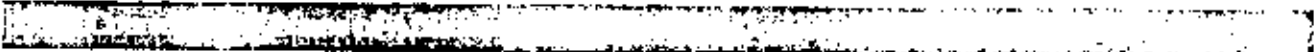



Subj: Clarification on Council's Notification dt.22.10.2022, *ex.259*

- Ref: 1. The decisions of various Executive Committees and Central Council as posted on Council's website during 2022-2023 approval cycle.
2. Notification No.14-443/2022-PC (Appeal process 2022-2023) - 14367 dt.22.10.2022 *ex.259*


Sir/Madam,

1. It may please be recalled that for 2022-2023 approval cycle, the decisions of the committees regarding approval of institutions on the website of Council and the approved intake of students was released.
2. The matter was considered by SPCU in its meeting held on 18.10.2022 which decided as under:
  - a) wherever admissions intake was reduced in 2022-2023 academic session in pharmacy colleges, the previous approved intake during 2021-2022 academic session be restored for 2022-2023 academic session also.
  - b) to notify to all such institutes that an affidavit\* should be uploaded on the portal of Dash Board I on the portal of Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi within one month of receipt of this Notification without fail. There should not be any change/modification/alteration in the affidavit provided with this Notification. In case any change is observed, the same will not be entertained at any cost and the liabilities will rest only with the Institute and SPCU.

The above decision of SPCU was notified on Council's website with notification no. 14-443/2022-PC dt.22.10.2022.

- 3. In view of observations directed to elicit that delay in receipt of the draft by various Executive Committees (relating the intake in various pharmacy courses) are to be read with care and not to be on dt. 27.11.2022 ensuring that wherever admission intake was reduced in 2022-2023 and deemed to be normal in 2023-2024, the previously approved intake during 2021-2022 would remain as such for 2023-2024 academic session.
