In these rules unless the context otherwise requires :

a) 'The Society' means MAA BHAGWATI EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY.

 Founder Member' means a member who subscribes to the Memorandum of Association of the Society.

Ordinary Member' means a member, who has been admitted so by the Governing Body.

) Yonotary Member' means a member, who has been admitted so by the Governing Body and

will bookhave any right to attend and/or vote in a general meeting of the Governing Body.

Life Member' means a member who has been admitted so by the Governing Body.

francing Committee' or 'Committee' means the Managing Committee of the Society for the

time being.

g) 'Financial Year' means the period commencing on the first day of April and ending on the thirty first day of March of the following year.

h) 'Rules' means the Rules and Regulations of the Society for the time being in force,

i) 'General Secretary' means the General Secretary holding office as such.

 The aims and objects of the Society are as set out in its Memorandum of Association and they may be altered, amended, extended, varied or abridged in accordance with the provisions of the Societies

Registration act, 1860,

POWER & DUTIES OF MEMBERS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE

31. The management, control and administration of the affairs of the Society shall be vested in the Management Committee. In addition to the powers and authorities by these rules expressly conferred upon, the Managing Committee may exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised and done by the Society and delegated by the Governing Body in a General Meeting and are not hereby or by legislative enactment expressly directed or required to be exercised or done by the Society in the General Meeting.

However, the powers of the Governing Body will be supreme and if Governing Body finds that the act / decisions of the management committee is against the interest or aims and objectives of the Society, the Governing Body can also veto such acts / decisions in its General Meeting.

a) POWERS OF THE CHAIRMAN:

- The following powers shall be exercised by the Chairman of the Society:
- * To chair all the meeting of Managing Committee and various meetings of the members.
- * To monitor the activities of Society.
- * To regulate the proceedings of the meeting.
- * All the powers as per Society Registration Act 1860.

b) POWER OF THE GENERAL SECRETARY:

- To send the notices of various meetings under his signature to the members of Managing Committee and Members of Society.
- * To ensure the recording of the minutes of meetings.
- To ensure the preparation of financial accounts of the Society and to present the same to members of the Society.
- To prepare the progress report of the Society and to present the same to members of Society.
- * To deal with all the matters relating to the Society and to defend against any legal proceedings

c) POWER OF THE SECRETARY:

To exercise all the powers of the General Secretary in his absence.

d) POWER OF THE TREASURER:

To ensure the timely preparation of final accounts of the Society and to get the same Audited from the auditor of the Society.

- 32. Without prejudice to the above, the Management Committee (consent of five members out of seven) shall have power:
 - a) To make or alter Rules for its own functioning and dispatch of its business not being the Rules of the Society continued under these present.
 - b) To delegate, subject to such conditions as they think fit, any of the powers to sub-Committee, consisting of such members of the Committee or other person being members of the Society or the Institute as they think may fit and to make such regulations as to the proceedings of such sub committee.
 - c) To communicate, correspond or represent to the Government of India, Parliament, Legislature, Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, Central Board of Direct Taxes or such other Government bodies and persons.
 - d) To appoint / remove employees in the employment of the Society and to fix their remuneration from time to time.
 - c) To establish Library and Reading rooms for the use of the members of the Society and to arrange for circulation and publication of books, journals, bulletins, pamphlets etc.
 - f) To arrange lectures, conferences, social functions and other opportunities for meeting, with a view to promote personal contacts of the members either independently or jointly with any other body or bodies.
 - g) To publish journal relating to the Engineering Technology, B.Arch, Management, B.Ed, L.L.B., Nursing, Public School, B. Pharma, Medical / Dental Science, B.B.A, B.C.A, B.J.M.C, B.P.Ed.

ALTERATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

40. The Society may amend, after, delete, substitute or add to the Rules and Regulations of the Society by a resolution at the General Meeting of the Society with the written consent of at least four Founder Members/ Whole Life Members out of seven Founder Members/ Whole Life Members, or in the ratio of 4/7. The Society may after, extend, abridge or amend its objects for purposes within the meaning of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 in the manner provided by section 12 of the said Act,

SEAL

41. The seal of the Society shall be prepared for the purpose of the Society and it shall not be used or affixed on any instrument except by the authority or resolution by any two of the office bearers.

INDEMNITY

42. All acts done by the members of the Management Committee in good faith shall not be invalidated. The office bearers, members of the Management Committee and the employees of the Society and the Auditors of the Society shall be indemnified out of the Society, against all claims, liabilities, losses, costs, charges and expenses that may at any time be made against or incurred by them in the discharge of duties or in the conduct of the Society's activities except such as are incurred by their own willful neglect or default.

GENERAL CLAUSE

43. The income and the property of the Society when so ever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion there of, shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise, how so ever, by way of profit to the persons, who at any time, are/ have been members of the Society or to any person claiming through any of them provided that
