





Board constituents of both Progues (Programme), Committees of Committee for HSC/ST, Establishment of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Establishment of State Complaint Redressal Mechanism, Survey Form Rule (Evaluation for student and society norms), Fire and Safety Committee should be maintained at least the minimum levels in Approved Process Handbook and AHB/AB. - ii. All such Institutions/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities within 2 years (will be laid down) on the efficient (minimum) by 2024.
- iii. In case of any difference in content in the Computer generated Document of Approval Letter, the concerned document as issued by the Academic Council / University Council as available on the website of MHRD shall be final and binding.
- iv. Non-compliance of above-mentioned Regulation - Approval is subject to strict compliance of previous legal or AICTE Regulation earlier case T. No. 2020-2021-CTE/2020 dated July 1, 2020 for Registration and Function of Ringers & Technical Institutions.
