However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to this Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase its annual admitted strength over a maximum period of five years beginning with the Academic Year 2020-21.
- The Institution offering courses under in the Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift/Part Time has arrangements as well/ must have staff upto to UPH of facilities such as infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2020-21 for the Time Approved Intake. Further, the Institutions claimed to be (Innovative Institutions using Alternative) Alternative modes shall have to maintain the Faculty/ Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook. All such Institutional/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS to UPH the norms listed in the APH as submitted to AICTE.
- In case of any deficiency or content in the Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the concerned matter as advised by the Executive Council/ General Council as available on the website of AICTE shall be final and binding.
- Strict compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation - Approval is subject to strict compliance of provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified vide F. No. 1773/Agg/AICTE/2008 dated July 1, 2008 for Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority institutions referred to the Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase its annual sanctioned strength over a maximum period of two years.
- The institution offering courses earlier in the Regular, Day, Part Time, Second Shift/Part Time and now discontinued as well those are shall have to fill up facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2022-23 for the Total Approved Intake. Further, the institutions Desirous to be Ordinary/ Institutions having Existing/ Autonomy status shall have to maintain the Faculty/ Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook. All such institutions/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS to fill the norms based on the Affidavit submitted to AICTE during with the Academic Year 2022-23.
- Strict compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation, Establishment of Committee for SC/ST, Establishment of Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), Establishment of Drive/ Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Sexual Harassment Environment for students and staffs persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be maintained as Approval Process Handbook and provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified from time to time.
- In case of any differences in context of the Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the concerned matter as approved by the Executive Council / General Council as available on the board of AICTE shall be final and binding.

Fee waiver institute: In compliance with the order dated 08/05/2020 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Tomlinson Petition (CMA) No. 87-101 of 2014, for the existing institutions offering courses in Primary Programs, approval of Primary Council of India (PCI) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required. The requirements for running the Programme (College / UGT / PG) such as Land & Building Area, Student-faculty ratio, intake etc., will be as per the respective regulatory body (PCI).

In case of any inconsistency in the course, term and intake for EWS issued by AICTE and the approval by PCI, the approval of PCI shall prevail.

Architecture Institute: In compliance with the order dated 06.11.2019 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India CA No.2941/2000, for the existing institutions offering Courses in Architecture Programme, approval by the Council of Architecture (COA) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required. The requirements for running the Programme (Diploma / UG / PG) such as Lead & Build-Up Area, Student-Faculty ratio, intake etc. will be as per respective regulatory body (COA) in case of any inconsistency in the course name and mode to that issued by AICTE and the approval by CoA, the approval of CoA shall prevail.

Deemed to be University: Institutions Deemed to be Universities (Running Technical Education Programmes), it is mandatory to have AICTE approval from the Academic Year 2018-19 in compliance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 06.11.2019 passed in CA No.2941/2000.
