- The State Government/ UT/ Directorate of Technical Education/ Directorate of Medical Education shall ensure that 10% of reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) as per the reservation policy for admission, implemented from the Academic year 2019-20 is implemented without affecting the reservation percentages of SC/ ST/ OBC (NCL) General. However, this would not be applicable in the year of Minority Institutions referred in the Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase its annual permitted strength over a structural period of two years.
- The Institution offering courses earlier in the People's List, First List, Second List/Part Time are now amalgamated as total intake and shall have to fill all facilities such as infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approved Process Handbook (APH) for the Total Approved intake. Further, the Institutions deemed to be University/ Institutions having Accredited/ Autonomy status shall have to maintain the Faculty: Student ratio as specified by the Approved Process Handbook. All such Institutions/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS to fill the seats based on the APHs submitted to AICTE beginning with the Academic Year 2022-23.
- Strict compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation, Establishment of Committee for SC/ ST, Establishment of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Establishment of Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Gender Free Safe Environment for disabled and elderly persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be maintained as Approved Process Handbook and provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified from time to time.
- In case of any difference in content in the Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the communication as approved by the Executive Council / General Council as available on the record of AICTE shall be final and binding.

**Pharmacy Institute:** In compliance with the order dated 05.02.2020 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Shrihari Padmanabhan (Civil) 184-82-181 of 2014, for the existing institutions offering courses in Pharmacy Programs, approval of Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required. The requirements for retaining the Programme (Status) (UG / PG) such as Land & Building area, Student faculty ratio, intake etc. will be as per the respective regulatory body (PCI). In case of any inconsistency in the course intake and intake for CoE issued by AICTE and the approval by PCI, the approval of PCI shall prevail.

Such Institution shall be permitted to increase its annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years.
- The Institution offering regular courses in the Regular DME, First DME, Second Short/Drop Time and amalgamated or dual mode shall have to fill all services such as Lecturers, Faculty and other appointments as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2021-22 for the Total Appointment Posts. Further, the Institutions deemed to be Autonomous Institutions having Autonomous Authority status shall have to maintain the Faculty/Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
- Good compliance of Anti-Ragging Provisions, Establishment of Committee for UGC (I), Establishment of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Establishment of Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Better Host-Student Environment for students and elderly persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be obtained as per the provisions made in Approval Process Handbook and (NCTE) Regulation notified from time to time.
- In case of any differences in respect to the Computer generated Statement of Approval Letter, the conciliation/mediation as advised by the Executive Council / General Council as available in the norm of NCTE shall be final and binding.

**Important Provisions**

- The State Government (ST) Directorate of Technical Education (Directorate of Technical Education) shall ensure that 100% of institutions for Engineering, Technology (EP/1000) are set up in accordance with the additional requirements from the Provisions (see 2019-21) to Engineering without affecting the maximum percentage of 100 EP/1000 (Total). However, this would not be applicable in the case of existing institutions referred to in Clause 11 of Article 20 of Constitution of India. Such institutions shall be permitted to continue or re-constituted through an extension period of two years beginning with the academic year 2020-21.
- The institution offering courses under the Regular, Day, Part Time, Distance Education, Open and Correspondence as well as other modes shall be held in full compliance with the Regulations, Terms and other requirements as per the norms specified in the approval Process (see 2019-21) to ST. Total approval shall be given for the institutions according to the Government's guidelines being formulated. Necessary steps shall have to be taken by the State Government as specified in the Manual, Provisions, Norms. All such institutions shall have to ensure the necessary faculty, infrastructure and other facilities (including staff) to fully comply with the Regulations (see 2019-21).
- In case of any difficulty in compliance with the complete provision of approval letter, the concerned institutions as specified by the Technical Council (Technical Council) shall be held in full compliance.
- 100% compliance of Self-Regulatory Bodies (SRB) is to be achieved in all compliance of provisions under the ST/TE Regulation (see 2019-21) to ST/TE. The ST/TE Regulation (see 2019-21) to ST/TE for the provision and formation of SRB in Technical Institutions is to be followed to be in full compliance with the Self-Regulatory Bodies (SRB) as per the provisions under the ST/TE Regulation (see 2019-21) to ST/TE. In case of any difficulty in compliance with the provisions of SRB, it will be open to the State Government to take the necessary steps to ensure full compliance of SRB.
