Important Instructions

- The State Government/ UT/ Directorate of Technical Education/ Directorate of Medical Education shall ensure that 10% of reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) as per the reservation policy for admission, operational from the Academic year 2019-20 is implemented without affecting the reservation percentages of SC/ ST/ OBC (NCL)/ General. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase in annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years.
- The Institution offering courses earlier in the Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift/Part Time are now amalgamated as total intake and shall have to fulfil all facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2022-23 for the Total Approved Intake. Further, the Institutions Deemed to be Universities/ Institutions having Accreditation/ Autonomy status shall have to maintain the Faculty: Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook. All such Institutions/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS to fulfil the norms based on the Affidavit submitted to AICTE beginning with the Academic Year 2022-23.
- Strict compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation, Establishment of Committee for SC/ ST, Establishment of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Establishment of Online Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Barrier Free Built Environment for disabled and elderly persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be maintained as Approval Process Handbook and provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified from time to time.
- In case of any differences in content in this Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the content/information as approved by the Executive Council / General Council as available on the record of AICTE shall be final and binding.

Pharmacy Institute: In compliance with the order dated 05.03.2020 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Transferred Petitions (CIVIL) No 87-101 of 2014, for the existing institutions offering courses in Pharmacy Programme, approval of Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required. The requirements for running the Programme (Diploma / UG / PG) such as Land & Build-up Area, Student-faculty ratio, Intake etc. will be as per the respective regulatory body (PCI). In case of any inconsistency in the course name and intake for EoA issued by AICTE and the approval by PCI, the approval of PCI shall prevail.

Architecture Institute: In compliance with the order dated 08.11.2019 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Indian CA No.364/ 2005, for the existing Institutions offering Courses in Architecture Programme, approval by the Council of Architecture (CoA) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required. The requirements for running the Programme (Diploma / UG / PG) such as Land & Build-up Area, Student-faculty ratio, Intake etc. will be as per respective regulatory body (CoA). In case of any inconsistency in the course name and

intake for EoA issued by AICTE and the approval by CoA, the approval of CoA shall prevail.

Deemed to be University: Institutions Deemed to be Universities (Running Technical Education Programmes), it is mandatory to have AICTE approval from the Academic Year 2018-19 in compliance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 03-11-2017 passed in CA No.17869- 17870 /2017.



112th CC Meeting (10.6.2021)

1. The decision of the PCI are as under.
2. It is decided that decisions are subject to following conditions.
 - a) the consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority and NOC of the State Government (as applicable) should be available with the institution.
 - b) the institution should have a legal entity status on the date of application to PCI and NOC of the State Government and consent of affiliation of Examining Authority (as applicable) shall be in the name of legal entity.
 - c) They shall produce records of their legal entity and the land and building documents to substantiate their claims.
 - d) Wherever needed inspections will be carried out subsequently and if the facts claimed by the institution are found false, the PCI may change or withdraw the approval.
 - e) Any approval granted by the PCI beyond 2021-2022 academic session will stand but will be considered year on year basis based on the information submitted by institution in online SIF.
 - f) Wherever required, institution shall furnish additional information as sought by the PCI from time to time.
 - g) The request for raise in admissions for D.Pharm course beyond 60 intake is not considered as per the policy of the council.
 - h) Regarding M.Pharm seats, it was noted that 110 Central Council in its meeting held on 11th December, 2020 under item No.273 decided as under -
 - i) 12 specialties / subjects are prescribed in which M.Pharm can be conducted. (Ref: Regulation-9., Appendix-A of M.Pharm Regulations).
 - ii) maximum 15 seats per specialization are sanctioned by PCI (Ref: Regulation-23.(i) of M.Pharm Regulations)
Further as per the statutory provisions of M.Pharm Regulations, the ratio of recognized Post-Graduate teacher to number of students to be admitted for the M.Pharm course shall be 1:3.
 - iii) as per the procedure in vogue, the institution applies in SIF for number of seats per specialization / raise in admission in case number of seats sanctioned by PCI are less than 15.
 - iv) In view of above statutory provisions of the M.Pharm Regulations, it was decided that in case institution has the prescribed teaching staff with prescribed experience as per "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014", PCI shall sanction number of admissions per M.Pharm specialization based on availability of the teaching staff irrespective of institution's request in SIF. However, under no circumstances more than 15 students per specialization shall be sanctioned.
In view of above, M.Pharm seats are decided accordingly.
 - v) The institution shall not make any admission to the increased intake sanctioned by PCI without affiliation of the Examining Authority for raise in admission.
3. The above conditions be also conveyed to individual institution through the institution's dash board.
