- NOTE: (The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For details, the corresponding orders / notifications issued from time to time must be referred)
- Maximum passing marks: In each Theory Paper 30% in Final Examination and 40% in aggregate; in Practical & Sessionals 30% in each component separately and 40% in aggregate of both semesters taken together.
  - Passing in Design and Extra-curricular activities is compulsory but marks obtained therein will be counted in total marks / percentage obtained.
  - Star (\*) shown against the marks denotes fall in the paper and 'G' denotes grace marks awarded in that paper to pass the examination. However, the grace marks are virtual marks which are neither to be added in individual component / subject marks nor / aggregate marks obtained. The grace marks will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers prescribed for the examination.
  - Grace Marks to the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks prescribed for an examination (to be rounded to the next whole number) will be awarded to a student in the failed subject(s) provided the student passes the examination by the award of such Grace Marks.
  - Promotion: A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed atleast in 25% of the theory papers and 25% of the practical and sessional subjects separately.
  - Re-valuation of answer books shall be permissible to not more than 20% of the theory papers (to be rounded to the next whole number) in which a student is actually appeared in examination. For Re-valuation, the student must submit his/her application form through Head of the Institute to the University within 15 days from the date of issue of marks sheet. Incomplete application form without request fee or received after the due date will be rejected. Re-valuation is not permitted in the back paper examination(s).
  - For any kind of improvement as per rules, the student has to apply within one month of their results from the declaration of the result.
  - Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term test marks if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if filing earlier. If a student has applied for improvement of term test marks, the marks secured by him/her in that test sheet stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the latest examinations / tests shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate fails to appear in the test, he/she shall be treated as absent.
  - Sessional Improvement: If the student is fail in any practical and/or sessional subject(s), he/she may apply for improvement in the sessional component provided the earlier marks in the additional component are less than 40%. Such student will be required to register in both practical and sessional components of the subject(s) and his/her marks of the latest practical & sessional examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student fails to appear in the test, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
  - A candidate shall be awarded:
    - Honours, if he/she secures atleast 70% of the aggregate i.e. 4800 marks or above, (4300 marks or above in case of Diploma candidates)
    - First Class, if he/she secures atleast 50% of the aggregate i.e. 4200 to 4800, (3600 marks to 4199 in case of Diploma candidates)
    - Second Class, if he/she secures atleast 50% of the aggregate i.e. 3600 marks to 4199, (3000 marks to 4199 in case of Diploma candidates)
    - Pass Class, if he/she secures below 3000, (3000 marks in case of Diploma candidates) subject to fulfilment of condition at point no. 1.
  - Answer books are not subjected to any inspection or re-valuation before any external or internal agency except at the instance of Vice-Chancellor.
  - In case of any mistake being detected in the marks sheet afterwards, the University is fully empowered to correct the same.
  - All court orders shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University Headquarter, Jaipur and not any other place.
