



### Important Instructions

1. The State Government/UT Directorate of Technical Education/ Directorate of Medical Education shall ensure that 50% of reservation for Government/Quota (GWS) as per the reservation policy for admission, mentioned in the Appendix (Ann 2020-21) to Regulations without affecting the reservation percentages of 20% ST/ OBC (General) However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to in Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such facilities shall be provided in respect of annual percentage upto a maximum period of five years beginning with the academic year 2020-21.
2. The institution offering courses earlier in the Regular, Short, Dual-Deg, Special Short-Term and unregulated or non-state shall have to fill all vacancies such as Professors, Faculty and other employees as per the norms specified in the Appendix (Ann 2020-21) to the Total Appendix (Ann). Further, the institutions covered by an Unregulated/Regulated having Accreditation/Recognition shall also have to mention the Faculty/Student ratio as specified in the Appendix (Ann) Handbook. All such Institutions/Universities shall have to make the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS from the norms laid in the Annexure appended to AICTE.
3. In view of any differences in content in the Computer generated Prospectus of Approved College, the same information as approved by the Council of Technical Education should be available on the website of AICTE: [aicteweb.org](http://aicteweb.org).
4. With compliance of the ongoing Regulation, Approval is subject to strict compliance of provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified under E. No. 2733/Regulation/TE/2020 dated July 1, 2020 for Promotion and Protection of Quality in Technical Institutions. In case Institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent flagging of both in and in accordance with AICTE Regulation or fails to furnish constitution or records of Faculty, it will be liable to take any action as defined under clause (a) of the said Regulation.

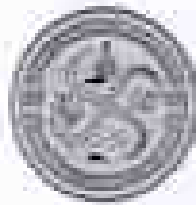

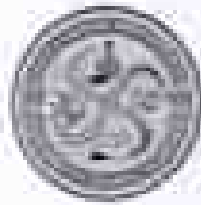
