

1. The decision of the JCI are as under:-
2. It is decided that decisions are subject to following conditions:-
  - a) The consent of authority of the Examining Authority and JCI of the State Government are applicable upto the date of the decision.
  - b) The applicant should have a legal entry status in the date of registration of JCI and NOC of the State Government and consent of authority of Examining Authority for application should be in the name of the applicant.
  - c) They shall produce records of their legal entries and the final and binding documents in substantiate their entries.
  - d) Wherever needed, repatriation will be exempted subsequently and it will have to be granted by the examining authority of their, the JCI may charge the expenses as per rules.
  - e) Any appeal against the JCI the end 2021-22 will be considered on a merit basis, will be decided in year or year has been on the information submitted by the JCI and the JCI.
  - f) Wherever legal, financial or shall financial documents are required as sought by the JCI then they to file.
  - g) The cases to come in admission for the 11th course beyond 30th June 2021 and concerned as per the policy of the council.
  - h) Register of the candidates is now dated 31st October 2021 and it is reviewed, called on 10 December 2021, under [http://www.mca.gov.in](#)
  - i) 15 candidates to be taken a certificate to be issued. M.P. can be considered. (Per Register of the Candidates and M.P. can be considered).
  - j) maximum 15 students per discipline are allowed. In JCI the maximum 2000 students from legally admit.
    - 1) There will be 10 voluntary students of M.P. and Register. The ratio of recognition of the JCI shall be the ratio of students to be admitted for the M.P. and will be 1:5.
    - 2) In case of the procedure to register, the institution applies in 5% the number of seats per qualification of their institution. The number of seats sanctioned by JCI will be 100:5.
    - 3) In view of above data by provision of the M.P. in Regulation of the council that in case institution for the number of seats working with the above data will be as per "The State of Planning 2011-12" and "Course Registration 2014". JCI will sanction number of candidates M.P. on the basis of the ratio of the ratio of the number of seats per discipline of their institution. In case of the ratio of the number of seats per discipline of their institution will be sanctioned. In view of above M.P. can be considered immediately.
    - 4) The institution shall not have any objection to be considered. These sanctioned by JCI will be the ratio of the Examining Authority for the number of 60.
