Declaration of Result:

After appearing at the Examination of Sixth Semester the Candidates can be put in the following two categories.

- Passed:** A candidate who has passed in all courses (including Project/Elective/filed study) of examinations of I, II, III, IV, V & VI Semesters and obtained at least CGPA of 5.00.
- Failed:** All the students who have not PASSED will be categorized as "FAILED"

A candidate shall be considered to have PASSED Sixth Semester course, if he/she has obtained Grade E or P above in each subject of the Sixth Semester courses

$$SGPA = \frac{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in VI Semester}}{\text{Total Credit of Concerned Semester}}$$

$$CGPA = \frac{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in I, II, III, IV, V \& VI Semesters}}{\text{Total Credit of I to VI Semester}}$$

* BAO IC: Environmental Studies- Compulsory Course. No Evaluation and only Attendance requirements is there. The Credit will not to be accounted for calculating CGPA/SGPA

Calculation of Percentage

The SGPA and CGPA shall be computed up to 2 place of decimals (truncated at the second place)
The conversion formula for converting CGPA to the corresponding percentage of marks will be as follows :
 $X = 10 Y - 4.5$ Where, X = Percentage of Marks, Y = CGPA

Declaration of Division:

A candidate who has passed in all the courses of examinations of I, II, III, IV, V & VI Semesters taken together will be declared as "Passed". Such passed candidates may be awarded with the division according to the following criterion:

- First Division with distinction..... CGPA 8.5 and above
- First Division.....CGPA 6.5 and above but below 8.5
- Second Division.....CGPA 5.00 and above but below 6.5.

IMPORTANT NOTES

Immediately after receipt of Grade-Card candidates are advised to verify and ensure that: (a) the name, roll number and enrolment number have been correctly written; (b) the Grades have been entered against the subjects offered / appeared; (c) the total Credits mentioned at the bottom are correct; and (d) there is no overwriting or erasing.

In the event of any inaccuracy / discrepancy in regard to any of the above, they are advised to inform the Controller of Examinations, B.H.U. within a week of the receipt of Grade-Card.

Note: Candidate who have passed an examination by award of Grace Marks and who want to get the Grace Marks withdrawn/removed, should submit to this office a written application to that effect along with original mark sheet of the concerned examination, within one month from the date of declaration of their result.
