3. In case of any differences in respect to the Computer generated Categories of Approvals after the communication as required by the Executive Council I issued Circular in respect of the fees of 2020-21 shall be final and binding.
4. Non-compliance of Anti-Plagiarism Regulation - Annexure is subject to strict compliance of processes, stated in AICTE Regulation dated 01. Feb. 2018 (Regulation 2018/2019 dated July 1, 2018) for Plagiarism and detection of Plagiarism in Technical Institutions.
