Annexure-2 of Item No.7 (I-239)
112th CC Meeting (10.6.2021)

1. The decision of the PCI are as under.
2. It is decided that decisions are subject to following conditions.
 - a) The consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority and HOC, of the State Government for applications should be available with the institution.
 - b) The institution should have a legal entity status on the date of application to PCI and HOC of the State Government and consent of affiliation of Examining Authority can be available shall be at the same of legal entity.
 - c) They shall produce records of their legal entity and the land and building documents to substantiate their claims.
 - d) Whenever needed inspections will be carried out subsequently and if the facts claimed by the institution are found false, the PCI may change or withdraw its approval.
 - e) Any approval granted by the PCI beyond 2021-2022 academic session will stand void and will be considered year on year basis based on the information submitted by institution in using 5IF.
 - f) Whenever required, institution shall furnish additional information as sought by the PCI, from time to time.
 - g) The request for raise in admissions for M.Pharm course beyond 10 intake is not considered as per the policy of the council.
 - h) Regarding M.Pharm seats, it was noted that JH Council Council in its meeting held on 11th December, 2020 under item No.277 decided as under:
 - i) 12 specialities / subjects are prescribed in which M.Pharm can be conducted. (Ref: Regulation 9, Appendix of M.Pharm Regulations)
 - ii) Students 12 seats per specialisation are sanctioned by PCI (Ref: Regulation-23(1) of M.Pharm Regulations)
Further as per the statutory provisions of M.Pharm Regulations, the ratio of sanctioned Post Graduate teacher to number of students to be admitted for the M.Pharm course shall be 1:3.
 - iii) As per the procedure in vogue, the institution applies to 5IF the number of seats per specialisation / raise in admission (i.e. no. number of seats sanctioned by PCI are less than 12).
 - iv) In view of above statutory provisions of the M.Pharm Regulations, it was decided that in case institution has the prescribed teaching staff with prescribed experience as per "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014", PCI shall sanction number of admissions per M.Pharm specialisation based on availability of the teaching staff irrespective of institution's request to 5IF. However, under no circumstances more than 12 students per specialisation shall be sanctioned.
 - v) In view of above, M.Pharm seats are decided accordingly.
 - vi) The institution shall not make any addition to the increased intake sanctioned by PCI without affiliation of the Examining Authority for raise in admission.
3. The above conditions be also conveyed to individual institution through the institution's dash board.
