

Decisions of PCI (23.6.2021)

The decisions of the PCI are as under. It is further decided that:

- a) Whenever needed inspections will be carried out subsequently and if the facts claimed by the institution are found false, the PCI may change or withdraw the approval.
- b) Any approval granted by the PCI beyond 2021-2022 academic session will stand but will be considered year on year basis based on the information submitted by institution at online SBI.
- c) Whenever required, institutions shall furnish additional information as sought by the PCI from time to time.
- d) The request for intake in admissions for B.Pharm course beyond 60 seats, is not considered as per the policy of the council.
- e) Regarding M.Pharm seats, it was noted that 10th Council Council in its meeting held on 11th December, 2020 under item No. 113 decided as under:-
 - i) 12 specializations / subjects are prescribed in which M.Pharm can be conducted. (Ref: Regulation-9, Appendix-A of M.Pharm Regulations).
 - ii) maximum 12 seats per specializations are sanctioned by PCI (Ref: Regulation-23.11) of M.Pharm Regulations).
Further as per the statutory provisions of M.Pharm Regulations, the ratio of recognized Post-Graduate teacher to number of students to be admitted for the M.Pharm course shall be 1:3.
 - iii) as per the procedure in regard, the institutions apply to SBI for number of seats per specializations / intake to admission in case number of seats sanctioned by PCI are less than 12.
 - iv) In view of above statutory provisions of the M.Pharm Regulations, it was decided that in 2021 institution has the prescribed teaching staff with prescribed experience as per "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014". PCI shall sanction number of admissions per M.Pharm specializations based on availability of the teaching staff irrespective of institution's request to SBI. However, intake in circumstances more than 12 students per specializations shall be sanctioned.In view of above, M.Pharm seats are decided accordingly.
- f) The institutions shall not make any admission to the sanctioned intake sanctioned by PCI without affiliation of the Examining Authority for intake in admission.
