NOTE: (The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For details, the corresponding orders / notifications issued from time to time, must be referred.)

- Maximum passing marks:** In each Theory Paper, the minimum passing marks shall be 25% of the aggregate marks of the paper. In each Practical Paper, the minimum passing marks shall be 25% of the aggregate marks of the paper.
- Passing in Disciplines and Extra-curricular activities:** A student shall be deemed to have passed in these activities if he/she obtains the marks, per activity, as specified in the marks sheet.
- Star:** A student who obtains marks of 75% or more in all the papers of a semester shall be awarded a star. The star shall be awarded in the marks sheet of the papers prescribed for the examination.
- Grace Marks:** The extent of 10% of the aggregate marks in a paper for an examination shall be used to the best advantage of a student who has failed in a paper, provided that paper passed the examination by the award of 10% grace marks.
- Promotion:** A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed at least 25% of the marks in papers and 20% of the aggregate marks in a semester.
- Re-valuation / Re-evaluation:** A student who fails in a paper shall be allowed to re-appear in the paper in the next examination. The re-valuation / re-evaluation of a paper shall be done at the discretion of the Controller of Examinations. The date of issue of marks sheet, including the date of re-valuation / re-evaluation, shall be ascertained after the publication of the marks sheet of the examination.
- For every kind of improvement:** The student is allowed to re-appear in the next examination. The student is allowed to re-appear in the next examination only if he/she has failed in the paper.
- Term Test:** A student is allowed to re-appear in the term test if he/she has failed in the paper. The student is allowed to re-appear in the term test only if he/she has failed in the paper.
- Sessional Improvement:** If a student fails in any paper in a semester, he/she is allowed to re-appear in the paper in the next examination. The student is allowed to re-appear in the paper only if he/she has failed in the paper.
- A candidate shall be awarded:**
 - First Class:** If a candidate secures at least 70% of the aggregate marks in all the papers.
 - Second Class:** If a candidate secures at least 60% of the aggregate marks in all the papers.
 - Pass Class:** If a candidate secures at least 50% of the aggregate marks in all the papers.

1. Answer books are not subjected to any evaluation.
 2. In case of any mistake being detected in the marks sheet, the Controller of Examinations shall be responsible for the same.
 3. All candidates shall be subjected to the discipline and extra-curricular activities.
