112th CC Meeting (10.6.2021)

1. The decision of the PCI are as under.
2. It is decided that decisions are subject to following conditions.
 - a) the consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority and NOC of the State Government (as applicable) should be available with the institution.
 - b) the institution should have a legal entity status on the date of application to PCI and NOC of the State Government and consent of affiliation of Examining Authority (as applicable) shall be in the name of legal entity.
 - c) They shall produce records of their legal entity and the land and building documents to substantiate their claims.
 - d) Whenever needed inspections will be carried out subsequently and if the facts claimed by the institution are found false, the PCI may change or withdraw the approval.
 - e) Any approval granted by the PCI beyond 2021-2022 academic session will stand but will be considered year on year basis based on the information submitted by institution in online SIF.
 - f) Whenever required, institutions shall furnish additional information as sought by the PCI from time to time.
 - g) The request for raise in admissions for D.Pharm course beyond 60 intake is not considered as per the policy of the council.
 - h) Regarding M.Pharm seats, it was noted that 110 Central Council in its meeting held on 11th December, 2020 under item No. 273 decided as under -
 - i) 12 specialties / subjects are prescribed in which M.Pharm can be conducted. (Ref. Regulation-9, Appendix-A of M.Pharm Regulations)
 - ii) maximum 15 seats per specialization are sanctioned by PCI (Ref. Regulation-23.(1) of M.Pharm Regulations)
 Further as per the statutory provisions of M.Pharm Regulations, the ratio of recognized Post-Graduate teacher to number of students to be admitted for the M.Pharm course shall be 1:3.
 - iii) as per the procedure in vogue, the institution applies in SIF for number of seats per specialization / raise in admission in case number of seats sanctioned by PCI are less than 15.
 - iv) in view of above statutory provisions of the M.Pharm Regulations, it was decided that in case institution has the prescribed teaching staff with prescribed experience as per "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014", PCI shall sanction number of admissions per M.Pharm specialization based on availability of the teaching staff irrespective of institution's request in SIF. However, under no circumstances more than 15 students per specialization shall be sanctioned.
 In view of above, M.Pharm seats are decided accordingly.
 - v) The institution shall not make any admission to the increased intake sanctioned by PCI without affiliation of the Examining Authority for raise in admission.
3. The above conditions be also conveyed to individual institution through the institution's dash board.

If institution is unable to start in the academic session 2019-20 due to reasons mentioned above, the institution will have to apply Online on AICTE web portal in next academic session for certification of approval.

The Society/Trust/Institution shall obtain necessary affiliation / permission from the concerned affliating University/ Board of Technical Education (BTE)/ Board of Technical Education & Training (BTET)(as applicable) as per the prescribed schedule of the University/ Board of Technical Education (BTE)/ Board of Technical Education & Training (BTET)(as applicable) Admission authority etc. The Applicant Society/Trust/Institution shall send information about commencement of the above courses to AICTE. In case the institution is not in a position to commence the above mentioned courses for whatever reason during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter, the approval becomes invalid and the applicant Society/Trust/Institution shall make fresh application to AICTE for grant of approval as per the norms prevailing at that time.

All institution shall fulfil the following general conditions:

- The management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing requisite infrastructure, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
- The Eligibility Criteria for admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
- The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall limits prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
- The Curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation / assessment of students shall be in accordance with the Model Curriculum and Examination Pattern prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- The management of the institution shall not discontinue any course(s) or start any other course(s) or alter intake capacity of any without

Pre-Approval of the Council

6. No access admission shall be made by the institution over and above the stipulated intake under any circumstances. In case any access admission is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
7. The institution shall not have any collaboration or agreement with any other institution and / or Foreign University for conduct of technical courses without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
8. The institution shall not conduct any course(s) as specified in the Approval Process Handbook, without prior permission / approval of AICTE. In case of any violation, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
9. The institution shall operate only from the approved location, and this the institution shall not open any off campus study center / branch/ centre directly or in collaboration with any other institution / university / organization for the purpose of providing technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE. In case of any violation, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
10. The accounts of the institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Central or persons authorized by it.
11. Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in strict conformity and selection shall be done according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and only those who are as per the norms prescribed by the AICTE are eligible for it. The institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year, giving details regarding the institution and courses / programs being conducted. Fees structure and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of supplementary information. The information booklet may be made available to the candidates of the technical education. The directory (directory information) as per the norms in the AICTE website / Approval Process Handbook, shall be put in the institution website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
12. It shall be mandatory for the institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information shall be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
13. If the institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and / or misrepresents the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
14. AICTE may also conduct inspection with or without notifying the date to verify specifications, to verify adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify any misrepresentation, violation of norms & standards, mis-practices etc.
15. The institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become entitled to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
16. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the withdrawal conditions should be given admission against the vacant seat. The amount fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the institution to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It would not be permissible for the institution to return the School / Institution Leaving Certificate in original to some extent of admitted students and not to charge fees for the remaining period if a student canceled the admission at any point of time.
17. The institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of AICTE regulation "Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities/Industry Deemed to Universities Imparting technical education" Regulation 2009 of No. 37/2009/AICTE/2009 dated 24/11/2009. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the notified regulations.
18. It is mandatory to comply with the essential requirements as given in AICTE 2016-20 (Appendix B).

The Management of the institution shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time. The Council may withdraw the approval, in case it observe any violation at the course visit/audit and/or non-adherence to the norms and standards prescribed by the Council, mis-representation of facts and submitting false/incorrect information to it.

NOTE: If the State Government / UT / DTE / DMC has a reservation policy for admission in Technical Education institutions and the same is applicable to Private & Self-Financing Technical Institutions, then the State Government / UT / DTE / DMC shall ensure that 10% of Reservation for EWS would be operational from the Academic year 2019-20. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India.
