- The State Government/UT/Institute of Technical Education/Institute of Medical Education shall ensure that 10% of expenditure for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) as per the reservation policy for admission, operational from the Academic year 2019-20 is implemented without affecting the reservation percentages of SC/ST/OBC/General. However, this policy will be applicable in the case of newly established colleges in the District (T) of Institute of Education. Each Institution shall be permitted to increase its actual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years.
- The Institution offering courses under the Regular, Full Time, Short Duration, and other modes shall have to fill all facilities such as infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2017-18 by the State Government/UT. Further, the institutions deemed to be Unapproved Institutions having Accreditation Authority shall have to fulfill the Faculty, Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook. All such Institutions/Colleges shall have to comply the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities within 180 days to fill the norms based on the stipulated standards/ACITE under the Academic Year 2021-22.
- Strict compliance of All-India Regulatory Establishment of Committee by SC/ST, Establishment of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Establishment of Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Sexual Harassment Cell (Environment for women and other persons). The All-India Regulatory Establishment should be maintained as per the process's steps in Approval Process Handbook and ACITE Regulation under the Academic Year.
- In case of any differences in content in the Computer generated (Electronic Approval) after the verification as approved by the Executive Council/General Council is available on the record of ACITE, shall be final and binding.

The State Government (in accordance with the provisions of Technical Education (Amendment) Act 2016) shall ensure that 10% of expenditure for Technological Studies Courses (TSCs) as per the notification issued by government, originates from the Academic year 2019-20 as expenditure without affecting the allocated percentages of 50/30/19/1% (Govt/Univt/ Govt/Univt) as per the applicable in the case of Institute/Institutions referred to the Clause 2(a) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institutes shall be permitted to maintain annual parallel strength over a maximum period of five years.
2. The Institutes offering courses under the Degree/Diploma/Trade/Advanced Diploma/Trade are free to discontinue or add more and shall have to fill up facilities such as infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approved Process Handbook 2020-21 for the Year Approved Study. Further, the Institutes/Univt to be considered/Institutions being considered, wherever there shall have to ensure the Faculty, Student ratio as specified in the Approved Process Handbook. All such Institutes/Univt shall have to create the necessary Faculty, infrastructure and other facilities (MTRR/IT/HR/HR) to fill the norm based on the relevant infrastructure/AC/TC (supported with the Academic Year 2020-21).
3. Best candidates of All-India Engineering Examination, Advertisement of Candidates for (AI/ET/ET) Advertisement of Central Computer Committee (CCC), Advertisement of Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) and other Government or Institute or other persons, the All India Certificate should be included in Approved Process Handbook and processes steps in AC/TC Regulation notified from the 2019.
4. In case of any difference or conflict in the Computer generated Database of Approved Study, the confirmation is approved by the Executive Council/Univt Council as notified in the record of AC/TC shall be final and binding.

The State Government (V) Directorate of Technical Education Directorate of Medical Education shall ensure that 10% of reservation for Community Quota (Section 2(A)(c)) as per the reservation policy for admissions operational from the Academic year 2019-20 is implemented without affecting the reservation percentages of SC/ST/BC(PwD)) General. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the Clause (c) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase or grant/provide/adjust over a maximum period of two years.
2. The Institution offering courses under the Regular (R), Free (F), Social (S) and Free (F) Fee are now designated as self-aided and shall have to fulfil all facilities such as infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2020-21 for the Self-Aided Institutions. Further, the Institutions deemed to be University Institutions having Accreditation Authority status shall have to maintain the Faculty Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
3. Staff compliance of Anti-Doping Regulation, Establishment of Committee for SC/ST, Establishment of Grievance Committee (GC), Establishment of Grievance Committee Redressal Mechanism, Barrier Free Road Development for disabled and elderly persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be maintained as per the provisions made in Approval Process Handbook and AICTE Regulation related thereto to date.
4. In case of any differences or queries in the Computer generated Statement of Approval's offer, the concerned institution as approved by the Executive Council / Council (wherever available in the case of AICTE) shall be the authority.
