


Minutes of 62,245<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee (EC) meeting of the Council held on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 at New Delhi. (11<sup>th</sup> minis meeting) The decisions are subject to ratification by Central Council of the PCI.

- A. Consideration of the approval of Diploma / Degree / Pharm.D / Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) / M.Pharm / B.Pharm (Practice) course and constitution of Pharmacy at the institutions mentioned:-
- A. It was decided to recommend to the Council to grant approval for conduct / extension of approval / rev. 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 of Diploma / Degree / Pharm.D / Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) / M.Pharm / B.Pharm (Practice) course and constitution of Pharmacy subject to the following conditions:-
  - a) The institution shall submit 50<sup>th</sup> entry form as per the Time Schedule prescribed by the Council.
  - b) The institution shall submit an affidavit for compliance of conditions.
  - c) The institution shall appoint 24 lecturers faculty with the qualification and experience as prescribed under the "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulation, 2012".

E. Decides above conditions, institutions seeking approval of Pharm.D / Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) course and comply with the following conditions:-

- 1. The institution shall comply with the requirements of Pharm.D Regulation, 2012 particularly regarding appointment of lecturers with appropriate and hospital facility.
- 2. Further the PCI recommends that Pharmacy Practice Faculty including HOD shall undergo at least 7 Continuing Education Programmes / Training Programmes of minimum 3 days duration every year and participate in at least one national conference every year.
- 3. In case of non-compliance, it was decided to let the institutions reviewed in relation to annual performance of each the member of each Continuing Education Programmes / Training Programmes / Seminars / Conferences are attended by HOD and pharmacy practice faculty during the last one year & subsequently evidence the participation certificate.
- 4. The institution to submit 50<sup>th</sup> entry form of the Pharm.D Regulation, 2012 as per following details:-

**Training of HOD of Pharm.D or Practice Department and Pharmacy Practice Faculty**

The HOD & the faculty of Pharmacy Practice Department who are not qualified with M.Pharm Pharmacy Practice Qualification or Pharm.D Qualification and have other specialist training of certificate in the Pharmacy Practice Department, shall undergo the training as per Regulations mentioned in the Pharm.D Regulation, 2012. The following details to be submitted:-

- I. In respect of HOD of Pharmacy Practice Department
  - a) Name of HOD
  - b) Designation
  - c) Qualification at graduate level
  - d) Qualification at PG level with specialization
  - e) Name of Training Centre
  - f) Duration of Training
  - g) Status of Training
  - h) Sign of HOD

- II. In respect of Pharmacy Practice Faculty of Pharmacy Practice Department
  - a) Name of Pharmacy Practice Staff
  - b) Designation
  - c) Qualification at graduate level
  - d) Qualification at PG level with specialization
  - e) Name of Training Centre
  - f) Duration of Training
  - g) Status of Training
  - h) Sign of HOD

4. The Curriculum of the courses, the procedure for enrollment, assessment of students shall be in accordance with the Model Curriculum and Examination Pattern prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
5. The management of the institution shall not discriminate any category or cast any race, creed or other innate capacity of persons without the prior approval of the Council.
6. No undue admission shall be made by the institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances, in case any excess admission is reported to the Council. Appropriate action as per the related regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
7. The institution shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any other Indian and / or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses without obtaining their approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the related regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
8. The institution shall not conduct any activities, as specified in the Approved Process Handbook without prior permission / approval of AICTE. A Council in appropriate action as per the related regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
9. The institution shall ensure that the approved courses, and that the institution shall not open any all-remote study centers / satellite centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution / university / organization for the purpose of providing technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE. In case of violation, appropriate action as per the related regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
10. The accounts of the institution shall be audited annually by a Certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or persons authorized by it.
11. Heads of Departments, the faculty and other staff shall be appointed as given time chart and procedure shall be done according to procedure, guidelines and regulations prescribed by the Council from time to time and any modification in the norms prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. The institution shall provide an information booklet before the commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses / programs being conducted, from amongst and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of brochure / prospectus. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education. The mandatory disclosure information, as per directions in the AICTE website / Approved Process Handbook, shall be put in the brochure / website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
12. It shall be mandatory for the institution to furnish a brochure involving the prescribed information. The brochure information shall be periodically updated as and when changes take place.
13. If the institution fails to disclose the information as required and / or disseminated the regulations, appropriate action as per the related regulations shall be initiated against the institution.
14. AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the institution to verify quality, compliance, to verify adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify the regulations, relative to norms & standards, regulations etc.
15. The institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become entitled to any grant/scholarship from the Central or State Government.
16. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the work sheet certificate should be given as per the approved format. The work sheet certificate shall be issued after a completion of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000. Please note that the work sheet certificate shall be retained and returned to the institution by the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It shall not be provided to the institution to enroll the student / institution (including candidates) in a higher number of similar courses and / or to enroll him for the remaining course if a student withdraws from the institution at any point of time.
17. The institution shall have appropriate measures for protection of intellectual property in the light of AICTE regulation "Protection and Promotion of Patent or Technical Innovations, Inventions including Patent in Universities regarding Technical Education" Resolution dated 9.10.2014 (AICTE/REG/2014/0001) in case of failure to protect the intellectual property by the institution, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the related regulations.

The management of the institution shall comply with all the conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time. The Council may withdraw the approval, to enter a scheme, any sanction at the above conditions and / or any violation in the norms and standards prescribed by the Council, and appropriate action as per the related regulations.
