- For a pass in each Theory paper, a candidate is required to obtain minimum 40% marks in aggregate of Tests and Final exam taken together and 20% marks in final exam also. For a pass in each Practical & Sessional, a candidate is required to obtain minimum 20% marks in both the Practical & Sessional separately and minimum 40% marks in both these components taken together.
 - Fewing in Discipline and Extra curricular activity is not necessary but marks obtained there of will be counted for writing out the division at the Final Examination.
 - Marks written with '-' against a paper denotes failure in that paper. Marks written with '0' against a paper denotes grace marks given to the candidate to pass the examination. '-' denotes minimum pass marks are not specified for that component.
 - In case of any mistake being detected during the preparation of the Marks sheet or brought to the notice afterwards, the University will be fully empowered to correct the same. (2-183-H)
 - A student will be given four chances to pass a paper and these four chances can be availed any time within the duration of Eight years (maximum duration to complete B.E. course).
 - Candidates desiring re-valuation/correction of their results should apply to the prescribed form obtainable from the University office, on request so as to reach the Dy. Registrar (Devy) within 30 days from the date of declaration of the result. Applications received after the due date will NOT BE ENTERTAINED in any case. Revaluation is not permitted for those candidates who have appeared in the last paper/s of supplementary examinations.
 - A candidate shall be awarded:
 - Honours, if he secures atleast 70% of the aggregate i.e. 4800 marks or above and 14000 marks or above in case of Diploma Candidates.)
 - First class if he secures atleast 60% of the aggregate i.e. 4200 to 4800 and 12000 marks to 14000 in case of Diploma Candidates.)
 - Second class if he secures atleast 50% of the aggregate i.e. 3600 to 4200 and 10000 marks to 12000 in case of Diploma Candidates.)
 - Pass class - below 5000 marks and 10000 in case of Diploma Candidates.)
 - All other cases shall be subject to the discretion of the Rajasthan University Headquarters i.e. Jaipur and not any place.
