112th CC Meeting (10.6.2021)

- The decision of the PCI are as under.
- It is decided that decisions are subject to following conditions.
 - the consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority and NOC of the State Government (as applicable) should be available with the institution.
 - the institution should have a legal entity status on the date of application to PCI and NOC of the State Government and consent of affiliation of Examining Authority (as applicable) shall be in the name of legal entity.
 - They shall produce records of their legal entity and the land and building documents to substantiate their claims.
 - Wherever needed inspections will be carried out subsequently and if the facts claimed by the institution are found false, the PCI may change or withdraw the approval.
 - Any approval granted by the PCI beyond 2021-2022 academic session will stand but will be considered year on year basis based on the information submitted by institution in online SIF.
 - Wherever required, institution shall furnish additional information as sought by the PCI from time to time.
 - The request for raise in admissions for D.Pharm course beyond 60 intake is not considered as per the policy of the council.
 - Regarding M.Pharm seats, it was noted that 110 Central Council in its meeting held on 11th December, 2020 under item No.271 decided as under -
 - 12 specialties / subjects are prescribed in which M.Pharm can be conducted. (Ref: Regulation-9, Appendix-A of M.Pharm Regulations).
 - maximum 15 seats per specialization are sanctioned by PCI (Ref: Regulation-23.(1) of M.Pharm Regulations)
Further as per the statutory provisions of M.Pharm Regulations, the ratio of recognized Post-Graduate teacher to number of students to be admitted for the M.Pharm course shall be 1:3.
 - as per the procedure in vogue, the institution applies in SIF for number of seats per specialization / raise in admission in case number of seats sanctioned by PCI are less than 15.
 - In view of above statutory provisions of the M.Pharm Regulations, it was decided that in case institution has the prescribed teaching staff with prescribed experience as per "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014", PCI shall sanction number of admissions per M.Pharm specialization based on availability of the teaching staff irrespective of institution's request in SIF. However, under no circumstances more than 15 students per specialization shall be sanctioned.
In view of above, M.Pharm seats are decided accordingly.
 - The institution shall not make any admission to the increased intake sanctioned by PCI without affiliation of the Examining Authority for raise in admission.
- The above conditions be also conveyed to individual institution through the institution's dash board.

Other decision

Regarding B.Pharm course (32-1009/2011-PCI) -

- a) It was noted that no admissions were made from last six years. In view of it, it was decided to seek clarification from the institution as to whether it intends to run the B.Pharm course and if yes, the institution shall comply with the norms prescribed under the following Regulations and submit compliance with documentary evidence with regard to appointment of teaching staff as per -
- The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
- b) It was further decided to seek clarification from inspectors regarding teaching staff in respect of B.Pharm course as the same is not clearly mentioned in inspection report.

F.No.01.104/2018-PCI

The minutes of 01.104th meeting of the Central Council of the Pharmacy Council of India held on 7th & 8th August, 2018 at New Delhi.

* Consideration of approval of the Diploma, Degree, Pharm.D and Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate), M.Pharm and B.Pharm (Practice) course and examination in Pharmacy at the undermentioned institutions.

The following resolutions moved by Dr.Shailendra Saraf, Prof. M.D. Karvekar and Shri H.G. Koshla and seconded by Prof. Shivajirao Kadam, Prof. O. P. Kalra and Shri B. Rajan were unanimously passed applicable in respect of all approvals u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist.

A. For the approval u/s 12

- In pursuance of the provisions of sub section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India declares the course in Pharmacy (as applicable) conducted by institutions mentioned below to be an approved course of study for the purpose of admission to an approved examination in Pharmacy (as applicable) in respect of number of students and academic session as specified here under:
- In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India declares the Examination in Pharmacy (as applicable) held by the Examining Authorities mentioned against their name, during the session mentioned to be an approved examination for the purpose of qualifying for registration as a Pharmacist under the said Act.*

B. The approval is subject to-

- the institution shall submit SIF every year as per the Time-Schedule prescribed by the Council.
- the institution shall submit annual affiliation fee on or before due date.
- the institution shall appoint the teaching faculty with the qualification and experience as prescribed under the "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014".

C. Besides above conditions, institutions seeking approval of Pharm.D / Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) course shall comply with the following conditions -

- The institution shall comply with the requirements of Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008 particularly regarding appointment of teaching staff, equipments and Hospital facility.
- Further the PCI recommends that Pharmacy Practice Faculty (including HOD shall undergo at least 1 Continuing Education Programme / Training Programme of minimum 3 days duration every year and participation in atleast one seminar/conference every year.
- In view of above, it was decided to ask the institutions concerned to intimate the council per return of mail the number of such Continuing Education Programmes / Training Programmes / Seminar / Conference etc. attended by HOD and pharmacy practice faculty during the last one year with documentary evidence i.e. participation certificate etc.

In case of any differences to content in this Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the content/information as approved by the Executive Council / General Council as available on the record of AICTE shall be final and binding.

State compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation - Approval is subject to strict compliance of provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified vide F. No. 27-31. Legal/AICTE/000 dated July 1, 2006 for Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions. In case institution fails to take adequate steps to Prevent Ragging or fails to act in accordance with AICTE Regulation or fails to punish perpetrators or incidents of Ragging, it will be liable to take any action as defined under clause 9(A) of the said Regulation.

It is mandatory to comply all the essential requirements as given in APH 2019-20 (appendix B)

NOTE: If the State Government / UT / DTE / DME has a reservation policy for admission in Technical Education Institutes and the same is applicable to Private & Self-financing Technical Institutions, then the State Government / UT / DTE / DME shall ensure that 10 % of Reservation for EWS would be operational from the Academic year 2019-20 without affecting the percentage reservation of SC/ST/OBC/General. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority institutions referred to in clause (f) of Article 31 of Constitution of India.
