Important Instructions

- The State Government/UT Directorate of Technical Education/ Directorate of Medical Education shall ensure that 10% of enrolment for Government Institute Section (GIS) as per the reservation policy for admission operational from the Academic year 2019-20 is implemented without affecting the reservation percentages of GOVT/ OBC (NCL)/ General. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the Clause 31 of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such reservation shall be permitted to increase in annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years.
- The Institution offering courses listed in the Regular, 10th, First Year, Second Year/Third Year are now unaccredited as local state and shall have to fulfil all facilities such as infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2020-21 for the Total Approval state. Further, the Institutions Deemed to be Universities/ Institutions Seeking Accredited/ Autonomy status shall have to increase the Faculty. Subject with an specified in the Approval Process Handbook. All such Institutions/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, infrastructure and other facilities within 2 (Two) to fulfil the norms listed in the manual submitted to AICTE beginning with the Academic Year 2020-21.

Architecture Institute: In compliance with the order dated 06.11.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India CA No. 3041/2018, for the existing Institutions offering Courses in Architecture Programs, approval by Council of Architecture (CoA) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required. The requirements for running the Programs (diploma / UG / PG) such as Land & Building Area, Student-faculty ratio, intake etc. will be as per respective regulatory body (CoA). In case of any inconsistency in the course name and intake for EoA issued by AICTE and the approval by CoA, the approval of CoA shall prevail.
