THE EXAMINATION

The Indian School Certificate (Year-12) Examination is in accordance with the 10 plus 2 scheme of school education of the Kothari Education Commission and is taken after a 2-year course of study beyond the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (Year-10) Examination or its equivalent.

MEANING OF GRADES**I. EXTERNAL EXAMINATION**

Attainment in a subject is indicated by a grade, of which Grade 1 is the highest and Grade 9 the lowest; only Grades 1 to 8 are recorded on Certificates. The interpretation of the grades is as follows:

II. INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

Awards and conditions for awards.
