NOTE: (The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For detail, the corresponding orders/notifications issued from time to time must be referred.)

- Minimum passing marks:** 33% in theory paper, 40% in practical/experiments and 40% in aggregate of term test and final examination. (A) - The rule & Sessional Shifts will apply separately and 40% aggregate will be considered as a whole.
- Passing in Discipline and Extra-curricular activities:** is not necessary for marks obtained therein. All secured marks shall be taken together.
- Star:** Minimum aggregate marks in all the papers and 50% marks in discipline marks are not sufficient to pass the examination. To have the grade marks are actual marks are taken for aggregate individual components subject that total aggregate marks obtained. The grade marks will be awarded only if the student scores in all the papers in the examination.
- Grade Marks:** To the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks given in the examination will be given to the student who has secured the highest marks in the total subjects provided that marks are evaluated by the examiners. (B) - Grade Marks.
- Promotion:** A student may be promoted to the higher class only after he/she has secured atleast 20% of the theory papers and 20% of the practical and sessional subjects separately.
- Re-valuation of answer:** Students who secure less than 20% of the theory papers or less than 20% of the practical and sessional subjects separately. For re-valuation, the student must submit an application form through the respective examiners within 15 days from the date of issue of marks sheet. Incomplete application will be rejected. Fee of Rs. 500/- shall be payable at the time of application. Re-valuation is not permitted in the case of practical/experiments. Answer books are not subjected to any re-valuation. In the case of re-valuation, the marks given in the original answer book will be considered. If the marks are found to be the same, the answer books shall be a subject to the marks given in the original answer book. (C) - Re-valuation of marks.
- For any kind of improvement as per rules:** the student has to apply in the respective department of the department of the respective department.
- Term Test:** A student is allowed to improve the term test marks in the respective department. Examination of the theory paper again and if failing again if a student has a minimum of 10% marks in the term test marks secured by him/her. However, the term test marks will be cancelled. The marks of the latest examination/term test shall be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate has attended the term test, the term test marks shall be treated as absent.
- Sessional Improvement:** If the student is failing in any component of the sessional subjects, he/she can apply for improvement in the sessional component provided the marks in the sessional component are less than 40%. The student will be required to register in both practical and theoretical components of the subject and his/her marks of the latest of a sessional examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If a student has attended himself from the term test, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
