In case the institution is not in a position to commence the above mentioned courses for whatever reason during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter, the approval becomes invalid and the relevant Society/Institution shall have to re-apply to AICTE for grant of approval as per the norms prevailing at the time.

The decision of the PCI is as under:

It is decided that decisions are subject to following conditions:

- a) The nature of affiliation of the Examining Authority and PNC of the State Government (as applicable) should be consistent with the Institute.
- b) The institution should have a legal entity status (as the date of application to PCI and PNC of the State Government and consent of affiliation of Examining Authority (as applicable) shall be in the name of legal entity).
- c) They shall produce records of their legal entity and the land and building documents as substantiated their claims.
- d) Whenever needed inspections will be carried out subsequently and if the facts claimed by the institution are found false, the PCI may change or withdraw the approval.
- e) Any approval granted by the PCI (upto 2021-2022 academic session) will stand but will be considered year on year basis based on the information submitted by institution in return III.
- f) Whenever required, institution shall furnish additional information as sought by the PCI from time to time.
- g) The request for new or additional B.E./Pharm course beyond 100 seats is not considered as per the policy of the Council.
- h) Regarding M.Pharm course, it was noted that 110th Council Council in its meeting held on 12th December, 2020 under Item No.27, decided as under:-
 - i) 12 specializations / subjects are permitted in which M.Pharm can be conducted. (Ref: Regulation-4, Appendix-4 of M.Pharm Regulations)
 - ii) maximum 12 seats per specialization are sanctioned by PCI (Ref: Regulation-23(11) of M.Pharm Regulations)
Further as per the statutory provisions of M.Pharm Regulations, the ratio of recognized Five-Creditable teacher to number of students to be admitted for the M.Pharm course shall be 1:1.
 - iii) as per the procedure in return, the institutions apply to PCI for number of seats per specialization / course to be sanctioned in case number of seats sanctioned by PCI are less than 12.
 - iv) in the view of above statutory provisions of the M.Pharm Regulations, it was decided that in case institution has the prescribed teaching staff with prescribed experience as per "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014", PCI shall sanction number of admissions per M.Pharm specialization based on availability of the teaching staff irrespective of institution's request to PCI. However, under no circumstances more than 12 students per specialization shall be sanctioned.
In view of above, M.Pharm course are decided accordingly.
- i) The institution shall not make any reference to the increased intake sanctioned by PCI without affiliation of the Examining Authority for issue of admission.
