Note: The approval is valid for two years from the date of issue of this letter only for getting affiliation with respective University/ Board of Technical Education (BTE) Board of Technical Education & Training (BTE) for affiliated and Affiliated State level requirements for admission of students to study in the academic session 2018-20 and to secure mentioned above, the Institution will have to apply for the 2018-20 and perform next academic session for continuation of approval.

The Society/Trustee/Institution shall obtain necessary affiliation / permission from the concerned affiliating University/ Board of Technical Education (BTE) Board of Technical Education & Training (BTE) (as applicable) as per the prescribed schedule of the University/ Board of Technical Education (BTE) Board of Technical Education & Training (BTE) (as applicable) Authority etc. The Affiliated Society/Trustee/Institution shall send information about commencement of the above courses to AICTE. It shall be the Institution's job to get a position to conduct the above mentioned courses for subsequent years during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter. The approval becomes void and the affiliated Society/Trustee/Institution shall make fresh application to AICTE for grant of approval in case the Institute pending at that time.

The Institution shall follow the following general conditions:

The management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing water, electricity, sanitation and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenses.

1. The Eligibility Criteria for institutions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
2. The fees and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Council from time to time. No institution shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form, if found not, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
3. The Curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation / assessment of students shall be in accordance with the Model Curriculum and Assessment Scheme prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
4. The management of the institution shall not discontinue any course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter extent/ capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
5. In case any institution shall be found by the Institution user and above the approved model under any circumstances, in case any adverse action is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
6. The institution shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any other bodies and / or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses without seeking prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
7. The institution shall not conduct any courses as specified in the Approved Process Handbook without prior permission / approval of AICTE, if found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
8. The institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centres / extension centres locally or in collaboration with any other Institute / university / organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without seeking prior approval from the AICTE. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
9. The process of the institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or persons authorized by it.
10. Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in given time frame and selection shall be done according to procedure, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. The institution shall submit an information booklet before commencement of the academic year going details regarding the Institution and course / programs being conducted, Fee structure and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory documents. The information booklet may be made available in its establishments of the technical education. The mandatory documents information, as per structure in the AICTE website / Approved Process Handbook, shall be put on the institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
11. It shall be mandatory for the institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
12. If the Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and / or misrepresents the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
13. AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the date to verify quality, compliance, its timely adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify any misrepresentation, violation of norms & standards, non-compliance etc.
14. The institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become exempt in any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
15. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the well listed conditions should be given admission against the vacant seat. The seats are allocated from the student, after a duration of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 10000. (Fees are not refundable) shall be returned and returned by the institution to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It would not be permitted for the institution to issue the School / Institution Leaving Certificate to original or false admission of admitted students and not to charge fees for the remaining period if a student secures the admission at any point of time.
16. The institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In the light of AICTE regulation "Prohibition and Prevention of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities Including Chartered Universities Imparting Technical Education" Regulation 2009 (7.44, 20-09-2009) (AICTE/REG/2009/0001/2009). In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the notified regulations.
17. It is mandatory to comply all the essential requirements as given in AICTE 2016 documents (2)

The Management of the institution shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time. The Council may withdraw the approval, in case it observes any violation of the above conditions under non-compliance to the norms and standards prescribed by the Council, misrepresentation of facts and exhibiting factually incorrect information (3).

AICTE, in the 2016 Documents (U / ETE / EME) has a reservation policy for admission in Technical Education Institutes and the same is applicable to State & Self-financing Technical Institutions, from the State Government / U / ETE / EME and ensure that 10 % of Reservation for EME would be available from the Academic year 2016-17 onwards. This would not be applicable in the case of minority institutions referred in the clause (1) of Article 30 Constitution of India.

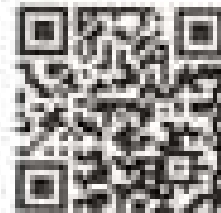

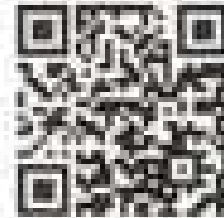

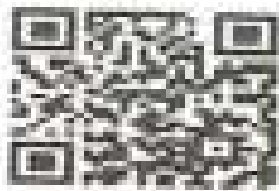
