- For a pass in each theory paper, a candidate is required to secure minimum 50% marks in aggregate of Tests and Final exam taken together and 30% marks in final exam also. For a pass in each Practical & Seminarial a candidate is required to secure minimum 50% marks in each of the Practical & Seminarial separately and minimum 50% marks in both these components taken together.
 - Passing in Seminars and Seminarsial activities is compulsory and marks awarded thereon are not counted for both regular and distance final examinations.
 - Marks written with "A" against a paper denote absence in that paper. Marks written with "0" against a paper denote gross marking given in the candidate's paper in the examination. Absence in seminarsial marks are not applicable in the aggregate.
 - In case of any student being detected during the presentation of the Marks sheet or brought to the notice afterwards, the University will be fully empowered to correct the same. (2) (1998)
 - A student will be given five chances to pass a paper and these five chances cannot be used any time after the student of eight years (seventeen months) duration to complete B.E. course.
 - Candidate bearing the responsibility of their results should apply in the prescribed form available from the university office, in duplicate to the Head of the Dept. Registrar (only 1 set) 30 days from the date of declaration of the result. Applications received after the due date will NOT BE ENTITLED TO BE CONSIDERED IN ANY CASE. Fee deposit is not permitted for those candidates who have appeared in the last paper with unsuccessful candidature.
 - A candidate will be awarded:
 - Pass with 1st Honours (above 70% of the aggregate i.e. 4900 marks or above and 1800 marks or above in case of Distance Candidate.)
 - First class (the student obtained 60% of the aggregate i.e. 4200 to 4900 marks or above and 1500 marks or above in case of Distance Candidate.)
 - Second class (the student obtained 50% of the aggregate i.e. 3500 to 4200 marks or above and 1200 marks or above in case of Distance Candidate.)
 - Pass class (above 300 marks and 0 marks or above in Distance Candidate.)
 - All documents and the subject papers should be forwarded to Registrar, University (Jaipur) within a time period specified.
