

15. DISPUTES OR SUITES:-In case of any dispute the legal jurisdiction will only Meerut District and tall the legal suits of the trust will be filed in the Meerut Court. Chairman & secretary of the trust or one of them with the consent of other or their nominated person will conduct pairvi of the cases.

16. DISSOLUTION

The Trust may be dissolved at a special meeting of the Board of Trustees convened for the purpose by majority present at such meeting in due presence of the permanent chairmen.

If upon dissolution of the trust there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Trust or any of them but shall be given or transferred to some other institution, trust, society etc. having objects wholly or in part similar to those of the Trust to be determined by the majority votes present and voting in meeting specially called for the purpose or in default thereof by a court of competent jurisdiction.
