NOTE.— Marks in the subject or Grand Total in which a candidate has failed are enclosed in circle.

- The minimum pass-marks are 33 per cent in every subject. The candidate should obtain minimum pass-marks in theory papers as well as practicals, wherever prescribed in the Prospectus.
- For distinction 75 per cent of the aggregate marks in a subject is the minimum.
- The minimum percentage of marks required for a pass in the first, second and third divisions are 60, 45 and 33 respectively in the aggregate.
- Any candidate who has appeared in a full Examination of the Board and obtained 40 per cent of the aggregate of marks but has failed in one subject only, obtaining not less than 25 per cent of marks in that subject, shall be eligible to appear in the Compartmental Examination.
- The answer-books of candidates who are declared eligible for Compartmental Examination and of those who have failed in one subject only by not more than 5 per cent of marks assigned to that subject are scrutinized free of charge and without the candidate making an application for scrutiny. Such candidates must not credit fee for scrutiny. They shall not get a refund of fee if they deposit the same in spite of this clear notice and advice.
- Applications for scrutiny of marks and rechecking of result from other candidates not covered by paragraph 5 above must be submitted on the prescribed form obtainable from the Principal or Centre Superintendent on application, so as to reach the Secretary's Office not later than July 15, 1966. Application form received after the prescribed date will not be entertained.
- (5-a) Results of affected candidates as and when discovered, are duly and regularly communicated to the Heads of Institutions and Superintendents of Centres concerned for communication to the affected candidates. Intimation regarding the results of post scrutiny of answer-books of candidates whose results are not affected by the scrutiny of their answer-books, are communicated to the candidates concerned when all the scrutiny work is completed by the end of September. No correspondence in connection with the results of scrutiny of answer-books will be entertained in Board's Office.
- The candidates should not wait for the result of scrutiny which takes time and are advised to take their admission in an institution if they want to study as a regular student or to appear in the Supplementary Examination. If they intend to appear as private candidates at the next Examination of the Board, they should submit their application form on the due date at their examination centre.
- Duplicate mark-sheets will be issued to the candidates by the Office of the Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Uttar Pradesh on payment of Rs. 250 in case of a private candidate and Re. 150 in case of a regular candidate. The amount should be deposited in the U. P. Government Treasury under Head "XXXII—Education". Fee once deposited shall not be returned. Fee deposited in excess of the above amount shall also not be refundable.
- Candidates who pass the various final Examinations with 50% marks or above (in the first attempt) are eligible for National Loan Scholarships, if their parents' income for the previous financial year was up to Rs. 6,000. Prescribed application forms and rules can be had from the District Inspector of Schools concerned and the same should reach the Director of Education, U. P. F(3) Section, Allahabad within 30 days of the announcement of the Scheme in the paper and over the All-India Radio or publication of the results whichever is later.
- Since the merit Scholarships are awarded by the Director of Education Uttar Pradesh, Allahabad no correspondence in the connection will be entertained by the Secretary, Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Uttar Pradesh, Allahabad.
